

ACQUISITIONS

- The majority of the males (79.4 percent) and females (89.9 percent) resident in Wisconsin's correctional facilities for adult offenders on June 30, 1989, were classified as new sentences. This category includes offenders received with new sentences, those admitted as probation violators either with or without new sentences, and those sentenced as new adult offenders following revocation of juvenile aftercare supervision. (See Table 1, p. 1-3, pps. 29-30.)
- White males made up over one-half (53.8 percent) of the population while just under two-fifths (37.7 percent) of the males were Black. Approximately one-half (49.1 percent) of the females were White with almost an identical proportion (46.4 percent) reported to be Black. (See Table 2, p. 4, p. 31.)
- The major offenses for which males in residence had most often been sentenced were unarmed burglary (20.6 percent), armed robbery (9.7 percent), and first degree sexual assault (8.4 percent). Females were most often sentenced for forgery (14.6 percent), theft (13.1 percent), and other drug violations (9.7 percent). (See Table 3, pps. 5-7, pps. 32-33.)
- Almost three-fifths (57.8 percent) of the males and two-fifths (41.9 percent) of the females were classified either solely as assaultive offenders or as assaultive offenders who were also sex and/or drug offenders. (See Table 4, p. 8, p. 34.)
- The average (mean) length of sentence for males in residence was 10.7 years while females were serving an average (mean) sentence of 6.8 years. Offenders serving life sentences, 381 males and 20 females, were excluded from these computations. (See Table 5, p. 9, p. 35.)
- Approximately two-fifths of the males (37.2 percent) and females (36.7 percent) in residence were committed from Milwaukee County. Commitments from Dane, Kenosha, Racine, and Rock Counties accounted for one-fourth (25.7 percent) of the males and one-third (33.0 percent) of the females in residence. (See Table 6, pps. 10-14, pps. 36-38.)
- Males, with an average (mean) age of 30.6 years, were slightly younger than females who were an average (mean) of 32.3 years old. (See Table 7, p. 15, p. 39.)
- Over one-half (55.3 percent) of the males and just under one-half (48.3 percent) of the females were born in Wisconsin. (See Table 8, p. 16, p. 40.)
- Eight out of 10 males (78.3 percent) and 7 out of 10 females (68.5 percent) were found to be without physical, emotional, or developmental disabilities. (See Table 9, p. 17, p. 41.)

- Less than one-fifth (17.8 percent) of the males and five females (1.9 percent) had a record of military service. (See Table 10, p. 18, p. 42.)
- Slightly less than one-half (45.4 percent) of the males and three-tenths (30.0 percent) of the females held high school diplomas or GED or HED certificates. A record of some college training was noted for almost one-fifth (18.7 percent) of the females and less than one-tenth (8.3 percent) of the males. (See Table 11, p. 19, p. 43.)
- A tested grade level of twelfth grade or more was noted for over one-fifth (22.3 percent) of the males and over one-fourth (28.5 percent) of the females. (See Table 12, p. 20, p. 44.)
- Males in residence on June 30, 1989, had an average (mean) stay of 26.8 months; females, an average (mean) stay of 19.8 months. Almost one-fourth (23.8 percent) of the males and one-third (33.3 percent) of the females had been institutionalized for less than one year. (See Table 13, p. 21, p. 45.)
- Males classified as close or maximum custody made up about one-third (34.0 percent) of the population, almost two-fifths (37.1 percent) were classified as medium or medium out, and approximately one-fourth (24.1 percent) were classified as minimum. One-fourth (25.5 percent) of the females were classified as maximum, another fourth (26.2 percent) as medium or medium out, and two-fifths (41.2 percent) as minimum. (Note: The presence of individuals with maximum or medium security classifications in minimum security institutions is due to a time lag in reporting changes to the information system. (See Table 14, p. 22, p. 46.)
- Three-fifths (59.8 percent) of the males and over two-fifths (44.65 percent) of the females were found to have moderate or serious needs for treatment of problems relating to the use of alcohol. Information was obtained from the inmate needs assessment system. (See Table 15, p. 23, p. 47.)
- A moderate or serious need for treatment of drug problems was noted for two-fifths of the males (60.7 percent) and females (62.2 percent) in residence. Information was obtained from the inmate needs assessment system. (See Table 16, p. 24, p. 48.)
- Eight out of 10 males (80.6 percent) and three-fourths (74.9 percent) of the females were found to have need for treatment of problems relating to the usage of alcohol and/or other drugs. Information was obtained from the inmate needs assessment system. (See Table 17, p. 25, p. 49.)
- A need for some type of treatment for problems connected with mental health was noted for one-fifth (19.5 percent) of the males and over one-fourth (27.0 percent) of the females in residence. Information was taken from inmate needs assessment system. (See Table 18, p. 26, p. 50.)
- Over one-half (53.2 percent) of the males and three-fifths (61.8 percent) of the females were found to be in need of at least moderate involvement in educational programming. Information was taken from the inmate needs assessment system. (See Table 19, p. 27, p. 51.)

- The majority of the males (78.5 percent) and females (77.5 percent) were found to have at least a moderate need for some type of vocational training. This information was obtained from the inmate needs assessment system. (See Table 20, p. 28, p. 52.)
