

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INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this report is to provide managers, planners, evaluators, and other users a useful display of substance abuse arrest data for South Carolina. No attempt is made to analyze the data and no conclusions concerning the meaning of the data are provided.

The report is a continuation of the Uniform Crime Report (UCR) Series published by this Division beginning in 1975. The initial study dealt with 1974 arrest data reported to the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division. This report presents arrest data for 1986 through 1989 from the same source, and offers a comparison by county of selected arrests for these years. By examining several years of arrest data, trends in annual substance-related arrests may be detected.

Five sections of tables are contained in this report. The first section, **Substance Abuse Arrest Tables** (1 through 10), presents arrest data by county, region, and state levels for each major substance abuse arrest area. The second section, **Arrest Rate Tables** (11 through 20), provides tables of similar information contained in section one but displayed as arrest rates per 10,000 population. Arrest rates are important measures with which to compare the relative number of arrests among geographical areas. The third section, **Possession, Sale, and Manufacturing Arrest Tables** (21 through 25), contains tables on drug arrests for possession separately from drug arrests for sale or manufacture for all counties. The fourth section, **Summary and Miscellaneous Tables** (26 through 29), presents population data, arrests for all offenses, comparisons of substance arrests to all arrests for 1986 through 1989, and crack arrests. The last section contains **graphic displays** of state totals for selected categories of arrests.

A person is counted on an arrest report each time he is arrested or summoned. This means that arrest counts do not reflect the number of different individuals arrested each year, since an individual may be arrested several times during a year for the same or a number of different offenses. Also, when an arrested individual is charged with multiple offenses, only one report is created, reflecting the most serious offense. As a result, arrests for substance-related offenses may be underreported in the UCR data base.

A juvenile is counted as an arrest when the circumstances are such that, if he or she were an adult, an arrest would be counted, or when law enforcement action or other official action is taken beyond a mere interview, warning or admonishment. Although by South Carolina law a juvenile is defined as age 16 or younger, in this report, "youth" refers to persons under age 18.

Readers of this report should be cognizant of the fact that the enclosed data represents the number of *reported** arrests, not the number of occurrences of an offense or the number of convictions. In order to clarify the different arrest categories that are dealt with, the following definitions are offered.

* Not all law enforcement agencies report UCR arrest data, although the number that do not report in a given year is small.

Heroin and Other Narcotics - Includes arrests for violations of state and local laws relating to the unlawful possession, sale, use, growing, manufacturing, and making of narcotic drugs including opium, its derivatives (morphine, heroin, codeine) as well as the synthetic narcotics (demerol, methadone, percodan).

Marijuana - Relates to the unlawful possession, sale, use, growing manufacturing and making of marijuana, hashish, and THC.

Cocaine - Relates to the unlawful possession, sale, use, manufacturing and making of cocaine and its derivatives.

Other Dangerous Drugs - Relates to the unlawful possession, sale, use, manufacturing, and making of other dangerous non-narcotic drugs (barbiturates, amphetamines, hallucinogens, tranquilizers).

Liquor Laws - Relates to the unlawful manufacture, transportation, sale, serving or possession of alcoholic beverages according to state and local laws. Liquor law violations include the following:

- Maintaining unlawful drinking places
- Advertising and soliciting orders for intoxicating liquor
- Bootlegging
- Furnishing liquor to a minor or intemperate persons
- Drinking on a train or public conveyance
- Having an open container of an alcoholic beverage in a moving vehicle
- Possession of alcohol by persons under 21 years old

Driving Under Influence - This category is limited to the driving or operating of any vehicle or common carrier while drunk or under the influence of liquor or narcotics. It includes the following:

- Operating a motor vehicle while intoxicated
- Operating an engine, train, streetcar, boat, etc., while intoxicated

Public Drunkenness - Included in this category are all offenses of drunkenness or intoxication with the exception of driving under the influence; it includes drunkenness, drunk and disorderly, common or habitual drunkard, and intoxication.

*Disorderly Conduct** - This category is included because disorderly conduct is frequently associated with drinking or with using drugs. In this category are placed all charges of committing a breach of the peace which includes the following:

Affray, unlawful assembly, disturbing the peace, disturbing meetings, disorderly conduct in state institutions, at court, at fairs, on trains or public conveyances, etc., prize fights, blasphemy, profanity and obscene language, desecrating flags, refusing to assist an officer, all attempts to commit any of the above.

* Disorderly conduct arrests are not used to calculate aggregated substance-related arrests.

Readers interested in UCR information other than that contained within this report are referred to *Crime in South Carolina, 1989*, published by the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division.



PERCENT CHANGE IN ARRESTS SINCE 1980



ALCOHOL ARRESTS AMONG YOUTHS UNDER 21, 1983 – 1989



ALCOHOL ARRESTS IN SOUTH CAROLINA, 1980 – 1989



DRUG ARRESTS IN SOUTH CAROLINA, 1981 – 1989






FIGURE 6 ARRESTS FOR POSSESSION AND SALE
