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GENERAL INFORMATION

This investigation of the impact of the Vietnam War on a cohort of young men who attended high school in one Oregon county from 1963 to 1967, was funded by the National Institute of Mental Health (Grant Number MH34583; "Cohort Careers and the Vietnam Experience"). It is part of a larger project, The Marion County Youth Study; a longitudinal investigation of the process of maturational development in a cohort of young men (see "Becoming Adult: An Analysis of Maturational Development from Age 16 to 30 of a Cohort of Young Men," Final Report of the Marion County Youth Study, Polk et al, 1981).

The data documented in this codebook was collected specifically to assess the impact of military service on the lives of these men and to answer questions about the nature of "delayed stress" for combat veterans.

A total of 151 respondents were interviewed during the Summer and early Fall of 1981. Fifty-one were Vietnam Veterans, 48 served in the military during the Vietnam Era but were not stationed in Vietnam, and 51 had no military experience. For a detailed explanation of the sampling and data collection procedures, see "Cohort Careers and the Vietnam Experience," (Polk, et al., 1982) the final report of the cohort careers project.

The data was processed and coded using standard procedures for compatibility with statistical packages such as SPSS and SAS. The codebook format is modeled on that of the General Social Survey NORC codebook and includes:

- The question, exactly as it is worded on the interview schedule;
- Suggests name for each variable, compatible with previous Oregon Cohort designations;
- Lists of all possible response categories and the code or numeric value assigned to those responses (88, 98, and 99 represent missing or unusable data for 2 column variables; 888, 998, 999 for 3 column variables);
- The frequency of occurrence (marginal distribution) and percentage distribution for each variable (except those with large numbers of interval categories); and
- The record and column location of each variable on the computer tape.

Note that there are five sections in the codebook. The first consists of general background questions which were asked of all 151 respondents. The second section has questions which were asked of the 100 respondents with military service records. Section three was asked of only Vietnam

Veterans (N=52). The fourth and fifth sections consist of questions asked the Military, No Vietnam (N=48) and the No Military (N=51) groups (respectively). These questions parallel those asked of the Vietnam Veterans, and are coded in the same deck and column location, but the wording of the questions has been altered slightly to fit the circumstances (see page x, Questions Available for Each Study Group). Respondent groups not asked a particular question will have responses coded as zero.

The three groups are sorted or selected using variable V003T13 (page x). Categories 2, 5, and 8, should be combined to form the Vietnam Veteran group; 3 and 6 for the Military, No Vietnam; and, 4 and 7 for the No Military group.*

There are 14 card image records for each of the 151 cases. Identification numbers are coded in column 1-4 of each record; card numbers in columns 79-80.

Detailed information about the coding of multi-category two and three column variables is available in Appendices A through I. Appendix J contains information about the construction of indices used in the analysis of this data.

In addition to the coded data described in this codebook, there is a set of responses to open-ended questions included in the interviews. These questions are listed below and the transcribed responses are available from the Oregon Cohort Study.

*NOTE: The cases are arranged by group on the tape. If using SPSS, a subfile structure will facilitate data runs. See Appendix K for more information.

- Q.233 Are there times, or have there been times, since you left the military, when these occur more frequently than others? When were/are those times? What were you doing when this happened?
- Q.274 What are your thoughts about the Vietnam War and America's participation in it?


