REPORT ON REVOCATION HEARINGS JULY 1, 1986 THROUGH JUNE 30, 1988

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SUMMARY

This report deals with revocation hearings conducted by the Board of Prison Terms, actions taken at the Parole Revocation Screening Calendar, and hearings waived during FY 1986/87 and FY 1987/88.¹

REVOCATION ACTIONS VS. PAROLE POPULATION

Graph I shows an increasing trend throughout the two-year period in both California supervised parole population and the number of revocation hearings, screenings, and waivers. As shown in Table I, the average California supervised parole population was 29,266 in FY 1985/86. It sustained annual increases of 16.07% to 33,968 in FY 1986/87 and 22.74% to 41,692 in FY 1987/88. The total number of hearings, screenings, and waivers also increased for the same period. In FY 1985/86, the total number was 23,181, rising by 49.26% to 34,600 in FY 1986/87. The following by the number increased 44.74% to vear 50,079. Additionally, the rate of hearings, screenings, and waivers to total parole population increased from 79.21% in FY 1985/86 to 101.86% in FY 1986/87 and then further increased to 120.12% during FY 1987/88.

REVOCATION HEARINGS CONDUCTED

shown on Table II-A, Region II continued to have As · the largest volume of revocation hearings conducted in FY 1986/87. Over one-fourth (26.12% or 3,014) of the 11,538 revocation hearings conducted during FY 1986/87 were in Region II. The three other regions had somewhat smaller rates: 18.75%, 17.20%, and 16.74% for Regions I, III, and IV, respectively. Together, the Northern and Southern Reception Centers and other institutions accounted for the remaining 21.20% of the hearings. During FY 1987/88, from Table II-B, the trend changed in that Region III now had the largest number of hearings conducted (17.99% of 14,321). II, I, and IV had 17.10%, 15.77%, and 14.08%, Regions The number of hearings conducted at the respectively. Reception Centers increased significantly with Reception Center South having 14.73%, and Reception Center North 12.55%. Other Institutions had a 7.78% share. This trend is shown in Graphs II-A and II-B.

¹Actions taken at the Parole Revocation Screening Calendar may result in either a waiver or a hearing.

SCREENINGS/WAIVERS

The number of cases screened and/or hearings waived for both fiscal years are plotted in Graphs III-A and III-B. During FY 1985/86 there were 14,082 cases screened and/or waived; the number rose by 63.77% to 23,062 during FY 1986/87. The total further increased by 55.05% to 35,758 during FY 1987/88. Region IV had the highest volume of screenings and waivers, 27.50% and 30.07% in FY 1986/87 and FY 1987/88, respectively. On a quarterly basis, the statewide volume of screenings and waivers appears to cluster towards the second half of the fiscal years- 32.48% and 29.76% during the third and fourth quarters of FY 1986/87, respectively, and 24.39% and 29.73% during the same period in FY 1987/88. (Refer to Tables III-A and III-B).

SCREENINGS POSTPONED WITH DEPUTY COMMISSIONERS PRESENT

As shown in Tables IV-A and IV-B, the number of revocation hearings postponed with deputy commissioners present totaled 672 during FY 1986/87, up by 18.73%, and 857 during FY 1987/88, up by 27.53%. For FY 1986/87, while the most hearings were conducted in Region II, the most postponements were in Region III (198 or 29.46% of the total). During FY 1987/88, the most hearings were in Region III (2,576) as well as the most hearings postponed (237 or 27.65% of the total).

ATTORNEY DETERMINATIONS

Tables V-A and V-B give the number of hearings bv institution/parole region at which an attorney was either waived or requested, and of those requested, the number granted or denied. The percent rates at which attorneys were waived were highest in Regions I and II, 79.50% and during FY 1986/87, and 81.31% and 75.50% 79.17% in FY 1987/88, respectively. Regions III and IV had the highest rates for attorney requests, 41.63% and 41.13% during FY 1986/87, and 39,89% and 33.80% in FY 1987/88, respectively. Requests were granted most frequently in Region IV (36.66%) during FY 1986/87 and in Region III (35.35%) in FY 1987/88. Excluding Other Institutions, requests were denied most often in Region I (74.89%) in FY 1986/87 and in Region II (76.42%) for FY 1987/88.

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AVERAGE LENGTH OF REVOCATION HEARINGS

Tables VI-A and VI-B show the total length of time spent on revocation hearings. During FY 1986/87, average preparation time ranged from a low of 17 minutes (Region I) to a high of 20 minutes (Reception Center-South). The statewide average remained at the previous year's level of 18 minutes, and in FY 1987/88, the statewide average was 17 minutes.

The average actual hearing time declined by 5.00% to 38 minutes in FY 1986/87, with Region I showing a high of 41 minutes and Other Institutions with a low of 34 minutes. On a quarterly basis, the statewide average hearing time remained fairly stable, varying only in the third quarter when it rose to 39 minutes and then back down to 38 minutes for the fourth quarter of FY 1986/87, to register an annual average of 38 minutes, down from 40 minutes during FY 1985/86. This trend continued during FY 1987/88. The average hearing time was 38 minutes for the first quarter, it dropped to 37 minutes in the second guarter, and rose to 39 minutes in both the third and fourth quarters, to sustain an annual average of 38 minutes, the same as FY 1986/87.

