





### TIME SERVED IN PRISON


During 1988 there were 32,158 inmates paroled for the first time from the California Department of Corrections (CDC). The total mean time served in CDC institutions and preconfinement time for felons was 22.7 months, the median time served was 16.4 months.

- The total mean time served including preconfinement time was 23.1 months for males, and 18.5 months for females.
- The mean and median time served in CDC institutions was 16.0 and 11.3 months, respectively.
- The total mean time served in CDC institutions was 16.3 months for males and 12.2 months for females.
- Preconfinement time for males and females was 6.8 and 6.3 months, respectively.





TOTAL MEAN TIME SERVED IN MONTHS IN PRISON AND PRECONFINEMENT TIME BY OFFENSE CATEGORY CALENDAR YEAR 1988



Violent offenders served the longest time in CDC institutions and also served the most preconfinement time. Only in the violent offense category was there a large difference in time served between males and females.

- The total mean time served for violent offenses was 32.3 months, with males serving 5.8 months longer than females (32.6 months for males and 26.8 months for females).
- The total mean time served for property offenses was 20.0 months.
- The total mean time served for drug offenses was 18.4 months.
- The total mean time served for all other offenses was 18.9 months.
