In 1988 Montana experienced a substantial decrease in traffic fatalities. The 198 recorded traffic fatalities is the lowest number of deaths since 1958 when 193 Montanans lost their lives on Montana's highways.

To you and the citizens of Montana, I respectfully submit this 1988 report of accident analysis.

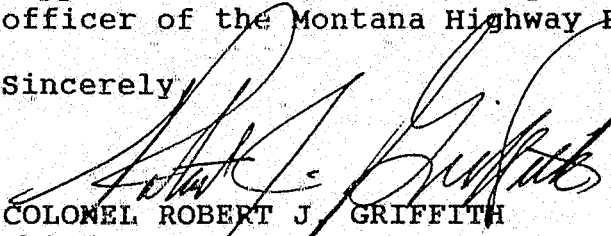

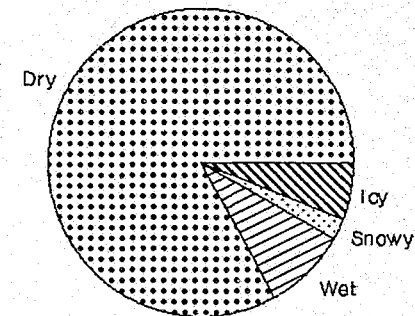
Trend of Alcohol Related Accidents in Relationship to D.U.I. Enforcement



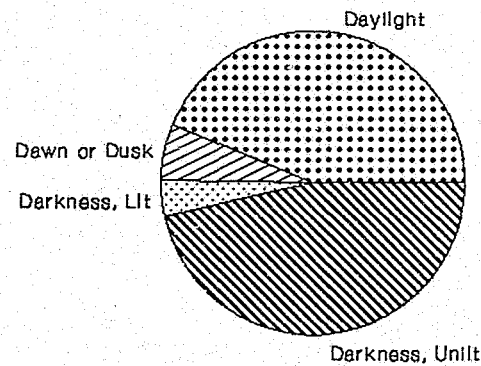
Fatal Accidents - 1988 By Weather Conditions



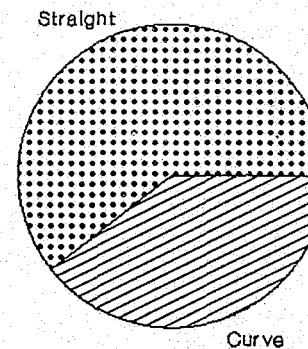
Fatal Accidents - 1988 By Road Conditions

