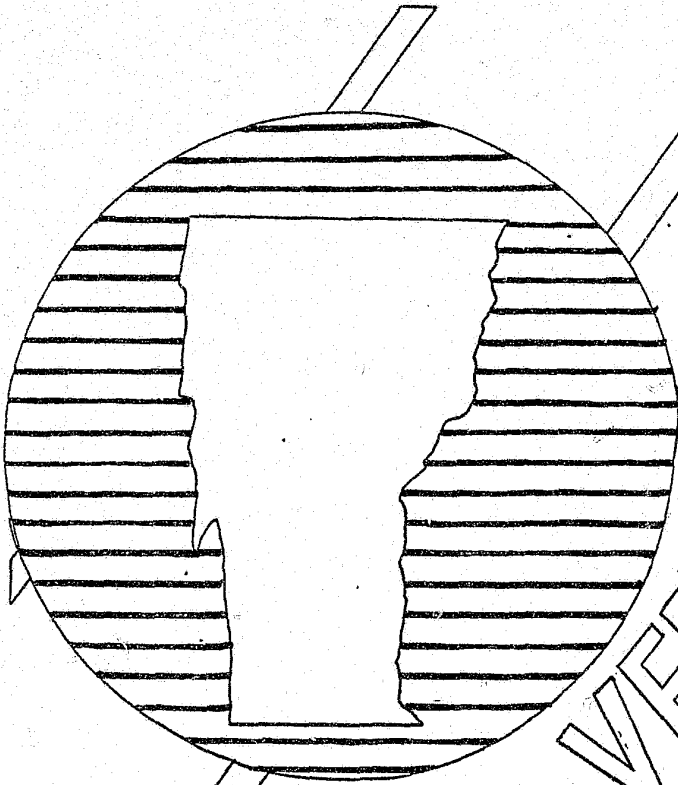


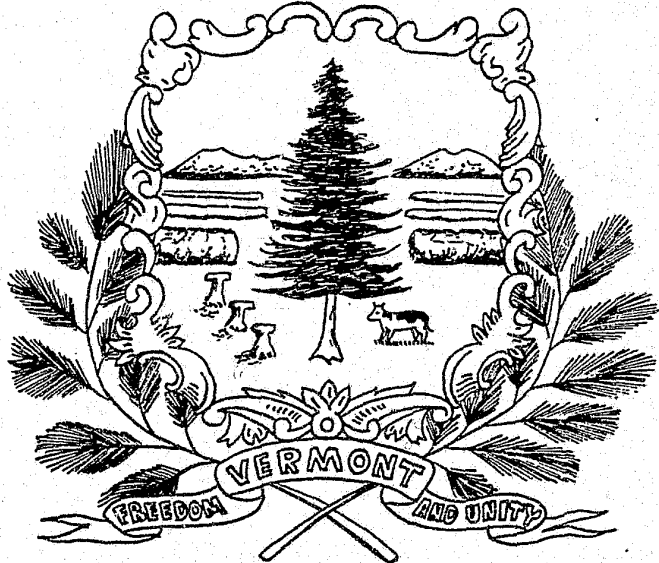

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HISTORY OF VLEIS

The Vermont Law Enforcement Information System (V.L.E.I.S.) is a computer based incident reporting system designed to provide for uniform statewide reporting by all law enforcement agencies. Funding for the system is provided by the Department of Public Safety.

Input forms are used to transmit agency activity and crime statistical information through the Vermont Criminal Information Center (V.C.I.C.) to the State Information System (S.I.S.) for processing. Weekly and monthly reports are generated which display officer activity, calls for service and crime statistical information.

V.L.E.I.S. was the result of years of study and planning, involving a significant number of people. The best features from a number of incident reporting systems were incorporated into a carefully tailored system to meet the needs of Vermont Law Enforcement.

Definitions Used In This Report

PART I CRIMES:

1) Homicide:

The willful or negligent killing of one human being by another.

2) Forcible Rape:

The carnal knowledge of a female forcibly and against her will.

3) Robbery:

The taking or attempting to take anything of value from the care, custody, or control of a person by force and/or by putting the victim in fear.

4) Burglary:

The unlawful entry of a structure to commit a felony or theft.

5) Larceny-Theft:

The unlawful taking, carrying, leading, or riding away of property from the possession or constructive possession of another.

6) Motor Vehicle Theft:

The theft or attempted theft of a motor vehicle.

7) Arson:

Willful or malicious burning or attempt to burn, with or without intent to defraud, a dwelling house, public building, motor vehicle or aircraft, personal property of another, etc.

8) Aggravated Assault:

An unlawful attack by one person upon another for the purpose of inflicting severe bodily injury.

