CALL FOR NOMINATIONS 2012 -2013 PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER MEDAL OF VALOR

WASHINGTON - The Department of Justice's Office of Justice Programs is accepting nominations beginning today for the Public Safety Officer Medal of Valor, the highest national award for valor by a public safety officer. The medal is awarded by the President to public safety officers cited by the Attorney General who have exhibited exceptional courage in protecting and saving lives.
