**COUNTY DETENTION FACILITIES:  
INMATE PROFILE SUMMARY  
DECEMBER - 1988**

**ABSTRACT**

The County Detention Facilities Summary provides a monthly profile of Florida's detention facilities inmate population. Average daily population figures for December, 1988 are collapsed into male and female categories for both adult and juvenile inmates. These population figures are also categorized into felony, misdemeanor and "other" subcategories in order to facilitate interpretation. Within both felony and misdemeanor subcategories the number of inmates held for trial or sentencing and those detained or sentenced for violation of probation will be presented for December, 1988. The "other" subcategory documents the number of parole violators, state inmates, undocumented aliens, holdings for other jurisdictions and individuals detained under the Baker (mental health) and Myers (alcoholism) Acts. In addition, the average daily population figures, the incarceration rates for each county, the number of overcrowded county detention facilities and the pretrial inmate levels for each facility are included in this report. County detention facilities with amended capacities since November, 1988 are denoted in table 3.

COUNTY DETENTION FACILITIES:  
PROFILE DATA SUMMARY  
DECEMBER 1988

Average Daily Population

On the average, there were 29,859 inmates in Florida's county detention facilities during the month of December, 1988. This figure represents a 3.7 percent decrease in the inmate population level from that reported for November, 1988. Since the data collection effort began in 1986 a modest seasonal decrease in the number of inmates housed in Florida's county detention facilities during the month of December has been documented.

The statewide average daily population (ADP) totals for December, 1988 include 26,381 adult males (88.4%), 2,851 adult females (9.5%), and 627 juvenile offenders (2.1%). The overall distribution of male and female inmates has remained fairly constant in county detention facilities for the past three years. The following provides an analysis of the inmate population for December, 1988.

- \* 76.5% of the inmate population were incarcerated for felony offenses, while 18.9 percent were detained for misdemeanor crimes.
- \* Offenders held for trial represented 65.0% of the inmate population and 21.3 percent were sentenced on either felony or misdemeanor crimes.
- \* Inmates detained for violation of probation represented 7.3% of the inmate population.

### Incarceration Rates

In December of 1988, the statewide county detention facility incarceration rate was 2.4 per 1,000 county residents based on the population estimate for 1988. Incarceration rates range from a low of 0.8 in Charlotte and Liberty Counties to a high of 7.1 per 1,000 population in Hamilton County. Hamilton County's extremely high incarceration rate is the direct result of holding a large proportion of their inmate population for the U.S. Marshals Service. Several other counties may also be experiencing high incarceration rates due to the contracting of bed space.

### Overcrowding: Capacity Versus Population

In December, 1988, 34.3 percent (23) of the counties in the State of Florida had average daily inmate populations which exceeded their Department of Corrections (DC) rated capacity. Twenty four percent (16) of Florida's counties had average daily inmate populations that were between 1 and 25 percent over their DC rated capacity, 6.0 percent (4) had inmate daily averages that were between 26 and 50 percent over capacity, and 4.5 percent (3) of the counties had average daily inmate populations which exceeded the rated capacity by more than 50 percent.

### Pretrial Population Levels

During the month of December, 1988, 65% of the inmates housed in county detention facilities were classified as awaiting trial. Of these 19,291 offenders, 86.7% percent were awaiting trial for felony offenses while 13.3% were detained for misdemeanor violations.