PART II CRIMES:

1) Assault:

An unlawful attack by one person upon another.

2) Forgery and Counterfeiting:

All offenses dealing with the making, altering, uttering, or possessing, with intent to defraud, anything false in the semblance of that which is true.

3) Fraud:

A fraudulent conversion and obtaining of money or property by false pretenses.

4) Embezzlement:

Misappropriation or misapplication of funds or property entrusted to one's care, custody or control.

5) Stolen Property:

Includes all offenses of buying, receiving and possessing stolen property as well as attempt to commit the above.

6) Vandalism:

The willful or malicious destruction, injury, disfigurement or defacement of any property, real or personal, without consent of the owner.

7) Sex Offenses:

Offenses against common decency and morals, such as: Adultery, Incest, Indecent Exposure, Sodomy and Statutory Rape.

8) Drug Abuse Violations:

Relates to the unlawful possession, sale, use, growing, manufacturing and making of illegal substances.

9) Offenses Against Family and Children:

All charges of non-support and neglect or abuse of family or children.

PART II CRIMES (continued):

10. Liquor Violations:

With the exception of drunkenness and driving under the influence, liquor violations include: manufacture, sale and furnishing of illegal liquor, maintaining an unlawful drinking place and furnishing to a minor.

11) Disorderly Conduct:

In this class are placed all charges of committing a breach of the peace.

11) Disorderly Conduct:

12) Other:

This includes all offenses in the following headings:

- A) Carrying or Possessing Weapons
- B) Prostitution and Commercial Vice
- C) Illegal Gambling
- D) Vagrance
- E) Abduction, Kidnapping and many others

