


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RESIDENTS IN WISCONSIN ADULT CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES

- Eight-tenths (79.8 percent) of the males and nine-tenths (89.1 percent) of the females in residence in Wisconsin's correctional facilities for adult offenders on December 31, 1988, were classified as new admissions. This category includes offenders received with new sentences, probation violators with or without new sentences, and juvenile aftercare violators sentenced as new adult offenders. (See Table 1, pps. 1-3, pps. 29-30.)
- Over one-half of the males (54.8 percent) and females (51.7 percent) were from White racial and ethnic backgrounds. Blacks made up more than one-third (36.9 percent) of the male and just over two-fifths (42.3 percent) of the female resident population. (See Table 2, p.4, p.31.)
- Unarmed burglary (21.7 percent), armed robbery (9.9 percent), and first degree sexual assault (8.5 percent) were the major offenses most often reported for male residents. Female residents had most often been institutionalized for forgery (17.6 percent), theft (12.4 percent), and other drug violations (7.9 percent). (See Table 3, pps. 5-7, pps. 32-33.)
- About three-fifths (57.6 percent) of the males and two-fifths (39.7 percent) of the females were classified as assaultive offenders either singly or in combination with sex and /or drug offenses. Males classified as sex offenders either alone or in conjunction with drug and/or assaultive offenses made up one-fifth (20.1 percent) of the population; a fact that was true for less than one-tenth (4.5 percent) of the females in residence. One-tenth of the males (9.5 percent) and females (10.5 percent) were classified either singly or in combination with assaultive and/or sex offenses as drug offenders. One-third (35.1 percent) of the males and almost one-half (48.7 percent) of the females were classified solely as property offenders. (See Table 4, p.8, p.34.)
- The average (mean) length of sentence for males was 10.7 years; for females, 7.0 years. Three hundred sixty-six males and 19 females serving life sentences were excluded from these computations. (See Table 5, p.9, p.35.)
- Almost two-fifths of the males (37.3 percent) and females (37.1 percent) were committed to the institutions from Milwaukee County. An additional one-fourth (25.2 percent) of the males and three-tenths (30.7 percent) of the females were committed from Dane, Kenosha, Racine, and Rock Counties. (See Table 6, pps. 10-14, pps. 36-38.)
- Males were found to have an average (mean) age of 30.5 years while females were slightly older with an average (mean) age of 31.8 years. (See Table 7, p.15, p.39.)
- Over one-half (55.5 percent) of the males as compared with approximately two-fifths (44.2 percent) of the females were born in Wisconsin. (See Table 8, p.16, p.40.)
- The majority of the males (79.3 percent) and females (68.9 percent) in residence were found to be free of physical, developmental, or emotional disabilities. (See Table 9, p.17, p.41.)
- About one-fifth of the males (18.0 percent) and seven females (2.6 percent) had a record of military service. (See Table 10, p.18, p.42.)

- One-third (32.3 percent) of the males and almost two-fifths (37.1 percent) of the females had completed at least ninth grade but had not earned a high school diploma. High school diplomas or GED or HED certificates were held by over two-fifths (45.5 percent) of the males and three-tenths (29.2 percent) of the females. (See Table 11, p.19, p.43.)
- One-fifth (21.4 percent) of the males and three-tenths of the females (30.3 percent) were found to be achieving at a tested grade level of twelfth grade or more. (See Table 12, p.20, p.44.)
- Males in residence had been institutionalized for an average (mean) of 26.8 months; females, for 20.9 months. (See Table 13, p.21, p.45.)
- One-third (33.7 percent) of the males in residence were classified as in need of close or maximum security, about two-fifths (38.0 percent) as medium or medium out, and about one-fifth (22.7 percent) as minimum. Approximately one-fourth (26.2 percent) of the females were found to be in need of maximum security with the remainder of the classified females divided evenly between medium or medium out and minimum (31.8 percent). Note: The presence of individuals with maximum and medium security ratings in minimum security facilities is due to a time lag in reporting changes to the reporting system. (See Table 14, p.22, p.46.)
- Three-fifths of the males (59.7 percent) and almost one-half of the females (46.4 percent) were considered to be in at least moderate need of treatment for problems relating to the use of alcohol. Information was obtained from the inmate needs assessment system. (See Table 15, p.23, p.47.)
- A moderate or serious need for treatment for problems relating to drug usage was noted for three-fifths (58.8 percent) of the males and two-thirds (65.9 percent) of the females in residence. Information was obtained from the inmate needs assessment system. (See Table 16, p.24, p.48.)
- Eight out of 10 males (79.5 percent) and females (77.9 percent) in residence were found to have problems relating to the use of alcohol and/or other drugs. (See Table 17, p.25, p.49.)
- There was at least a moderate need for mental health services for one-fifth (20.2 percent) of the males and three-tenths (31.1 percent) of the females in residence. Information was obtained from the inmate needs assessment system. (See Table 18, p.26, p.50.)
- Records indicate that over one-half (53.5 percent) of the males and three-fifths (60.7 percent) of the females were in at least moderate need of some type of educational programming. Information was obtained from inmate needs assessment system. (See Table 19, p.27, p.51.)
- Eight out of 10 males (79.3 percent) and females (82.4 percent) were found to have a moderate or greater need for some kind of vocational training. Information was obtained from the inmate needs assessment system. (See Table 20, p.28, p.52.)
