

The Maine Alcohol and Drug Abuse Clearinghouse is an informational support service operating within the Division of Health Education, Bureau of Health, in the Department of Human Services. It serves as a central source for information about alcohol and other drugs, substance abuse prevention, treatment, research, and education. Requests may come directly from the public, from service providers, agency personnel, or from the five Alcohol and Drug Abuse Regional Councils.

Clearinghouse services will be most effective when they are:

- o in response to specific requests reflecting the needs of defined target populations, such as teens, women, families, employees, agency personnel, etc.;
- o not an isolated activity, but supplemental to other activities aimed at meeting the needs of that target population;
- o some sources are included for followup or further development.

The five Alcohol and Drug Abuse Regional Councils will be recognized as a followup for the requests for information. Other suggestions for followup or further involvement will be made appropriate to the needs of the requestor.

- o Consultation and technical assistance regarding the development and best use of materials.
- o Library searches including loan of materials and limited literature searches.
- o The Clearinghouse exchange newsletter, a resource for information sharing about alcohol and drug abuse.