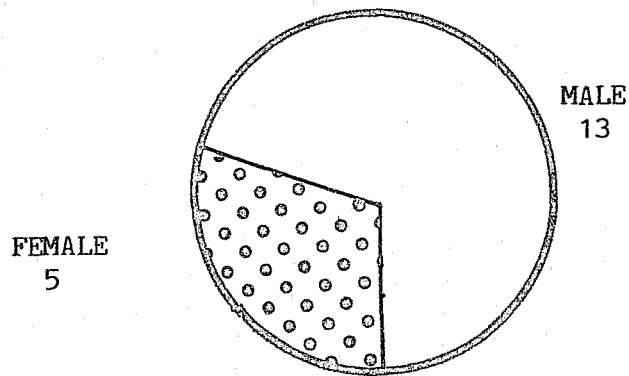


AGE OF ACCUSED

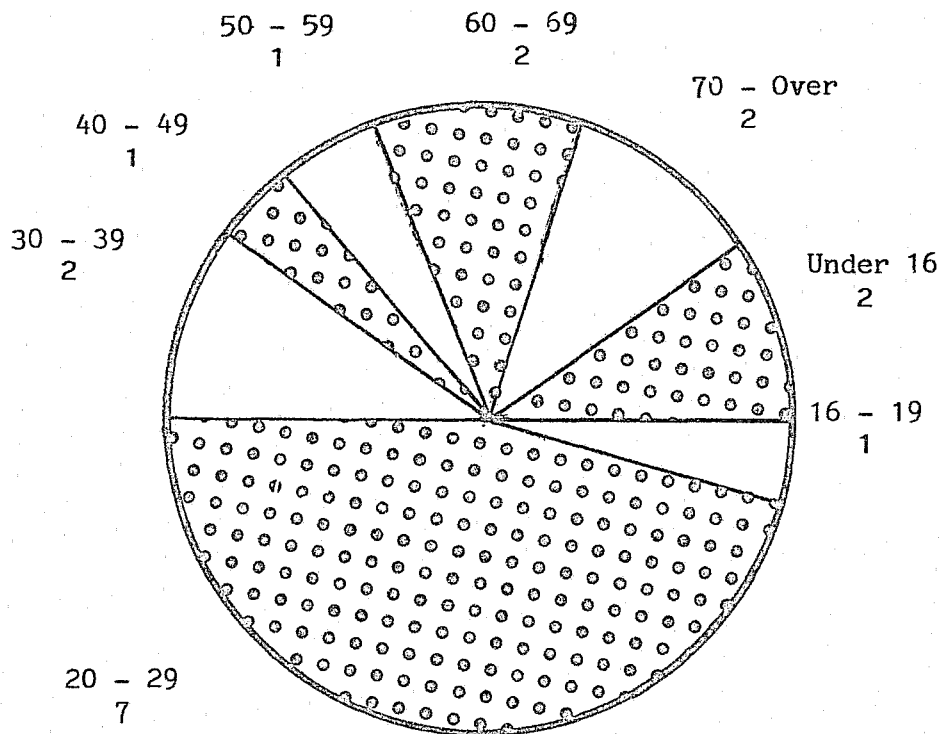

VICTIM

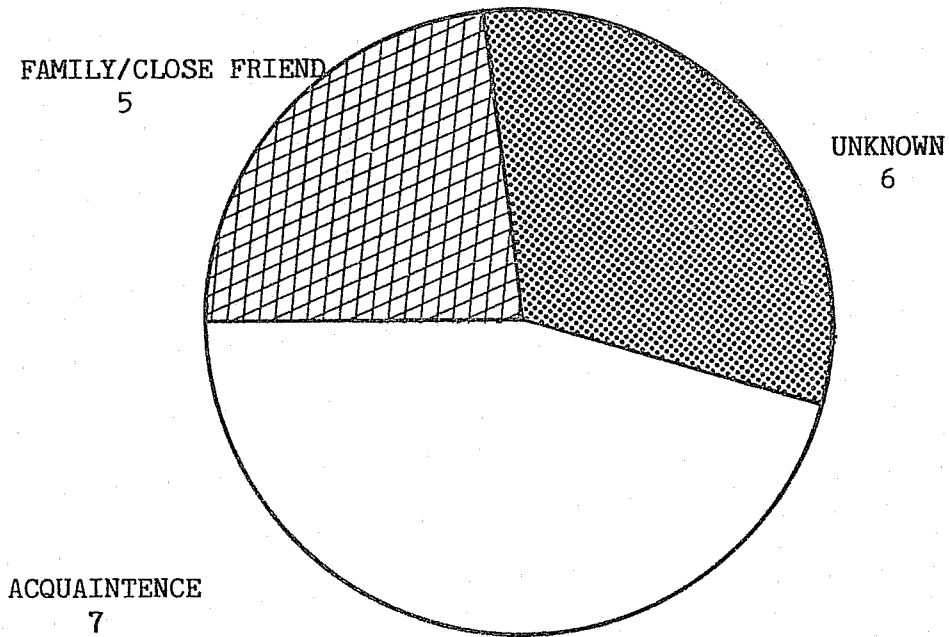

