



During 1987, there were 50,512 felon releases to parole. This was an all time high for the California Department of Corrections (CDC).


- This represented an increase of:
 - 34.8% (13,038) from Calendar Year 1986.
 - 231.0% (35,250) from Calendar Year 1982.
 - 416.7% (40,736) from Calendar Year
 1977.

NOTE: First releases to parole include New Admissions From Court and Parole Violators Returned with a New Term (PV-WNT's). Reparoles are Parole Violators Returned to Custody (PV-RTC's) being re-released to parole after serving their revocation time.

> FELON PAROLE RELEASES PAROLE REGION BY SEX CALENDAR YEAR 1987




FELON PAROLE RELEASES BY TYPE OF RELEASE CALENDAR YEARS 1970 THROUGH 1987



During Calendar Year 1987:


- there were 28,134 first releases to parole of which 25,834 were male and 2,300 were female.
- there were 22,378 re-releases to parole of which 20,797 were male and 1,581 were female.
- Region IV received 15,168 (30.0%) of the total releases to parole.
- Region III received 14,040 (27.8%) of the total releases to parole.
- Region II received 11,018 (21.8%) of the total releases to parole.
- Region I received 10,286 (20.4%) of the total releases to parole.



- Region III had the most first releases to parole accounting for 30.3% (8,518).
- Region IV had the second most first releases to parole accounting for 29.8% (8,393).
- Region IV had the most re-releases to parole, accounting for 30.3% (6,775).
- Region II had the second most re-releases to parole, accounting for 25.2% (5,641).

Of the total release to parole population:

- Los Angeles County had by far the most felon releases to parole during 1987, accounting for 39.3% (19,833).
- San Diego County was the second largest county receiving 6.4% (3,222).
- Santa Clara County received 5.6% (2,842).
- Alameda County also received 5.6% (2,833).
- Sacramento County was the eighth largest county, having received 3.5% (1,765).
