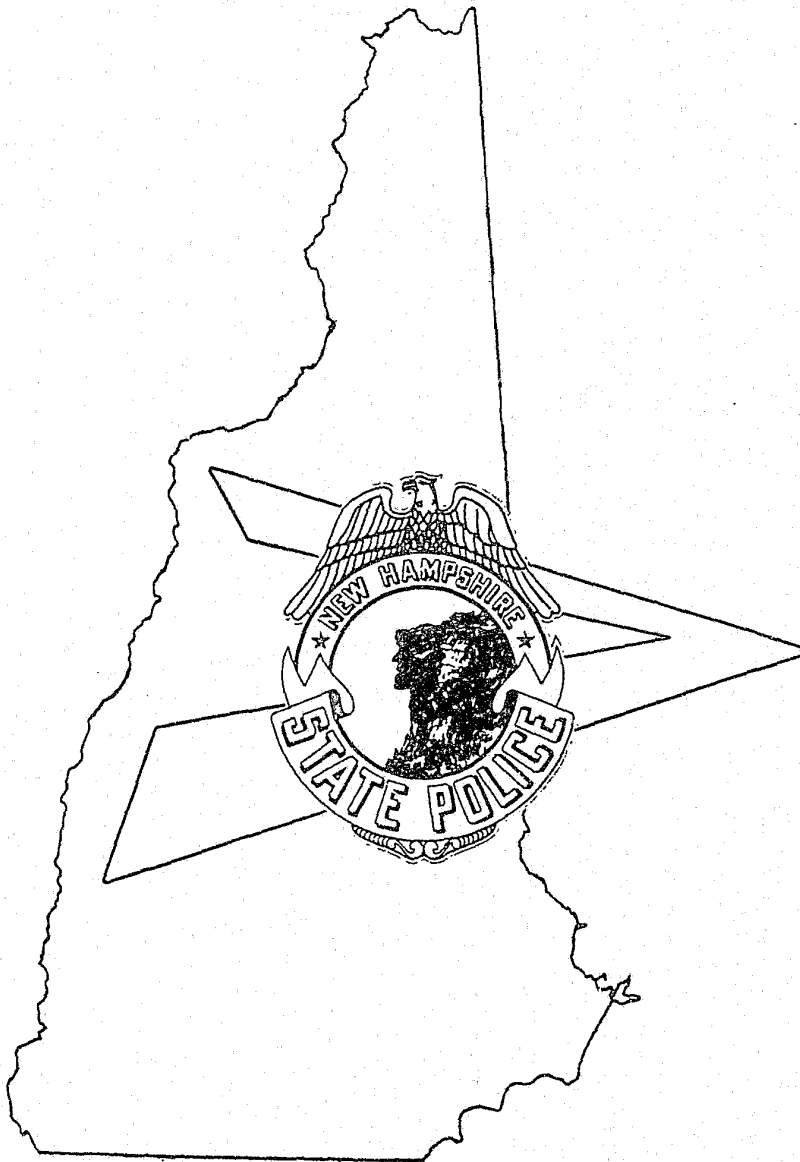

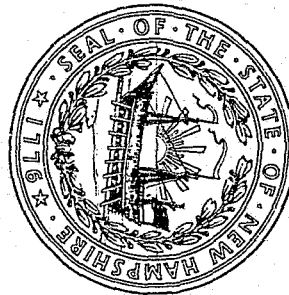

The Division of State Police is again pleased to publish our annual Uniform Crime Report "Crime in New Hampshire". This 1985 edition reflects the total crime picture for New Hampshire.

The primary purpose of this report is to keep abreast all law enforcement agencies and interested persons, various and patterned crime trends. Since the inception of the New Hampshire Uniform Crime Reporting Program, each years annual report establishes meaningful statistics adopted by procedural guidelines of reporting. These statistics are testament to the participating agencies who report criminal activity occurring within their geographical jurisdictions.

Regretfully, I am required to acknowledge a disturbing progression in the growth of Part I offenses experienced by the state. The numbers authenticate a dangerous trend. Homicides increased 61.5%, Robberies increased 10.5%, while overall Part I offenses increased by 4.8%. Rape, although disturbing in number, decreased 10.1% since 1984.

We, the law enforcement community, must accept the challenge these statistics represent and produce a unified effort to combat their increase. By improving the integrity of life and liberty, the New Hampshire ideal will be preserved.

