Offenders Admitted to Wisconsin Adult Correctional Institutions Calendar Year 1989

HIGHLIGHTS

Seven out of 10 males (72.3 percent) and eight out of 10 females (85.5 percent) admitted during calendar year 1989 were classified as new admissions; a category which includes offenders who were not under any type of supervision prior to sentencing as well as those received as probation violators with or without a new sentence.

Males were most often sentenced for unarmed burglary (20.9 percent), other drug violations (12.3 percent), and theft (6.6 percent). Other drug violations (17.9 percent), forgery (16.8 percent), and theft (13.8 percent) were the offenses for which females were most frequently sentenced.

The average (mean) length of sentence for all offenders was 68.8 months. Males received average (mean) sentences of 70.3 months; females sentences of 43.8 months. Twenty-six males and two females who received life sentences were excluded from these computations.

Commitments from Dane, Kenosha, Rock, and Racine Counties accounted for over one-fourth (27.0 percent) of the males and two-fifths (40.3 percent) of the female admissions. Over one-third (35.9 percent) of the males and three-tenths (30.1 percent) of the females were committed from Milwaukee County.

Males convicted of unarmed burglary, other drug violations, and theft received average (mean) sentences of 58.8, 46.5, and 48.9 months. The average (mean) length of sentence received by females convicted of other drug violations, forgery, and theft were 37.9, 50.1, and 36.3 months.

One-fourth (24.1 percent) of the males were assaultive offenders, an additional tenth (13.6 percent) were both assaultive and sex offenders, while assaultive drug offenders and assaultive, sex, and drug offenders made up 1.2 percent of the admissions. Females classified solely as assaultive offenders made up one-fourth (25.0 percent) of the group; two percent were categorized as both assaultive and sex offenders, with one (0.5 percent) classified as an assaultive and drug offender. Somewhat less than one-fifth (16.2 percent) of the males and over one-fifth (22.4 percent) of the females were classified solely as drug offenders.

The average (mean) age for all offenders was 28.0 years. Males, with an average (mean) age of 27.9 years, were almost a year younger than females who had an average (mean) age of 28.8 years.

About one-half (52.0 percent) of the males and less than one-half (46.9 percent) of the females were from White racial and ethnic backgrounds.

^o Two-thirds (65.1 percent) of the males and one-half (50.5 percent) of the females had never been married.

No prior felony convictions other than those associated with this admission were found for over one-half of the males (52.5 percent) and females (56.1 percent) admitted in 1989. Almost one-fourth (23.5 percent) of the males and over one-tenth (13.3 percent) of the females had a record of two or more prior felonies.

This was the first period of confinement in a penal institution for over one-half (53.6 percent) of the males and almost three-fourths (72.4 percent) of the females. Over one-third (35.6 percent) of the males and less than one-fifth (16.8 percent) of the females had previously been confined in Wisconsin correctional facilities.

One-fourth (26.8 percent) of the males and one-tenth (10.2 percent) of the females had a record of prior stay in a correctional institution for juvenile offenders.

More than two-fifths (44.3 percent) of the males and almost one-half (48.0 percent) of the females had not yet earned a high school diploma. However, three-tenths (30.0 percent) of the males and almost one-fifth (17.9 percent) of the females had earned GED or HED certificates prior to this admission.

Testing indicated that two-fifths of the males (40.2 percent) and females (37.8 percent) ranked at or below the sixth grade level. A rank of at least the twelfth grade level was recorded for one-fourth (26.4 percent) of the males and one-fifth (20.4 percent) of the males and one-fifth (20.4 percent) of the females.

Seven out of 10 males (71.7 percent) and six out of 10 females (63.3 percent) were found to be without physical, developmental, or emotional disabilities.

A record of military service was noted for over one-tenth (15.1 percent) of the males and one (0.5 percent) of the females.

About one-half (53.5 percent) of the males and two-fifths (39.8 percent) of the females received an initial custody classification of medium or medium out following the completion of assessment and evaluation procedures.

Almost one-half (45.7 percent) of the males were placed in maximum security facilities following completion of assessment and evaluation procedures, one-third (32.0 percent) in medium security facilities, and nearly one-fifth (17.5 percent) in minimum security facilities. About three-fifths (57.7 percent) of the females were placed in a maximum-medium facility while two-fifths (39.8 percent) were placed in minimum security facilities.

° Four out of 10 males (61.8 percent) and over one-third (36.2) of the females were in serious need of treatment for alcohol problems.

About seven-tenths (69.1 percent) of the males and females (65.8 percent) were in serious need of treatment for problems with drug usage.

- A need for treatment of problems relating to the use of alcohol and/or other drugs was noted for eight out of 10 males (81.8 percent) and seven out of 10 females (71.4 percent).

- About one-half (53.2 percent) of the males and three-fifths (61.7 percent) of the females were found to have need for an opportunity to become involved in some type of educational program.

About one-fourth of the males (24.7 percent) and females (22.4 percent) were seriously in need of some type of vocational training.

(See Table 23)

The majority of the males (84.5 percent) and females (87.2 percent) were found, after assessment and evaluation, to be without need for any type of services relating to mental health problems.

Participation in drug and alcohol programs, other therapy programs, and educational programs were the placements most frequently recommended for males and females following completion of the assessment and evaluation process.
