INTRODUCTION

This report has been developed to provide information regarding selected characteristics for offenders under the jurisdiction of the New Jersey Department of Corrections who are on parole. The data compiled in this report are based on information contained in the Department of Corrections computer files as of December 31, 1987. The selected characteristics compiled in this report are Base Offense at Admission, Race/Ethnicity, Age and County of Commitment.

In this edition, note that the District Offices have been divided into four regions, with the Northern Region representing Districts 1, 4 and 12 (Clifton, Jersey City and Paterson), the Metro Region representing Districts 2 and 9 (East Orange and Newark), the Central Region representing Districts 3, 5 and 11 (Red Bank, Elizabeth and New Brunswick) and the Southern Region representing Districts 6, 7, 8 and 10 (Trenton, Camden, Atlantic City and Vineland).

Records of offenders convicted in New Jersey who are under active parole supervision in another state or whose time has maxed out but still owe a revenue obligation (penalty, fine, or restitution) are maintained at Department of Corrections' Central Office in Trenton. These cases are in the process of being assigned to a New Jersey District Office as the district of responsibility.

Out-of-State: The out-of-state designation represents offenders who were convicted in New Jersey but who are under active parole supervision out of state because of family ties or job location.

"NOT CODED" are records on offenders in the correctional system for which admission characteristic data has not been entered into the computerized information system as of this date.

Total parole population includes Prison, Young Adult and Juvenile parolees. Also included in the total parole population are 738 female offenders.

The Bureau of Parole, in addition to supervising state parolees, is responsible for the supervision of parolees who have served county sentences, usually of a year or less. These cases are not included in this report.

Note: Percentages in some tables and graphs do not total 100% due to rounding.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

The preparation of this report entailed the assistance of numerous individuals and reporting units. The extensive data collection effort was significantly enhanced by the assistance of the Correctional Information and Classification Services Data Base, the Prison and Youth Reception Units the Bureau of Parole and the Correctional Institutions that report data to the Data Base daily. Special acknowledgement is given to Mrs. Terry Lihvarcik, Head Statistical Clerk of the Correctional Information and Classification Services Central Office Report Preparation Unit for the compilation of data and the layout of the report.

HIGHLIGHTS

Forty-three percent of the total parole population consisted of persons who had committed crimes of a violent nature. Of these violent offenders, 51% or 3378 were on parole for robbery, 15% or 979 were on parole for homicide, 21% were on parole for assault, 12% were on parole for sexual assault and other sex offenses.

More than half of the total parole population was black, with District Office #2 in East Orange and District Office #9 in Newark together accounting for 32% of the black parole population.


More than nine-tenths of the total parole population (94%) are 71 years of age or older (including 41% between the ages of 21 and 29).

Forty percent of all offenders on parole were committed from the four (4) Northeast Counties of Bergen, Essex, Hudson and Passaic (with 2648 offenders, representing 18%, from Essex County alone.)

In these tabulations, the Base Offense for an offender is that which is the most serious offense at the time of admission. These figures reflect the base or controlling offense at admission only, and do not include offenses in addition to the base offense in the case of multiple sentences at admission, nor are additional sentences imposed following initial admission to the state correctional system included in this data.

Violent Crimes include homicide, sexual assault, aggravated assault, robbery and other sex offenses i.e. incest, carnal abuse, sodomy and impairing the morals of a minor.

Other Persons Offenses include simple assault, weapons offenses, coercion, larceny from a person and negligent manslaughter.

Property Offenses include arson, breaking and entering, theft, forgery, embezzlement, auto theft and receiving or possessing stolen property.


Public Policy Offenses include racketeering, gambling, prostitution, corruption, perjury, escape, bail jumping, juvenile or family-related offenses and conspiracy.

Narcotics Violations include distribution, manufacture and possession/use of drugs.

Almost one half (46%) of the total parole population consisted of offenders who had committed crimes of a violent nature or other persons offenses. Of the 6588 violent offenders, 51% or 3378 were on parole for robbery, 15% or 979 were on parole for homicide, 22% or 1421 were on parole for assault and 12% or 810 were on parole for sexual assault and other sex offenses.

Forty-three percent of all offenders on parole were convicted of a crime of a violent nature. More than half the offenders on parole from District Office 2 (East Orange), District Office 4 (Jersey City), District Office 7 (Camden) and District Office 9 (Newark) were convicted of violent crimes or other persons offenses. Offenders convicted of robbery comprise 22% of the total New Jersey parole population.

The "other" category includes Asian, Pacific Islander, American Indian and Alaskan Native.



More than one half (55%) of the total parole population was black, with the Metro region accounting for 32% of the Black parole population.

Thirty percent (4533) of the total parole population was white, with the Southern region accounting for the largest proportion of the White parole population (31%).

Two thousand three hundred sixty-one (15%) of the total parole population was Hispanic, with the Northern region supervising 38% of the Hispanic parole population.

BY AGE GROUPS