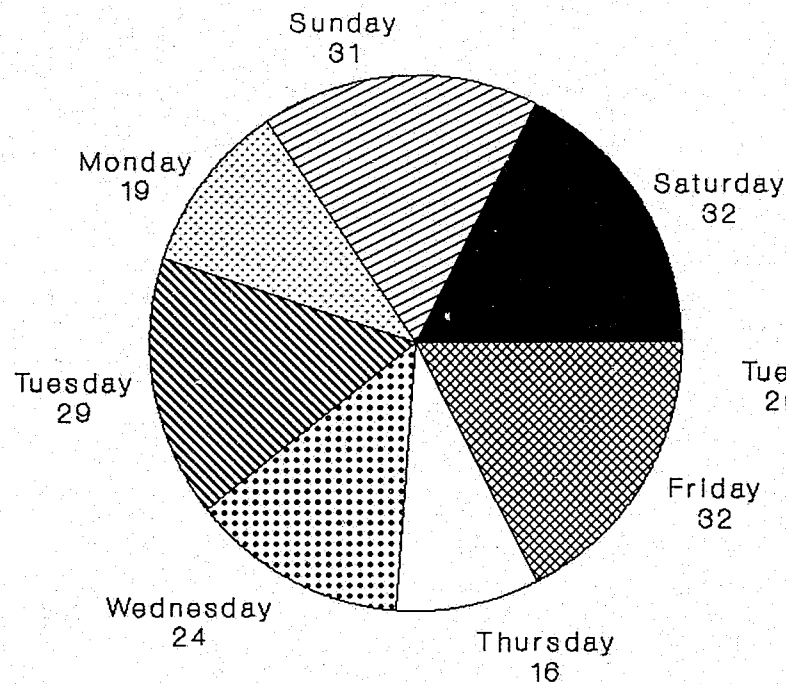

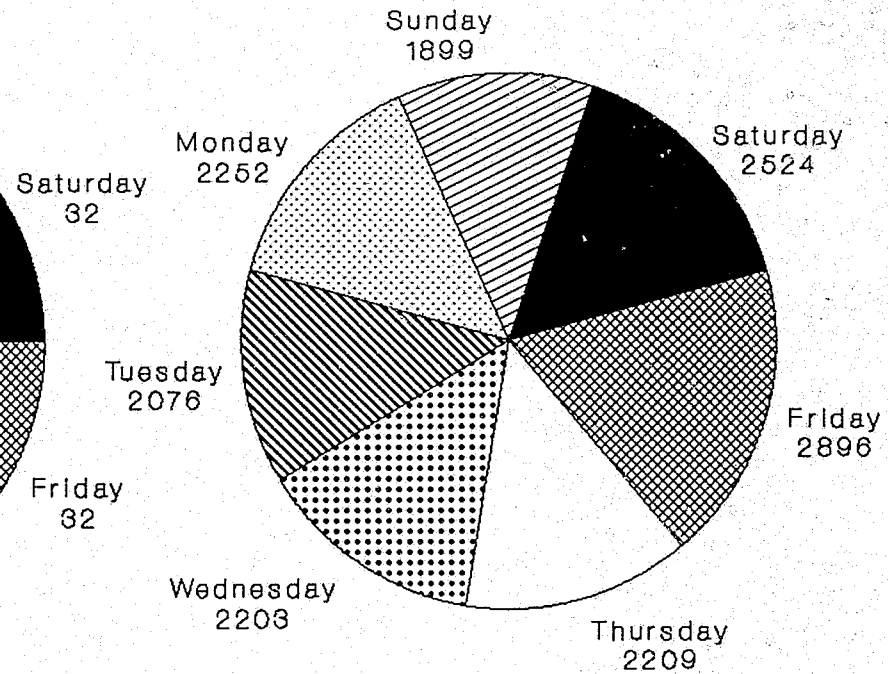

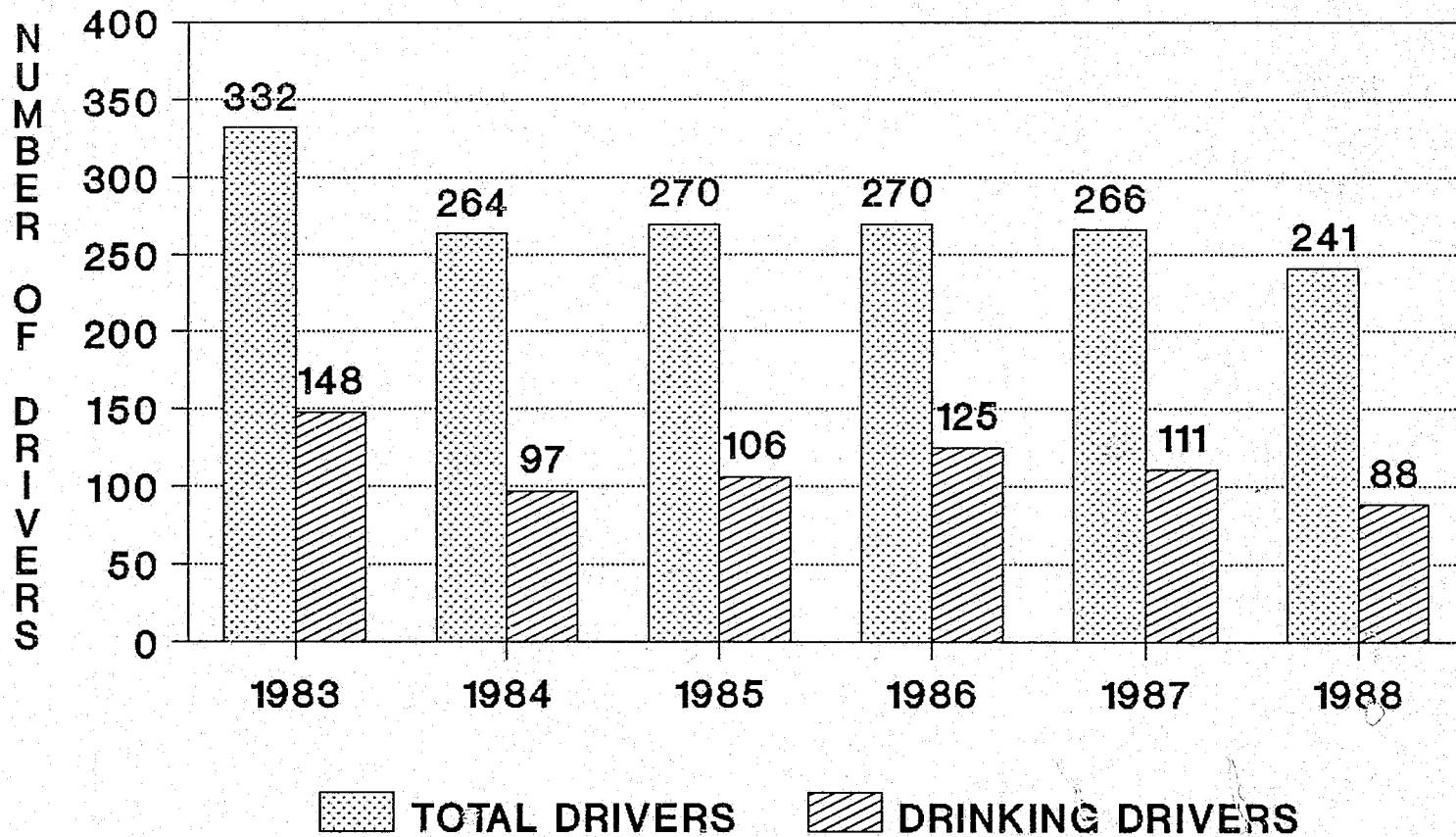

ANALYSIS OF LARGE TRUCK/TRACTOR TRAILER
FATAL ACCIDENTS IN MONTANA IN 1988

Fatal truck accidents during 1988 claimed the lives of four truck drivers, thirteen drivers or passengers in other vehicles, and one pedestrian. Thirteen of the seventeen accidents involved two or more vehicles.

Of the seventeen fatal truck accidents, two involved tractors with double trailers, ten involved semi-trucks and trailers, one truck and pole trailer, and four were straight trucks.

Of these seventeen fatal accidents, six truck drivers were in violation of the law. These included two violations for careless driving, two violations for fail to yield the right-of-way, and two violation for speed to fast for conditions. Ten truck accidents were caused by drivers of automobiles while one was caused by a pedestrian.

