#### INTRODUCTION

The Department of Correctional Services (DOCS) released 13,966 offenders from facility custody during calendar year 1985. A major portion (9,901 or 70.9%) were released to parole supervision for the first time since their date of commitment to DOCS. This report presents descriptive data on a variety of attributes describing the characteristics of this group of offenders as well as data on the amount of time served in penal facilities.

The variables covered in this report include: gender; ethnic group; region; age on release; felony class; first/second felony sentence status; prior education; prior occupation; minimum sentence; maximum sentence; commitment offense; and median time served by crime. Charts showing the percent distributions of the variables are presented along with crosstabulations by time served in DOCS custody. Tables showing combined DOCS time plus local jail time are also included for selected variables.

In addition to the material on 1985 first releases a breakdown of the other 1985 release categories is provided. Also, the number of admissions by type and releases by type are shown for each calendar year covering the period 1976-1985.

#### HIGHLIGHTS


- 1. There were 13,966 total releases from Department of Correctional Services facilities during 1985. Of these, 9,901 were inmates released to parole supervision for the first time on their current sentence.
- 2. Ninety-six percent (9,492) of the 1985 first releases to parole supervision were males and 4% (409) were females.
- 3. Over half of the first releases (58.4% or 5,765) had been committed as violent felony offenders. Other violent/coercive felonies accounted for another 5.3% (526) while property/drug crimes made up 33.8% (3,333) of the first releases. The remaining 2.5% had been committed as Youthful Offenders.
- 4. The median time served in state prison for all first releases was 23.0 months. This figure increases to 29.9 months if time spent in local jail is also included.
- 5. Slightly over half (50.9%) of the first releases were black; 25.4% were white; 23.3% were Hispanic and 0.5% were other.
- 6. The large portion (68.7%) of the first release population had been committed from New York City. Upstate areas accounted for 19.2% followed by 12.1% from Suburban New York City areas.
- 7. The median age on release was 28.0 years. The largest age category on release was the 25-29 category with 2,476 followed by the 21-24 year old category at 2,376.
- 8. Over forty percent of the release population did not have a high school education at the time they were committed.
- 9. Only 37.8% of the released population had been employed as skilled or professional workers prior to incarceration.
- 10. Forty percent of those released had been committed as second felony offenders.















1985 INMATES DISCHARGED AGE ON RELEASE BY TIME SERVED (STATE TIME ONLY)




