

Statistical Summary
July 1 through December 31, 1989
Family Violence Arrest Incidents

There were 10,956 incidents of family violence in which at least one person was arrested during the second six months of 1989 (preliminary total as of March 12, 1990):

5,761 occurred in the third quarter of 1989;
5,195 occurred in the fourth quarter of 1989;

Nearly nine in ten cases involved an arrest for assault, breach of peace or disorderly conduct.

83.2% of victims were female and 88.5% of offenders were male. 76.5% of all persons arrested for family violence (offenders + both (all) arrested) were male.

In most incidents (76.9%), the closest relationship among all parties was of intimate partner (Live-ins (46.5%), Spouses (30.0%) and Former Spouses (3.1%)).

More than half (59.5%) of all participants were between the ages of 21 and 35.

In 14.9% of the incidents there were prior court orders (Protective or Restraining Order).

Physical injury occurred in two-thirds of arrest incidents. Specifically, 2.2% of injuries were serious and 64.7% of injuries were minor.

Children were present or directly involved in 43.9% of incidents. Children were involved in 10.1% of cases and present in 33.8% of cases.

71.7% of cases involved physical force. An additional 14.7% of cases involved dangerous weapons (guns, knives, other dangerous).

DEFINITIONS

ARREST INCIDENT: An occurrence of family violence in which at least one arrest has been made. One arrest incident is counted for each Family Violence Offense Report submitted; regardless of the number of parties arrested.

BREACH OF PEACE AND DISORDERLY CONDUCT: Crimes of Threatening; Harassment and Reckless Endangerment may be reported under either Breach of Peace or Disorderly Conduct.

BOTH (ALL) PEOPLE ARRESTED: An individual is assigned the status of BOTH when involved in a family violence incident in which all parties were arrested. Each participant who has been coded as BOTH has committed an offense involving family violence, and therefore cannot be considered a "pure" victim. However, an individual classified as BOTH cannot be classified as a "pure" offender either, since s/he has also been the target of a violent domestic crime. Note that these incidents frequently involve more than two people.

FAMILY OR HOUSEHOLD MEMBERS: Spouses; former spouses; parents and their children; persons eighteen years of age or older related by blood or marriage who are presently residing together or who have resided together in the past; and persons who share a child in common regardless of their marital status or living arrangement.

FAMILY VIOLENCE: An incident resulting in physical harm; bodily injury or assault; or an act of threatened violence that causes fear of imminent physical harm; bodily injury or assault between or among family or household members. Verbal abuse or argument alone does not constitute family violence. Nor are acts of parents or guardians in disciplining their minor children classified as family violence unless such acts constitute abuse. In order for an offense to be classified as family violence, there must be present danger, the likelihood that physical violence will occur and the relationship between the parties conforms to the definition of "Family or Household Members."

FAMILY VIOLENCE CRIME: A crime as defined in section 53a-24 of the Connecticut General Statutes which contains as an element an act of violence directed at a family or household member.

INJURY: A serious injury is a physical injury which creates a substantial risk of death; or which causes serious disfigurement; serious impairment of health or serious loss or impairment of the function of any bodily organ. A minor injury means impairment of physical condition or pain. Non-physical injuries include threats and attempts to cause harm.

LIVE-IN: Persons presently residing together or who have resided together in the past; and persons who share a child in common.

"OTHER" CRIME: Offenses included under the classification of "Other" include all family violence crimes which are not covered by the offense types listed. "Other" crimes include, but are not limited to: Robbery; Burglary; Arson; and Criminal Trespass.



RELATIVE (SAME/OTHER HOME): Includes parents and children; brothers; sisters; aunts; uncles; in-laws; cousins; etcetera.