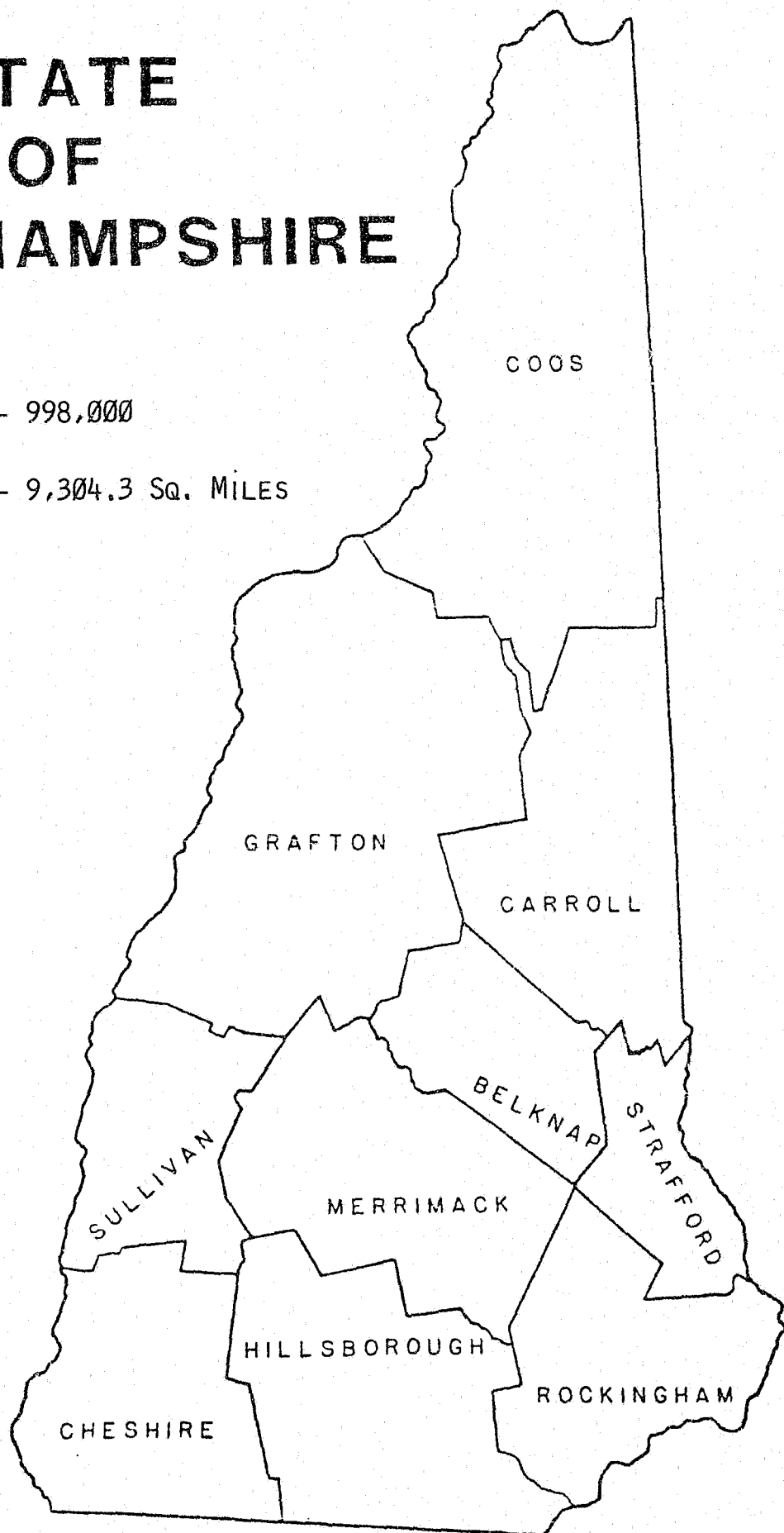

GLOSSARY OF TERMS

ADULT - In New Hampshire an adult is a person 18 years of age or above.

CLEARED BY ARREST OR EXCEPTIONAL MEANS - For UCR purposes, an offense is "cleared by arrest" or solved for crime reporting purposes when at least one person is (1) arrested, (2) charged with the commission of the offense, and (3) turned over to the court for prosecution. In certain situations, when the police have exhausted all leads and done everything possible to clear a case, the offense can be "exceptionally" cleared. The following conditions have to be met before an offense can be cleared exceptionally: (1) The investigation has definitely established the identity of the offender; (2) There is enough information to support an arrest, charge, and turning over to the court for prosecution; (3) The exact location of the offender is known so that he could be taken into custody; and (4) There is some reason outside law enforcement control that precludes arresting, charging, and prosecuting the offender.

INDEX OFFENSES - The sum total of eight major offenses used to measure the extent, fluctuation, and distribution of crime in a given geographical area. The eight offenses are: (1) Murder, (2) Forcible Rape, (3) Robbery, (4) Aggravated Assault, (5) Burglary, (6) Larceny-Theft, (7) Motor Vehicle Theft, and (8) Arson. Each of these offenses is referred to as an "Index Offense."

JUVENILE - In New Hampshire, a person 17 years of age or under.

PROPERTY CRIME - Consists of the Index Offenses of Burglary, Larceny, Motor Vehicle Theft, and Arson.

VIOLENT CRIME - Consists of the Index Offenses of Murder, Forcible Rape, Robbery, and Aggravated Assault.

C A L C U L A T I O N O F R A T E S

CRIME RATE

To compute rates, divide your community's population by 1,000 and then divide the number of offenses by the resulting figure.

Example:

- a. Population for your jurisdiction, 31,600.
- b. Number of known burglaries for your jurisdiction for a year, 341.

Divide 31,600 by 1,000 = 31.6.

Divide 341 by 31.6 = 10.79.

The burglary rate is 10.79 per 1,000 inhabitants.

CLEARANCE RATE

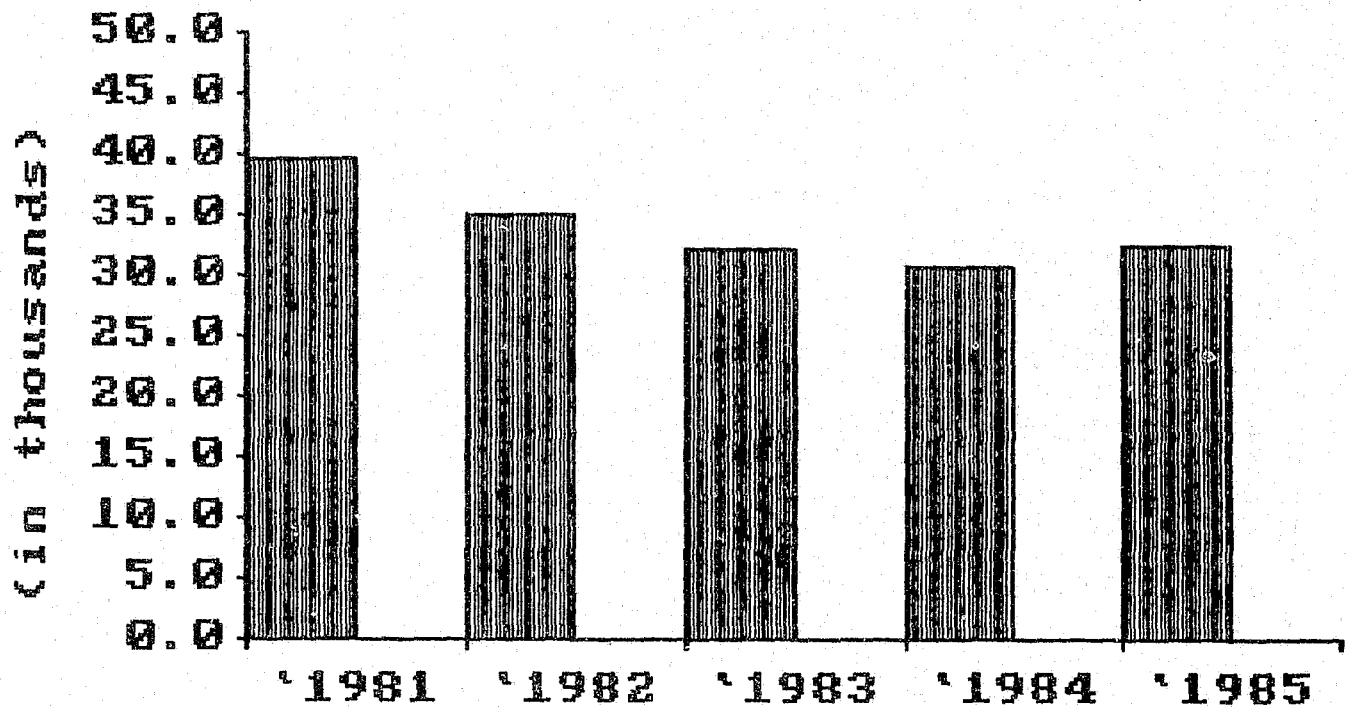
The percentage of crimes cleared by arrest is obtained by dividing the number of offenses cleared by the number of actual offenses known. This answer is then multiplied by 100.

