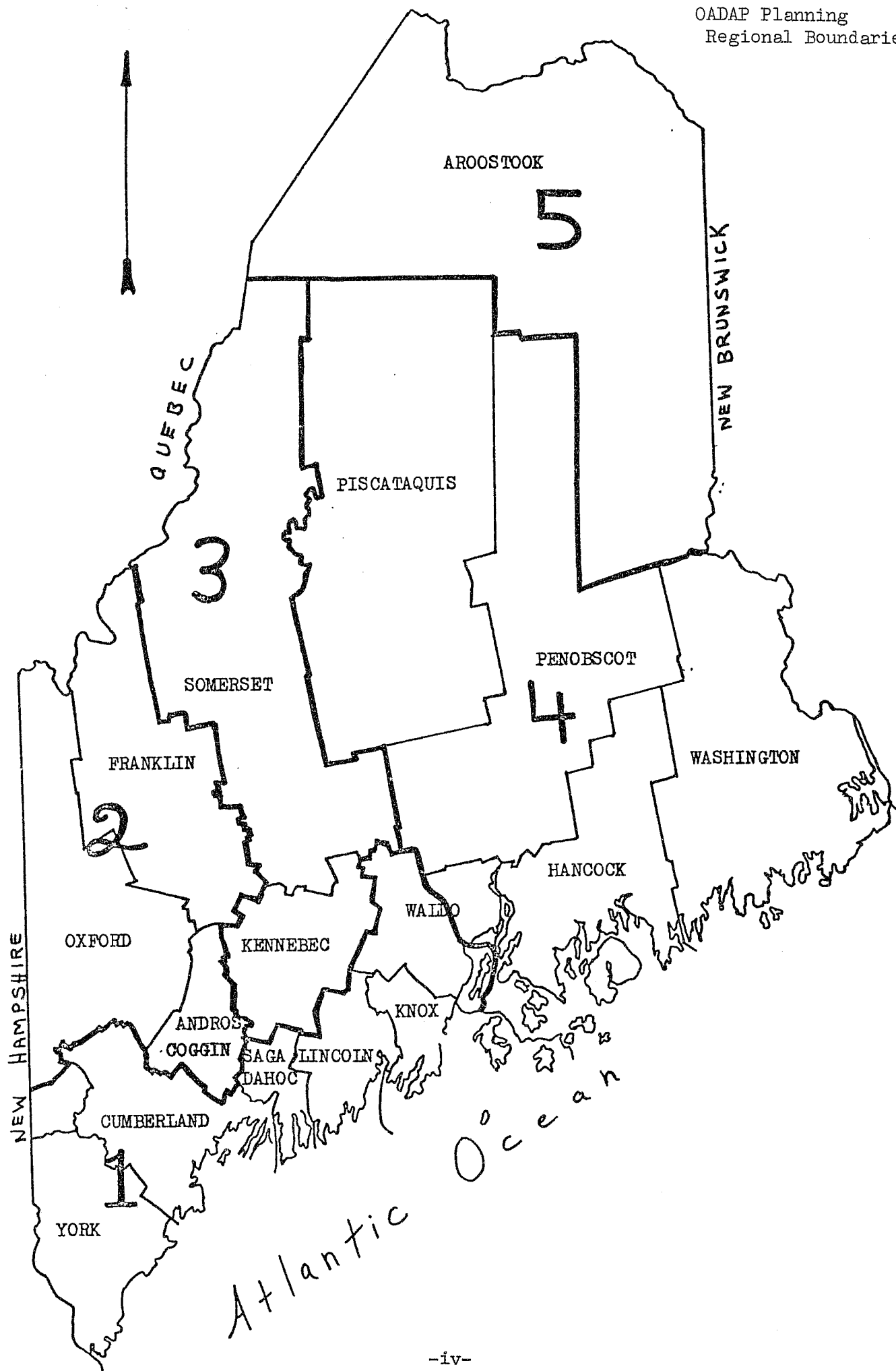

Requests may come directly from the public, from service providers, agency personnel, or from the five Alcohol and Drug Abuse Regional Councils.

- o Library searches including loan of materials and limited literature searches.
- o The Clearinghouse exchange newsletter, a resource for information sharing about alcohol and drug abuse.
