#### INTRODUCTION

#### History of New Jersey's Juvenile Delinquency Unit Case Reporting

In October 1984 New Jersey's Administrative Office of the Courts began data collection of delinquency cases handled by the state's family courts. This responsibility is mandated in New Jersey Annotated Code section 2A.4A.49 which specifies that individual case data be collected at the county level. The data are used by the state in the development of guidelines for the disposition of juveniles adjudicated delinquent.

#### **Data Collection Methods**

Delinquency cases are handled by the family courts in 15 vicinages covering the 21 counties in the state. These courts also handle status offense and dependency cases but no automated case-level records are maintained by the state on these cases.

Delinquency data are recorded on a Unit Case Form (see Appendix I) for each referral to court intake. Each form can contain up to three offenses. If there are more than three offenses in a referral, more forms are used to capture the remaining offense information. These forms are linked together by a series of numbers which identify the youth and referral.

A Unit Case Form is completed at two different points in the processing of a case. The first form contains demographic and charge data and is completed at the time of referral to court intake. The second is coded upon disposition of the case. It contains detention, attorney, adjudication, and disposition information. These forms are sent weekly to the Administrative Office of the Courts' Statistical Services Division at which point they are automated.

#### **Archived Data Files**

The data files received by the Archive contain a separate record for each disposition in a delinquency case. These records contain the following variables: juvenile ID number, docket number, serial number, zip code, race, sex, date of birth, date of filing, filing type, detention 1, attorney, calendar, predisposition report ordered, detention 2, continuous detention, detention days, municipality, initial charge, final charge, adjudicated delinquent, date of hearing, violent crime compensation, disposition, length of sentence, suspend type and dollar amount. Although these variables are used to create the archived case-level records, they are not all contained on the created records.

From these disposition-level files the Archive creates case-level files. First, all records for a juvenile are grouped together based on the unique juvenile ID number within each county. Records with filing types of "reopened due to unsuccessful diversion" or "reopened, other" are deleted from the file. Records with "new" or "transferred in" filing types are retained. Records having the filing type of "reactivated" are retained if that record's docket number (a number assigned to each offense at the time of filing) is different from all the youth's records having a "new" filing type.

The disposition records for each youth are next grouped according to docket and serial number (a prestamped number on the Unit Case Forms) in order to determine unique offenses in each referral. If more than one disposition record contains identical docket and serial numbers it indicates that the dispositions apply to one offense. Based on these groupings of docket and serial numbers, offense-level records are created for each youth. This is done by stringing together up to four groups

of disposition information (disposition, length of sentence, unit, suspend type and dollars) for each offense.

For each youth the offense-level records are then grouped by date of filing to create case-level records. For each case, the first offense-level record is selected to provide demographic (race, sex, date of birth and zip code) and referral (county, juvenile ID and date of filing) data for the case. The age of the youth at filing is created by subtracting the birth date from the date of filing.

If detention, mandatory counsel (from the calendar variable), or delinquency adjudication were indicated on any of the offense-level records then these are copied to the case-level record. The type of attorney is selected from the record which represented mandatory counseling.

Referral offenses and final offenses are then recoded into a seriousness hierarchy (see Appendix II). The three most serious offenses are selected from among the referral offenses and copied to the case-level record. The most serious final offense is also written to the case-level record. In like manner, dispositions are sorted by severity (see Appendix III) and the most severe disposition is added to the case-level record.

In order to provide as much information as possible about a case, the Archive creates several additional variables. The "petitioned" variable is created to indicate whether an adjudicatory or waiver hearing was held. To determine whether an offense was petitioned, dispositions are studied. Nonpetitioned offenses are those with dispositions of "parent, guardian participation (code 081)," "marked untriable (084)," "transfer to another county (092)," "other referral, transfer (093)," juvenile conference committee (100)," "intake services conference (101)," "crisis intervention unit (102)," and "other diversion (103)." If a disposition other than those listed above appear in the offense record, then the offense was petitioned. Taking it to the case-level, a petitioned case is one in which any of the offenses was petitioned.

The most serious offense petitioned variable is created by selecting the most serious referral offense that was petitioned in a case. In addition, the most serious final offense adjudicated is selected from those final offenses which were adjudicated.

Variables are also created based on which dispositions were served and, as a result, indicate the most severe restrictions actually placed upon the youth. Also captured is the most serious final offense having the most severe disposition served. The date of this disposition is written to the case-level record as well.

The data in the files are stored as numeric characters (which are whole numbers) unless otherwise noted. The records for each case are 71 characters in length and contain 30 variables. The data are stored in single year files. The number of case records in each calendar year data file is as follows:

#### USING THE CODEBOOK

The information that follows is based on a study of available documentation from the data supplier (e.g., Administrative Office of the Courts Coding Manual and Procedures Manual), interviews with the data supplier and court personnel, and diagnostic analyses performed by the Archive staff. The example below is a reproduction of information appearing in the codebook for a typical variable. The numbers in brackets do not appear in the codebook, but are references to the descriptions which follow this example.

- [1] The starting location and width of the variable in the machine-readable data file. This is the format information needed to read the data into other systems.
- [2] The variable number. The variable number is used as a variable name when the file is processed by systems which use alphabetic variable names (e.g. SPSS).
- [3] The variable label used by statistical systems to identify the variable or program output.
- [4] A description of the variable contents.
- [5] The code values occurring in the data for the variable.
- [6] The textual definitions of the codes. The first 20 characters form a short value label which some systems use to document the output of analysis programs. A longer description follows the short label when necessary.

- [7] The designation of missing data. The Archive staff has replaced any out-of-bounds codes with missing data codes. Many analysis packages require that certain types of data which are usually excluded from analysis be designated as "missing data". Fields with no entry were left blank and "() No entry" is listed as a code value. Some variables also have response options representing "unknown" which are also listed as code values.