Example:

<u>55</u> Burglaries cleared	
341 Burglaries known	.16 x 100 = 16%

Your percentage of clearance for burglary is 16%.

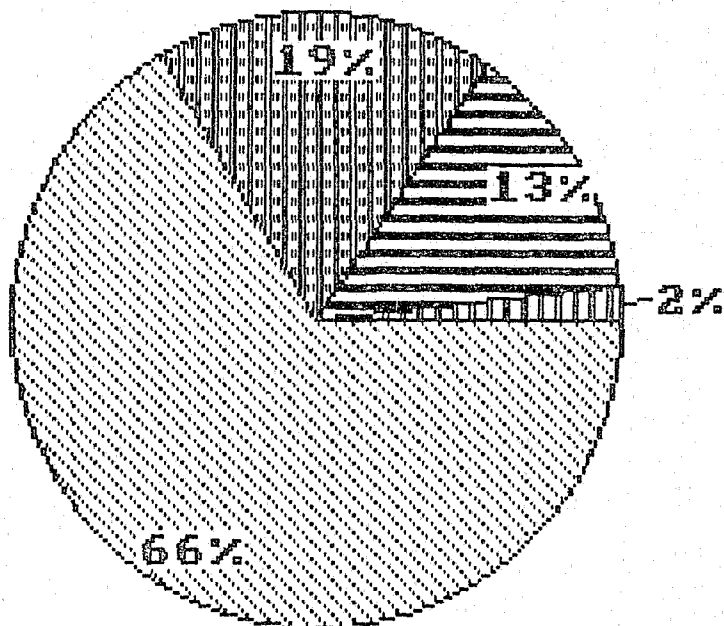

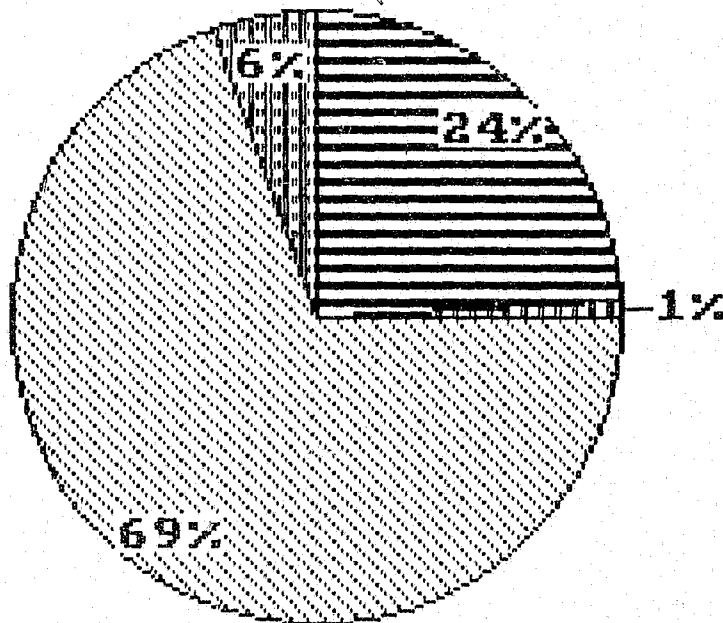

