### Acknowledgements

Crime and Arrests in Wisconsin, Semi-Annual Report 1990 is the product of information provided by a variety of law enforcement agencies throughout the State. Without the excellent cooperation of the people in these agencies, this publication would not have been possible. The Wisconsin Office of Justice Assistance gratefully acknowledges the assistance of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Uniform Crime Reporting Program; and especially the Administrators of local law enforcement agencies and their staffs, whose efforts made the data available.

### A. Offenses Reported

This report presents the number of crimes reported to Wisconsin law enforcement agencies for the first six months of 1990\*. As shown in Table 1, there was a statewide increase of 5.6 percent in reported Index Offenses for the first half of 1990 compared to the first six months of 1989\*\*.

During the first half of 1990, there were increases in the number of all offenses except arson.


With the exception of aggravated assault, each Index Offense increased during the five year period. The total number of Index Offenses increased by over eleven percent during the five years.

\* All figures for 1990 are estimates based on data from over 99 percent of reporting agencies.

\*\* Index Offenses include the four Violent Offenses of murder, forcible rape, robbery and aggravated assault and the four Property Offenses of burglary, theft, motor vehicle theft and arson.

Graph 1 shows the five year trend in reported Violent Index Offenses for the first six months of each year.


Graph 1: Violent Offenses



Reported Violent Index Offenses increased in 1987, decreased in 1988 and 1989, then increased in the first six months of 1990.

## B. Arrests

Tables 3 and 4 compare adult and juvenile arrests for the first six months of 1989 and 1990.

Both total adult and total juvenile arrests increased by about six percent during the first six months of 1990. However, the increase in arrests for Part II crimes was greater for both age categories.

Table 5 provides arrest figures for the most common offense categories for which adults were arrested in the first six months of 1989 and 1990.

There were substantial increases during the first half of 1990 in the number of adults arrested for disorderly conduct, fraud, vandalism, simple assault and OMVWI. However, arrests of adults for aggravated assault and weapons violations declined.

\*\*\* Part I offenses include all eight Index offenses plus negligent manslaughter. Part II offenses include all other non-traffic offenses.

Table 6 provides arrest figures for the most common offense categories for which juveniles were arrested in the first six months of 1989 and 1990.

There were substantial increases during the first half of 1990 in the number of juveniles arrested for disorderly conduct, simple assault, theft, vandalism, and runaway status. However, arrests of juveniles for motor vehicle theft and drug law violations declined.

C. County and Local Jurisdiction Data

Table 7 lists the number of Index Offenses by county for sheriff's offices and other law enforcement agencies for the first six months of 1989 and 1990. The number of months of data reported by each agency for both years is also noted. This information is vital to the interpretation of this table since the data presented in Table 7 for individual jurisdictions are reported data, not estimated as in the previous tables of statewide data presented in this report. Thus, in comparing jurisdictions it is essential that the number of months of reported data be the same.

Certain agencies and their respective counties are marked by an asterisk (\*) in Table 7. These agencies fall into five categories:

1. New Reporters in 1990 - Pulaski (Brown Co.), Hurley (Iron Co.), and Spooner (Washburn Co.);
2. New Reporters in 1989 - UW La Crosse (La Crosse Co.), Eleva, Osseo and Strum (Trempealeau Co.);
3. Missing Some or All 1990 Data - Adams (Adams Co.), Shorewood (Milwaukee Co.), Sparta (Monroe Co.), Prescott (Pierce Co.), Orfordville (Rock Co.), and Osseo (Trempealeau Co.);
4. Missing Some 1989 Data - Columbus (Columbia Co.) and Evansville (Rock Co.);
5. Missing All 1989 and 1990 Data - Montello (Marquette Co.)

In each of these cases, the 1989 and 1990 crime figures are not directly comparable for both the individual agency and its respective county total.