Eleven of the fatal accidents occurred on primary highways of Montana, five occurred on the interstate system, and one on a county road.

Ten of the seventeen accidents occurred during daylight hours, the other seven occurred during the hours of darkness.

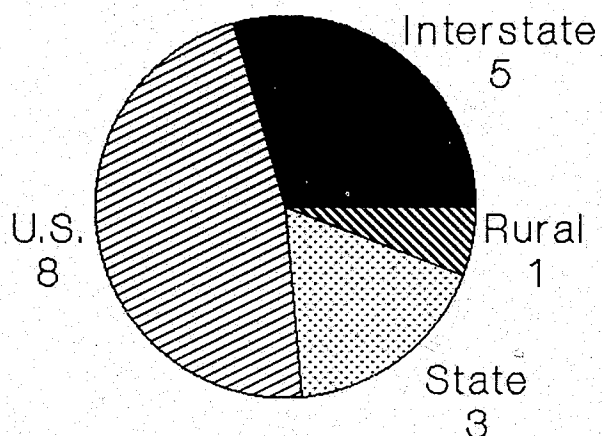
Since 1985 when Montana first began truck inspections, the number of commercial vehicle accidents has declined from 1,343 in 1985 to 1,059 in 1988. The number of fatal accidents has declined from 35 in 1985 to 33 in 1986 to 23 in 1987 to 17 in 1988. It appears that the truck inspection program is having a favorable effect on reducing accidents along with the increased interest of the truck drivers and also the emphasis that is placed upon safe operations by the various trucking companies.

It appears that this program as a team effort has been successful. With a great deal of effort and cooperation in the future this reduced low level of traffic accidents can be maintained for the benefit of the motoring public.