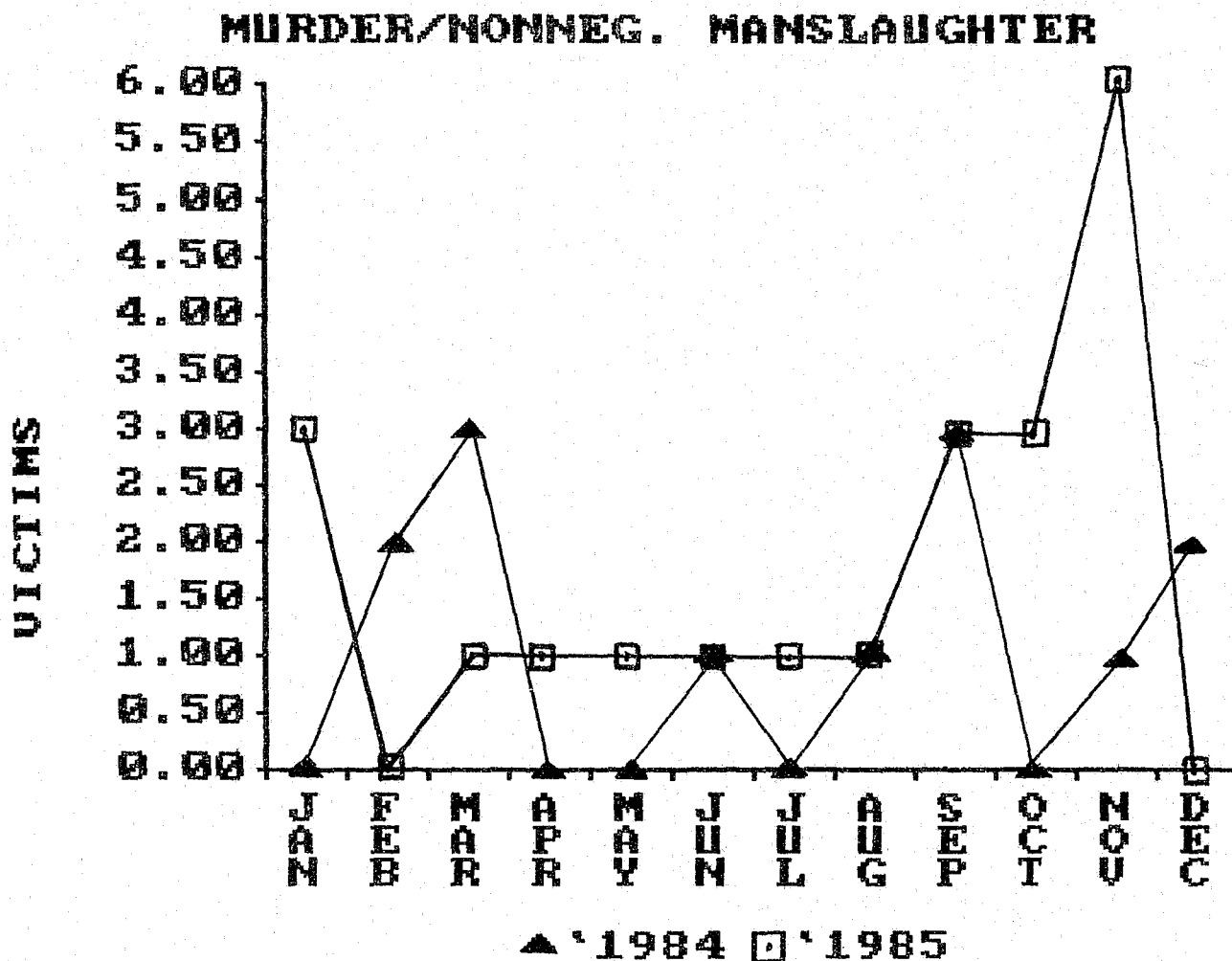

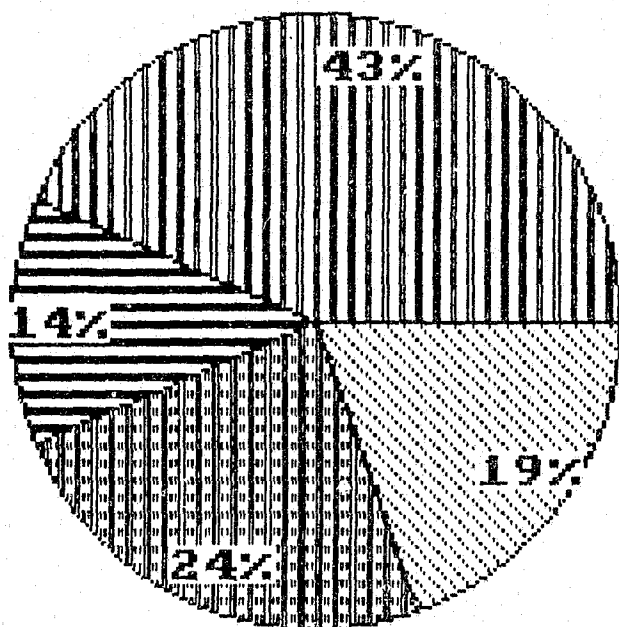

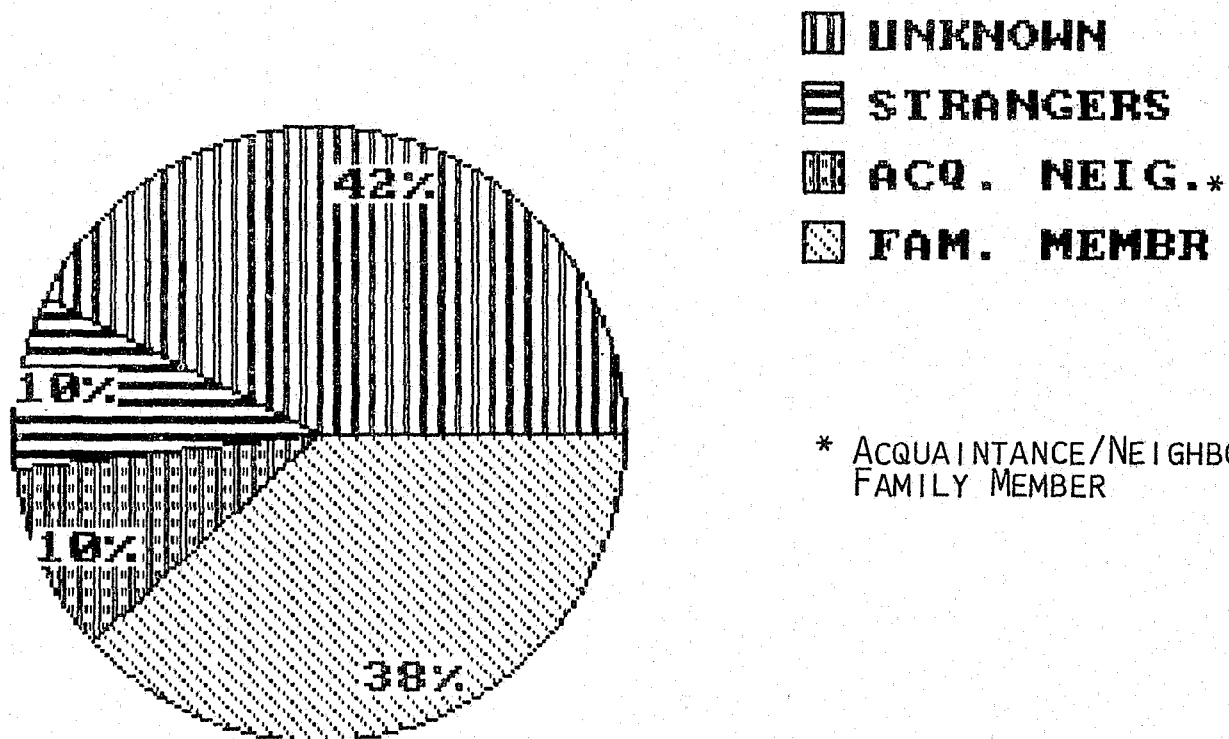

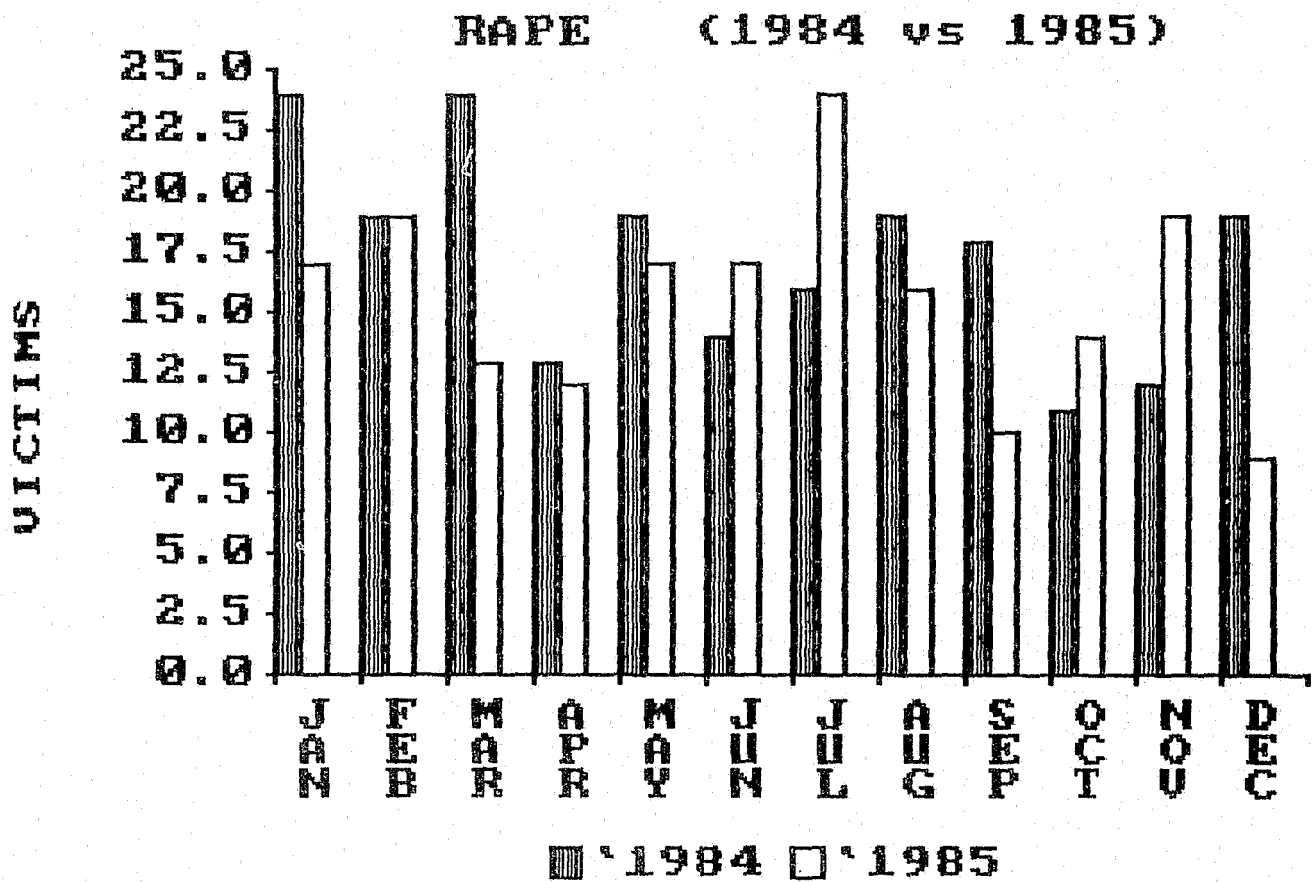
RELATIONSHIP OF VICTIM TO OFFENDER

