

Offenders Released From Wisconsin Adult Correctional Institutions Calendar Year 1987

HIGHLIGHTS

- A total of 2,604 offenders were released from Wisconsin's correctional institutions for adults during calendar year 1987. Seven out of 10 (72.2 percent) were classified as first releases, approximately one-fourth (23.9 percent) as rereleases, and the remainder (3.9 percent) were offenders released after completion of revocation hearings or alternative to revocation placements, or for other reasons. (See Table 1)
- The majority, 89.9 percent of the males and 92.5 percent of the females were released to a community supervised status; i.e., parole, mandatory release, or special action early release. (See Table 2)
- Males released during 1987 were often serving sentences for unarmed burglary (27.1 percent), armed robbery (8.4 percent), and theft (7.8 percent), while females were frequently incarcerated for forgery (21.8 percent), theft (20.5 percent), and other drug offense (9.0 percent). (See Table 3)
- of the males and slightly more than three-fifths (63.4 percent) of the females released during 1987 were serving sentences of three years or less. The average (mean sentence for the total group was 60.2 months with males and females serving average sentences of 61.2 and 44.5 months respectively. These computations do not include six males with life sentences. (See Table 4)
- Almost two-fifths (37.7 percent) of the males were committed to the institutions from courts in Milwaukee County as were approximately three out of 10 (28.8 percent) of the females. Approximately one-third (32.0 percent) of the females and roughly one-fourth (24.1 percent) of the males were committed from Dane, Kenosha, Racine, and Rock Counties. (See Table 5)
- The average (mean) length of stay since most recent admission was 22.8 months for males and 16.8 months for females with an average (mean) for all releases during 1987 of 22.4 months. (See Table 6)
- Males rereleased during 1987 spent, since last new admission, an average (mean) of 55.1 months in the institution; females, an average (mean) of 41.9 months. Rereleases as a group spent an average (mean) of 54.6 months. (See Table 7)
- ° One-fourth (24.8 percent) of the males and females (25.0 percent) rereleased during 1987 had at least two prior releases to community supervision. (See Table 8)
- Just under three-fifths (55.2 percent) of the males and two-fifths (41.0 percent) of the females released during 1987 were White. (See Table 9)

- One-half (52.0 percent) of the males and three-fifths (62.8 percent) of the females released during 1987 were classified as property offenders. Over one-fourth (26.6 percent) of the males were classified solely as assaultive offenders while less than one-tenth (8.9 percent) were categorized solely as drug offenders. About one-fifth (20.5 percent) of the females were categorized solely as assaultive offenders while one-tenth (10.3 percent) were classified solely as drug offenders. (See Table 10)
- Less than one-tenth (5.1 percent) of the males and only three (1.9 percent) of the females released during 1987 were turned over to authorities from other jurisdictions on detainer status. (See Table 11)
- Somewhat less than one-fifth (16.7 percent) of the males, as contrasted with almost two-fifths (37.9 percent) of the females, took part in adult basic education courses while institutionalized. (See Table 13)
- ° Less than one-fifth (17.9 percent) of the males and just over one-fourth (26.3 percent) of the females released during 1987 participated in GED or HED courses prior to release.
- Three-fourths of the males (74.8 percent) and females (77.6 percent) did not take part in high school classes while confined. High school diplomas were earned by 22 males and 8 females prior to release. (See Table 14)
- Participation in institution programs designed to assist offenders in dealing with problems stemming from the use of both alcohol and other drugs was noted for slightly more than one-tenth (12.8 percent) of the males and one-fourth (25.6 percent) of the females released during 1987. (See Table 15)
- Less than one-fifth of the males (17.0 percent) and females (16.0 percent) took part in some type of work release program while incarcerated. (See Table 16)
- ° Forty-five males (1.9 percent) and 19 females (2.6 percent) released during 1987 participated in study release. (See Table 17)
- Almost one-fourth (23.0 percent) of the males and somewhat less than one-fifth (16.0 percent) of the females took part in some type of vocational or apprenticeship program prior to release. (See Table 18)
- Eighty-seven males (3.7 percent) and 11 females (7.1 percent) participated in some type of college study program during their stay in the institution. (See Table 19)
- Males serving sentences for unarmed burglary, armed robbery, and theft, which were the crimes most often committed by males first-released in 1987, spent an average (mean) of 22.1, 45.6, and 16.7 months respectively in the institution. Females released after commitment for forgery, theft, and other drug violations, the offenses most frequently reported for females first-released in 1987, spent an average (mean) of 17.5, 14.0, and 11.2 months in the institution. (See Table 20)

- Males serving sentences for the most common offenses among those rereleased in 1987 (unarmed burglary, armed robbery, and theft) served an average (mean) of 15.6, 31.3, and 14.0 months between the time of reinstitutionalization and rerelease. Females rereleased in 1987 who were serving sentences for forgery and theft, the crimes for which rereleased females had most often been sentenced, spent an average (mean) of 15.8 and 9.3 months in the institution. (See Table 21)
- First-released males who were serving five-year sentences were institutionalized for an average (mean) of 29.9 months prior to release while female first-releases with five-year sentences spent an average (mean) of 24.2 months in the institution. (See Table 22)
- Males and females with five-year sentences who were released from the institution and returned following revocation of some type of field supervision spent an average of 12.6 and 10.5 months in the institution prior to being rereleased during 1987. (See Table 23)
- Nine out of 10 (87.6 percent) of the males and females released during 1987 planned to live somewhere within the State of Wisconsin. With the exception of two males the remainder (12.4 percent) of the releases intended to live elsewhere in the United States. (See Table 24)
