## INTRODUCTION

### History of South Dakota's Court Services Juvenile Referral Action System

The Court Services Juvenile Referral Action System was instituted in 1976 by the State Court Administrator's Office (the Office). The system was designed by the Office and a users group of local Court Services Office personnel. The authority for the Office to collect data from Court Services Offices is stated in judicial policy. The data are used by the Office to manage workloads, analyze out-of-home placements, and conduct research, and by local offices to monitor pending cases.

### Data Collection Methods

Eight circuit courts have jurisdiction over juvenile delinquency and child in need of supervision cases in the state's 66 counties. When a juvenile is referred to court, a Court Services Officer completes a Juvenile Referral Action Form (see Appendix I). These forms are sent to the Office's Planning and Systems Development Office weekly. The data are entered into the automated file and a new Juvenile Referral Action Form is printed containing all the information submitted for the referral. The printed form and the original form are returned to the Court Services Offices for validation and filing.

### Publications

Each year an annual report is produced which includes summarized information on juvenile proceedings. [*Benchmark: The Annual Report of the South Dakota Unified Judicial System, State Court Administrator's Office.*]

### Archived Data Files

Each year the National Juvenile Court Data Archive asks the Office to create a data file containing a record for each case disposed during the previous calendar year and reported to the Office. The data files contain an individual record on each delinquency and status offense (child in need of supervision) case disposed. Cases processed formally (with a petition) and those handled informally (without a petition) are included. Records contain demographic, offense, detention, manner of handling and disposition information.

The National Juvenile Court Data Archive staff has checked the data for invalid or inconsistent code values. When found, such codes were replaced with missing data code values. Records containing a Record ID (SD001) of "D" are removed from the archived files. These domestic records involve cases of custody and adoption. The Archive also creates the variable Most Serious Offense (SD052). If the case has only one offense that is selected for this variable. If the case contains more than one offense, the most serious based on a seriousness hierarchy developed by Archive staff is selected (see Appendix II).

The data in the files are stored in numeric characters (which are whole numbers) unless otherwise noted. Each case record is 174 characters in length and contains 52 variables. The data are stored in single year files. The number of case records on each calendar year data file is as follows:

## USING THE CODEBOOK

The information that follows is based on a study of available documentation from the data supplier (e.g., Instruction Manual for the Court Services Juvenile Referral Action System, State Court Administrator's Office, 1984), interviews with the data supplier and court personnel, and diagnostic analyses performed by the Archive staff. The example below is a reproduction of information appearing in the codebook for a typical variable. The numbers in brackets do not appear in the codebook, but are references to the descriptions which follow this example.

[1] The starting location and width of the variable in the machine-readable data file. This is the format information needed to read the data into other systems.

- [2] The variable number. The variable number is used as a variable name when the file is processed by systems which use alphabetic variable names (e.g. SPSS).
- [3] The variable label used by statistical systems to identify the variable or program output.
- [4] A description of the variable contents.
- [5] The code values occurring in the data for the variable.
- [6] The textual definitions of the codes. The first 20 characters form a short value label which some systems use to document the output of analysis programs. A longer description follows the short label when necessary.
- [7] The designation of missing data. The Archive staff has replaced any out-of-bounds codes with missing data codes. Many analysis packages require that certain types of data which are usually excluded from analysis be designated as "missing data". Fields with no entry were left blank and "( ) No entry" is listed as a code value. Some variables also have response options representing "unknown" which are also listed as code values.