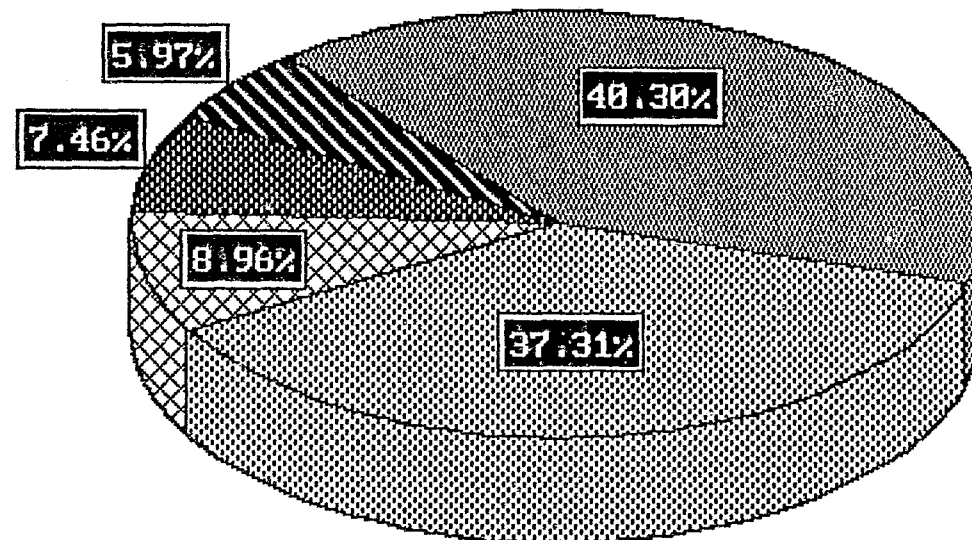

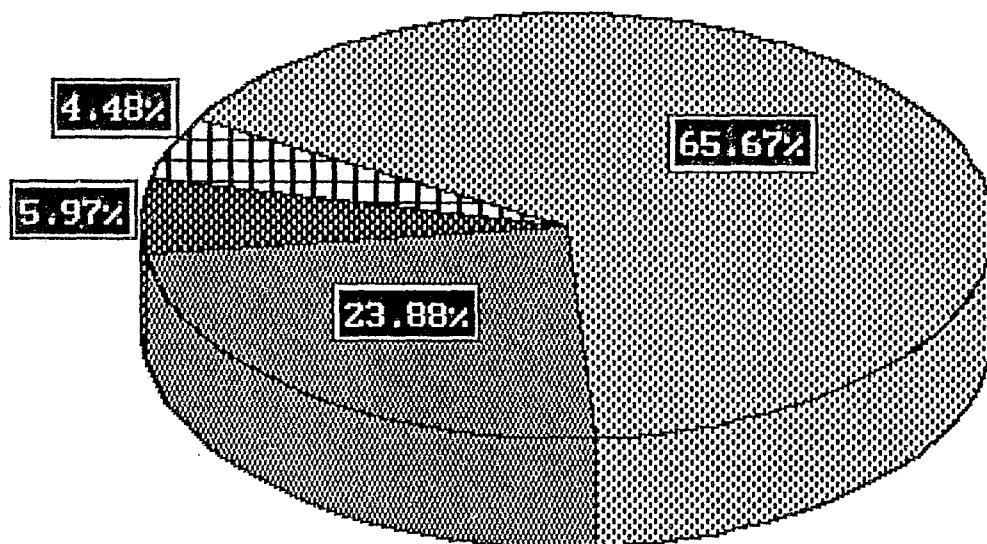

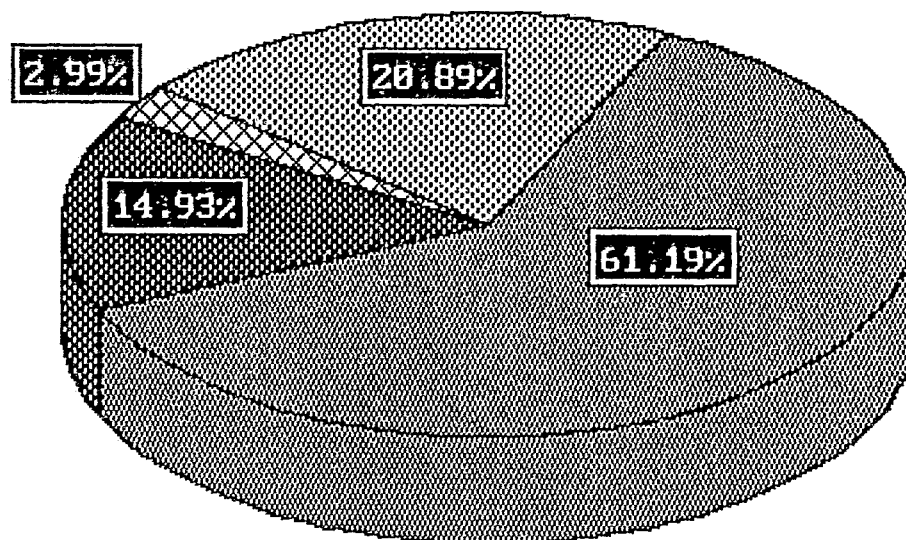