The average reporting time remained at 9 minutes for both FY 1986/87 and FY 1987/88.

The statewide average total length of revocation hearings was 65 minutes for FY 1986/87 (down by 2.99%) and 64 minutes for FY 1987/88 (down by 1.54%). It is clearly evident that the time spent during these hearings has been decreasing as the number of hearings continue to increase.

TIME LAPSED FROM HOLD DATE TO HEARING DATE

Tables VII-A, VII-B, VIII-A, and VIII-B, and Graphs IV-A and IV-B provide information on the average number of days required for the Department of Corrections (CDC) and the Board of Prison Terms (BPT) to request and complete a revocation hearing. The process begins with the placement by CDC staff of a hold on a parolee who is in custody and ends when the revocation hearing is completed by the BPT.

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"Hold to request" or CDC time reflects the number of days required to prepare the parole violation report, advise the parolee of rights, determine if the parolee needs an attorney and/or interpreter, and then to request a revocation hearing. "Request to Hearing" or BPT time is the number of days needed to schedule the hearing, subpoena witnesses, appoint attorneys or interpreters, if needed, and to conduct the hearing. For these calculations, the date used as a request date is the date of the CDC initial request for a hearing. In cases which have a more recent request date, the most recent date is used. These tables and graphs exclude data on former optional waivers and extension hearings.

Tables VII-A and VII-B give the average time lapsed from "date of hold" to "date of hearing" by hearing location and by quarter. The statewide average for "date of hold to request" went up from 49 days to 50 days (2.04%) in FY 1986/87, and then dropped to 38 days (-24.00%) in FY 1987/88. During the same two-year period, the statewide average for "request to hearing" remained at 23 days in FY 1986/87 and then declined to 16 days (-30.43%) in FY 1987/89. The statewide "hold to hearing time" increased from 71 days to 73 days (2.82%) in FY 1986/87 and then dipped to 54 (-26.03%) in FY 1987/88.

Tables VIII-A and VIII-B show the average time lapsed from "hold date" to "hearing date" on a monthly basis. The highest average "hold to hearing time lapsed" for FY 1986/87 was in January (81 days) and for FY 1987/88 in August (68 days). For FY 1986/87, the highest average time for "hold to request" occurred in February (59 days); the longest average time from "request to hearing" was in January (28 days). During FY 1987/88, the highest average time lapsed from "hold to request" was in July (46 days); from "date of request to date of hearing", the highest average time was in August (23 days). There was a fairly steady downward trend in the average time elapsed from hold date to hearing date during FY 1987/88, from a high of 68 days in August down to 45 days in April and May, and ending with 46 days in June.

EXTENSION HEARINGS

Tables IX-A and IX-B, which concern extension hearings, also show the average time lapsed from "incident date" to "hearing date" on a monthly basis. The highest average "incident to hearing time lapsed" for FY 1986/87 was in December (97 days) and for FY 1987/88 was in September (78 days). For FY 1986/87, the highest average time for "incident to request" also occurred in December (83 days); the greatest average time for "request to hearing" was in October (21 days). During FY 1987/88, the highest average time lapsed from "incident to request" was in January (64 days); from "date of request to date of incident", the highest average time was in August and September (15 days each).

STATISTICAL SUMMARY RTC

The amount time for return to custody ordered for parolees is reflected in Tables X-A, X-B, XI-A, XI-B, XII-A, and XII-B. Of the 24,164 parolees ordered returned to custody in FY 1986/87, the average term was 7.6 months, a decrease of 7.32% over the previous fiscal year's level. The median term also decreased by 22.22% to 7.0 months, and the mode remained unchanged at twelve months. The following fiscal year, there were 33,112 (37.03% increase) parolees returned to custody with the mean number of months imposed decreasing by 5.26% to 7.2 months. The median term decreased to six months (-14.29%), and the mode made no change from the prior fiscal year's level of twelve months.

On a quarterly basis, the second quarter of FY 1986/87 had the highest mean term (7.8 months), and during FY 1987/88, the third quarter had the highest mean term (7.5 months). On a statewide basis, Region III continued to have the highest mean term (8.05 months) during FY 1986/87, and Reception Center-South had the highest mean term (7.87 months) during FY 1987/88.


FREQUENCY OF NUMBER OF MONTHS RTC

The frequency of the number of months parolees were returned to custody is shown in Graphs V-A and V-B. Tables XII-A and XII-B indicate that during FY 1986/87, 32.73% had a sentence of twelve months, while for FY 1987/88, the rate decreased to 23.70%. The six-month sentence registered 9.68% of the total for FY 1986/87 and increased to 13.35% for FY 1987/88.

REVOCATION HEARINGS, SCREENINGS AND WAIVERS COMPARED TO PAROLE (FELON) POPULATION


FISCAL YEARS 1983/84 THROUGH 1987/88

NUMBER OF HEARINGS CONDUCTED PAROLE VIOLATORS


FISCAL YEAR 1986/87

NUMBER OF HEARINGS CONDUCTED PAROLE VIOLATORS


FISCAL YEAR 1987/88

FISCAL YEAR 1986/87



NUMBER OF REVOCATION SCREENINGS AND WAIVERS PAROLE VIOLATORS


FISCAL YEAR 1987/88

FISCAL YEAR 1986/87





FISCAL YEAR 1987/88