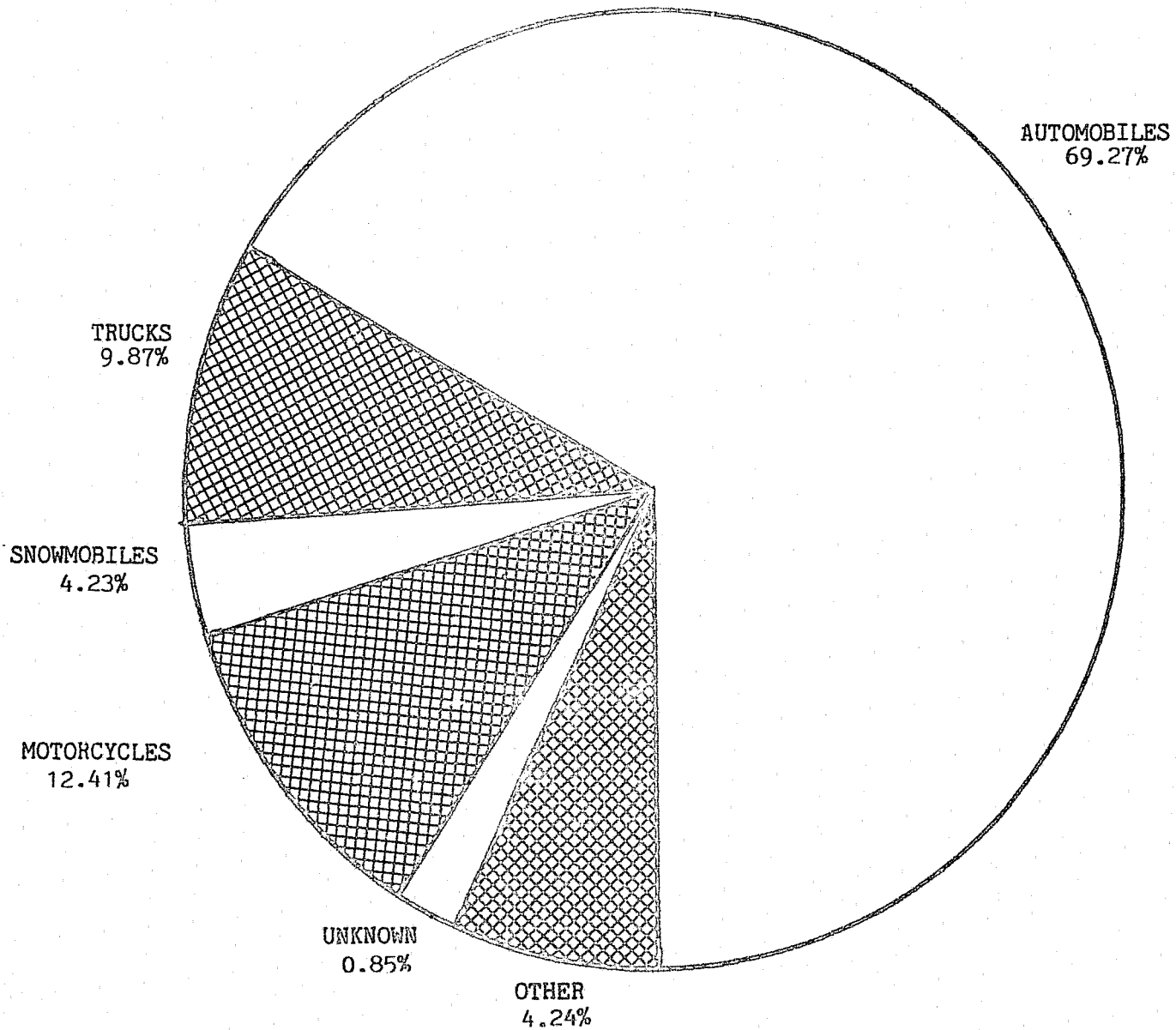


LARCENY BY TYPE



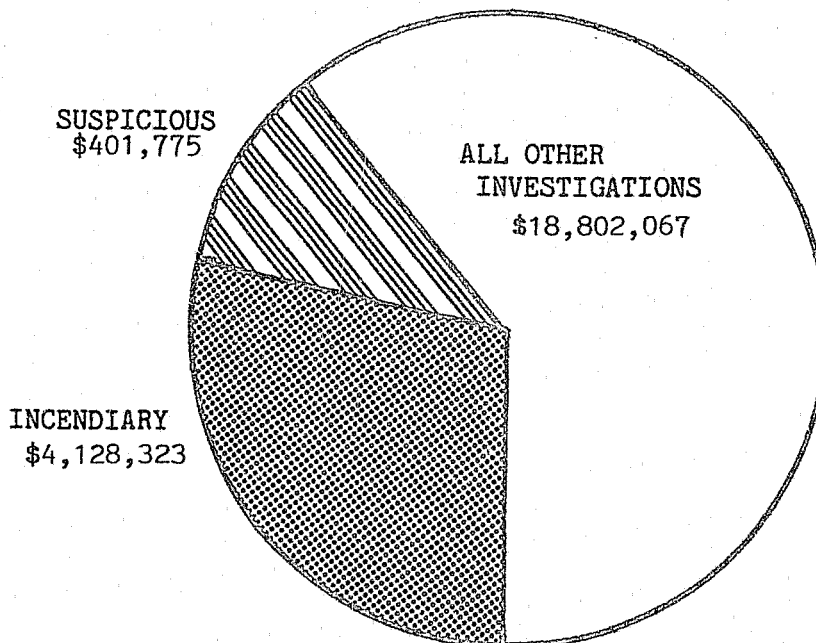
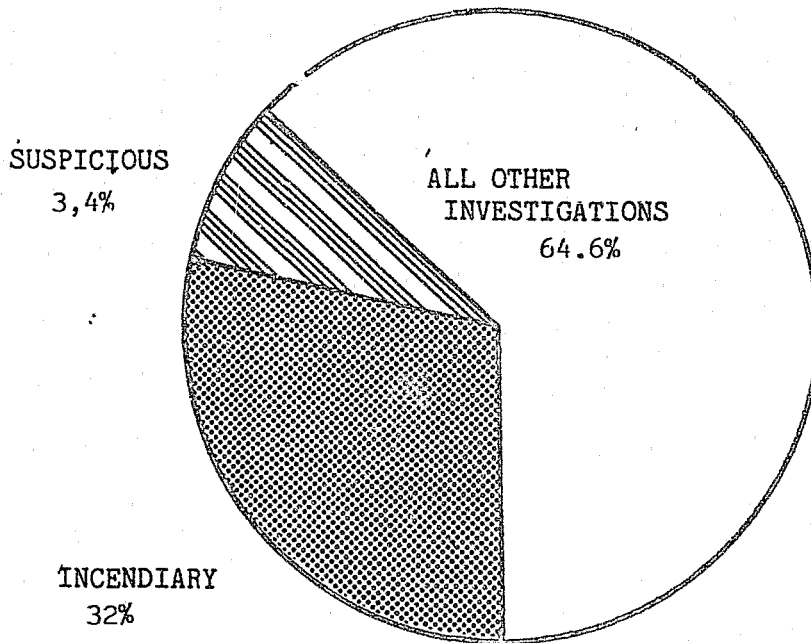