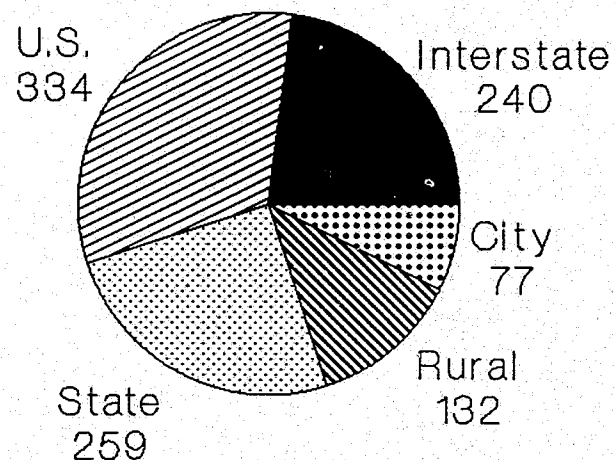

TRUCK/TRUCK TRACTOR Accidents By Route - 1988



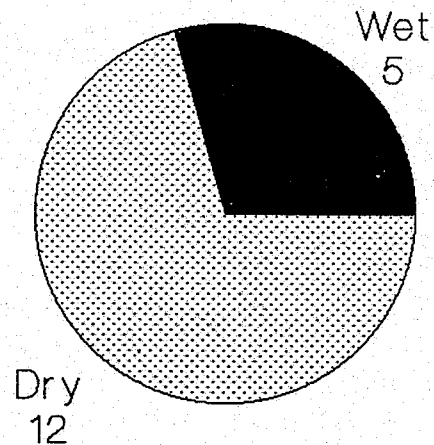

Accidents By Collision Type - 1988

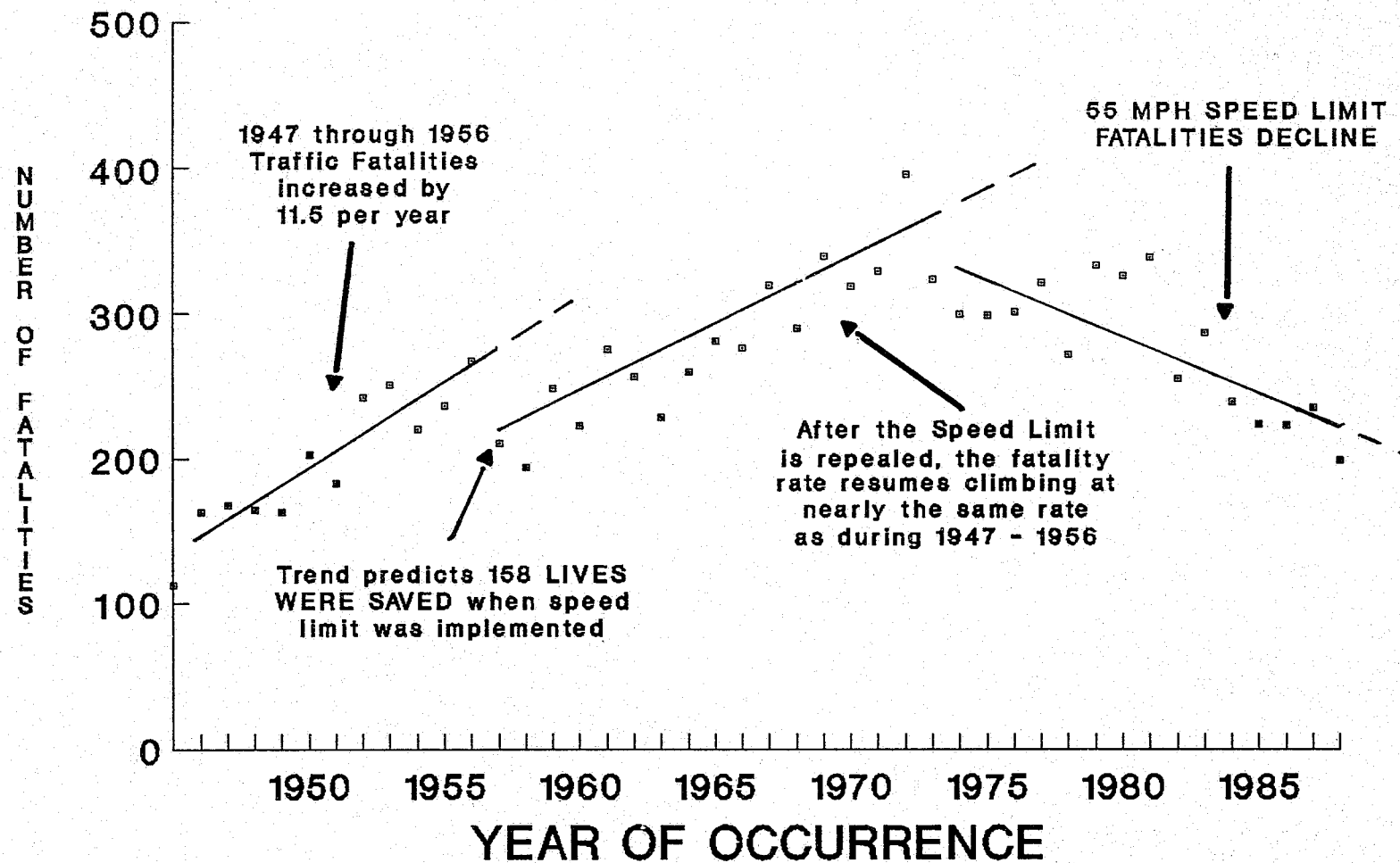