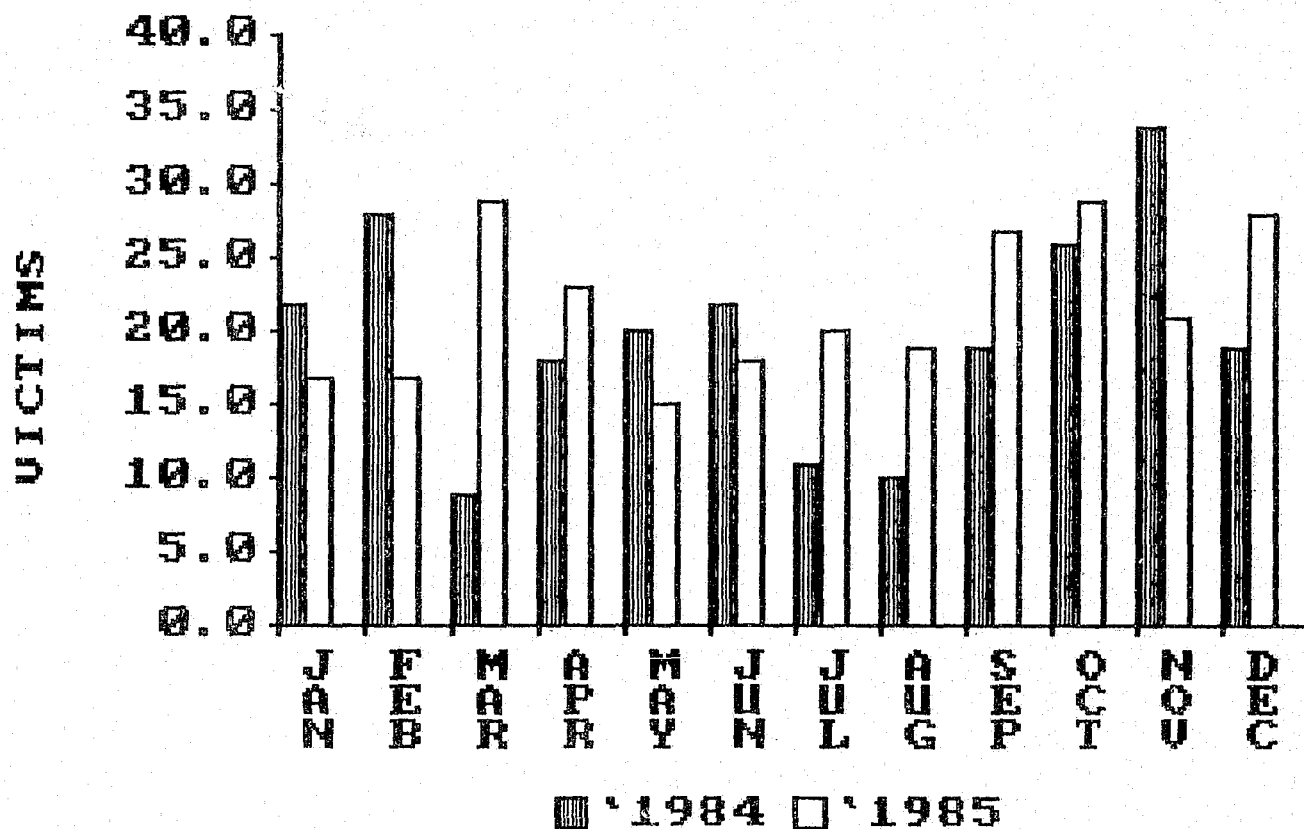

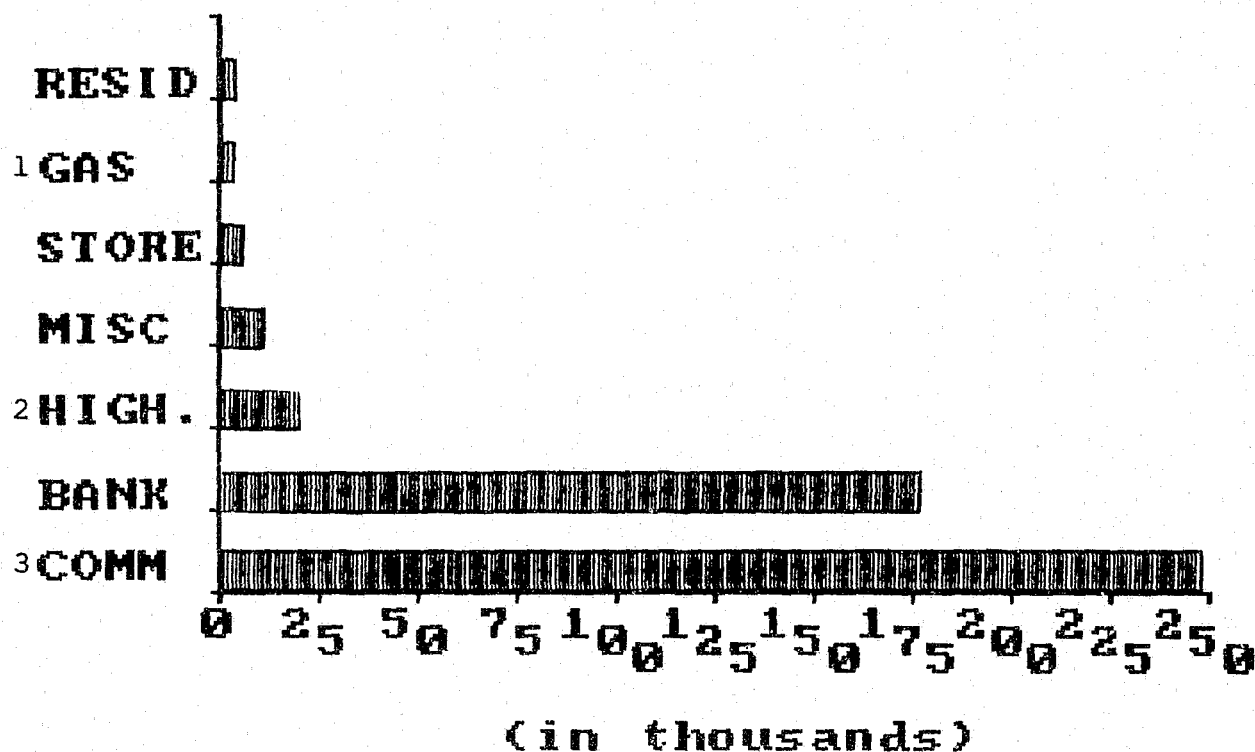

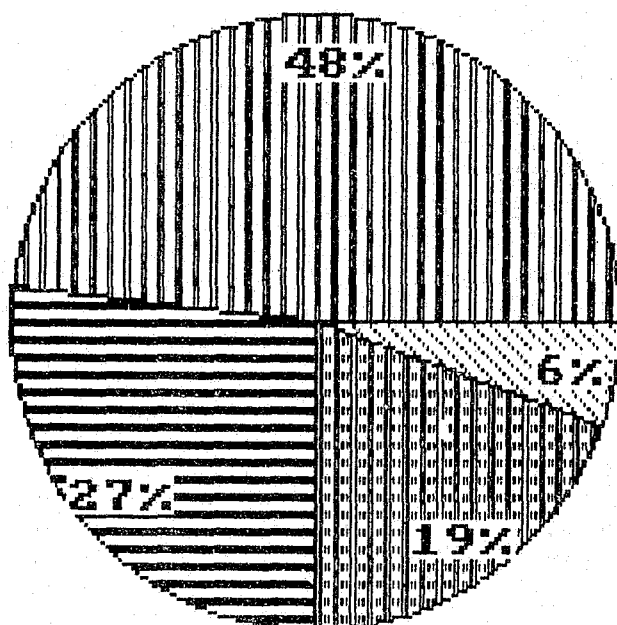

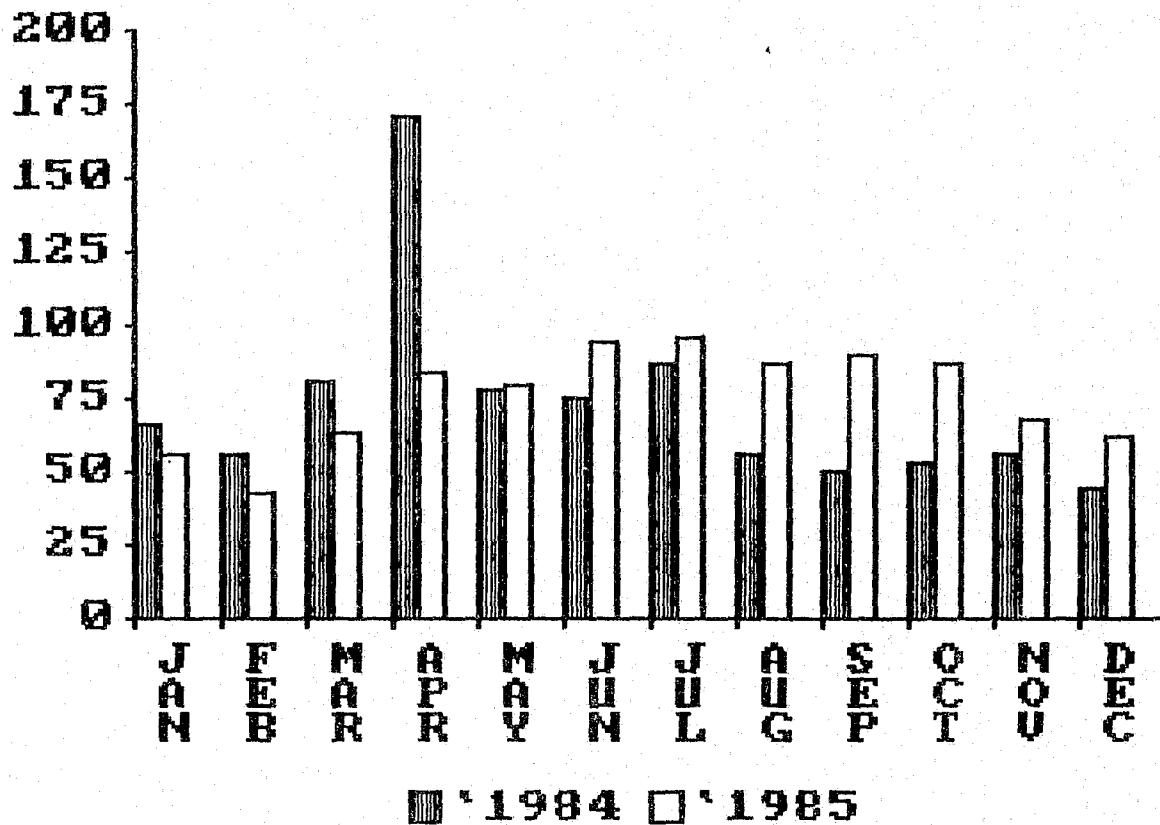
ASSAULT WEAPONS USED

