Recipients subject to the nondiscrimination provisions of the SSA are exempt from the EEOP requirement if they meet any of the following criteria: (1) the recipient is a nonprofit organization, a medical or educational institution, or an Indian tribe; (2) the recipient has fewer than 50 employees; or (3) the recipient received a single award for less than \$25,000.
