This collection contains information on violent crime on campus, property crime on campus, the number of police officers assigned to campus duty, aggregate demographics and socio-economic conditions of the students on campus as well as for the cities in the dataset. Three files comprise this collection. One is an SPSS Version 9 file containing control cards; and a second has SPSSx control cards. A third file contains the data. The data consist of an initial sample of 150 college campuses which reported their crime rates to the F.B.I.'s Uniform Crime Report in 1978. The data were collected from several sources. Crime rates and police strength for both cities and campuses were collected from the 1978 UCR. Other campus variables were collected from the three sources: the Comparative Guide to American Colleges, 1979, Barron's Profiles of American Colleges, 1978 and The College Bluebook (seventh edition). The variable percent black on campus was obtained from the U.S. Department of Education's publication entitled Racial, Ethnic and Sex Enrollment data from Institutions of Higher Education, in the Fall of 1978. For universities reporting incomplete information on campus variables, other editions of these publications had to be consulted. These editions include The College Handbook 1981-1982. (nineteenth edition); Peterson's Annual Guide to Undergraduate Study Data, and the Comparative Guide to American Colleges, (sixth edition), 1973. City statistics were obtained from the 1980 U.S. Census except for the unemployment rates. Unemployment rates were obtained from Employment and Earnings 1978. For cities that included in this volume, unemployment rates were obtained from the State and Metropolitan Area Data Book, 1979. The unemployment rates in this volume were for the year 1977. A list of variables and summary statistics on those variables can be found in the appendix. As the appendix demonstrates, the data set is quite complete. Relevant variables are available, there is very little missing data, and the summary statistics indicate that the values are responsible.

This data set is being made available to the public through the Criminal Justice Research Archive maintained the Interuniversity Consortium for Political and Social Research at the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor.