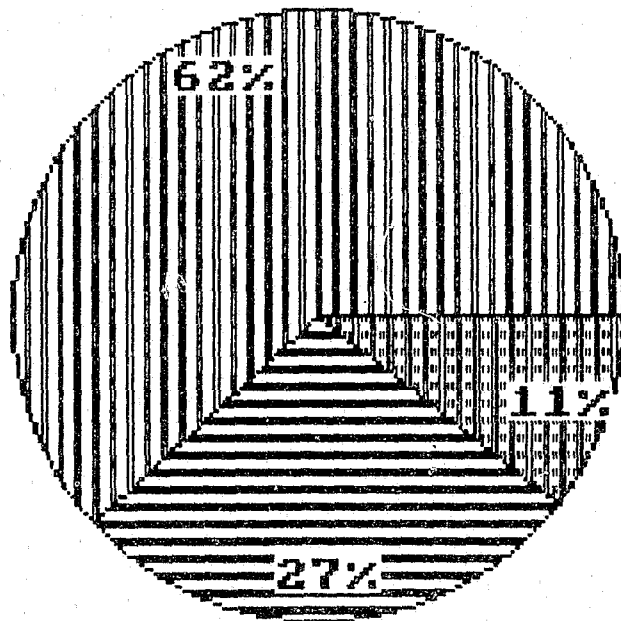

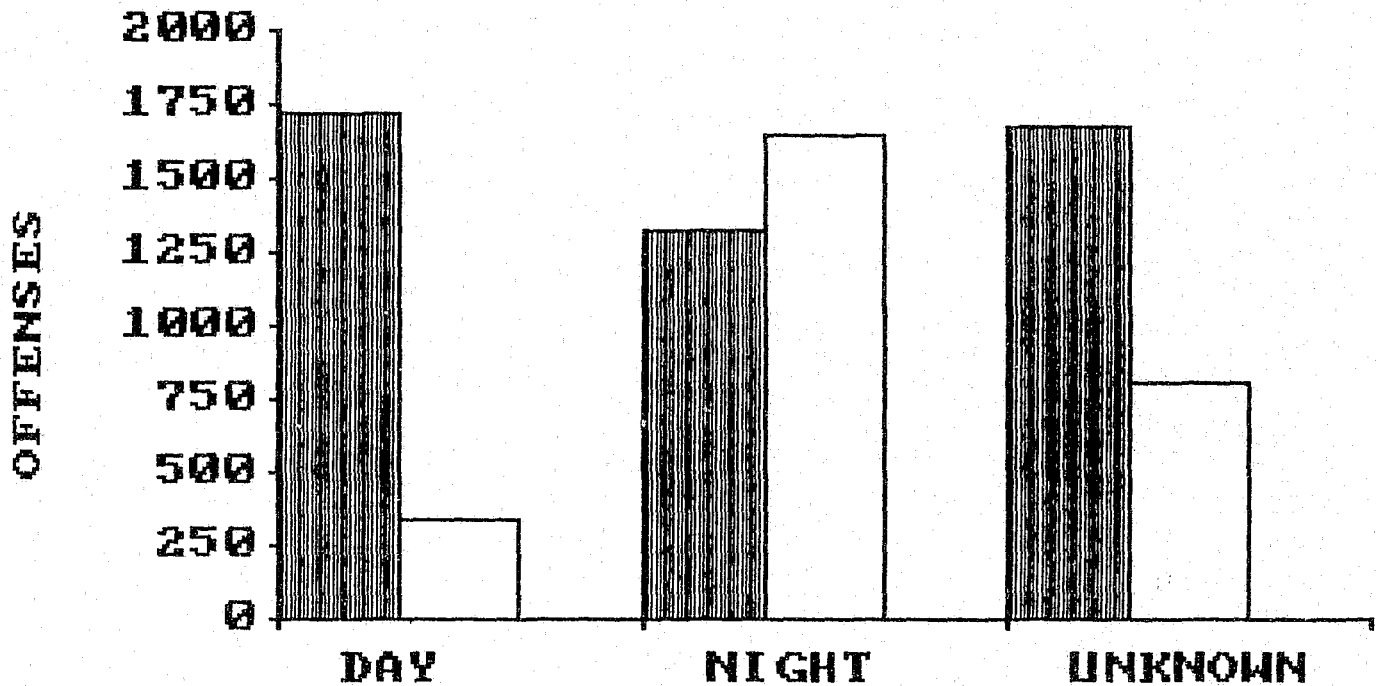

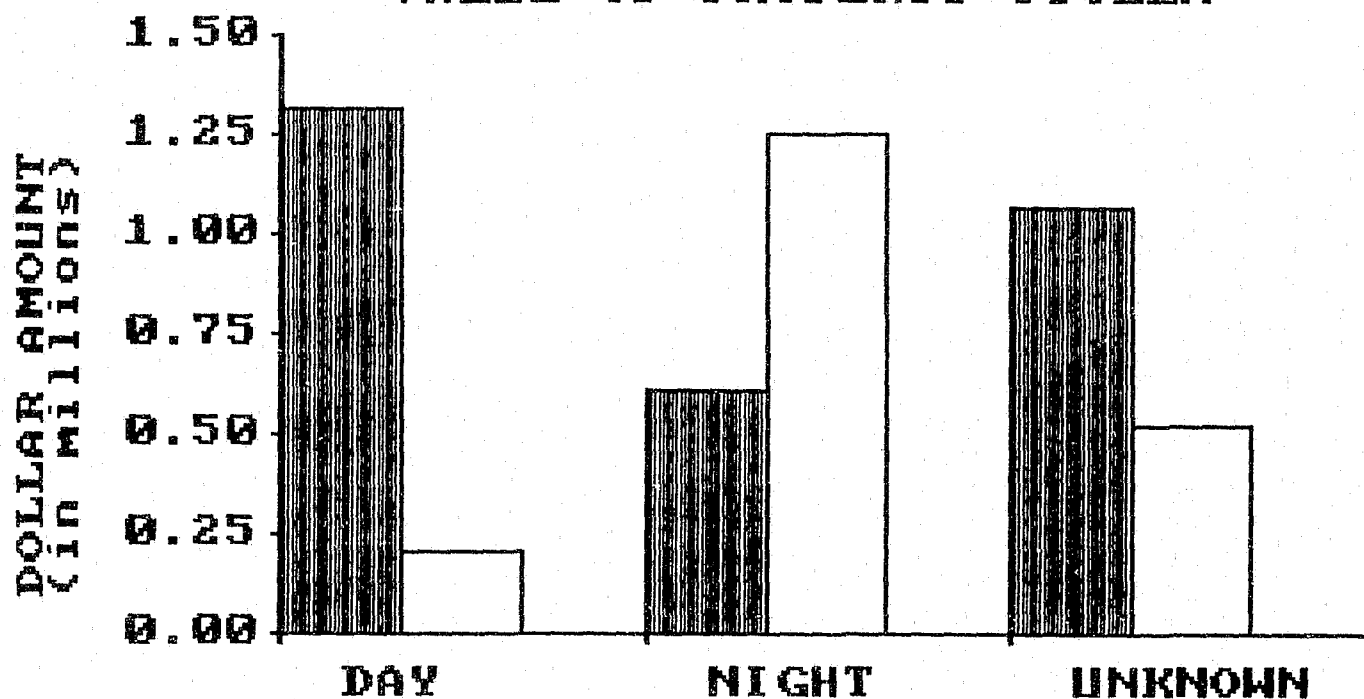

DOMESTIC ASSAULT

In 1979, the General Court mandated the Director of State Police to present an annual report to them concerning the nature and extent of domestic violence in our State. It was decided to collect this data in conjunction with the UCR program by adding a relationship category to the information collected in assaults. The following chart indicates the relationship of the offender to the victim along with the type of weapon used in aggravated assaults and the number of simple assaults for 1984:
