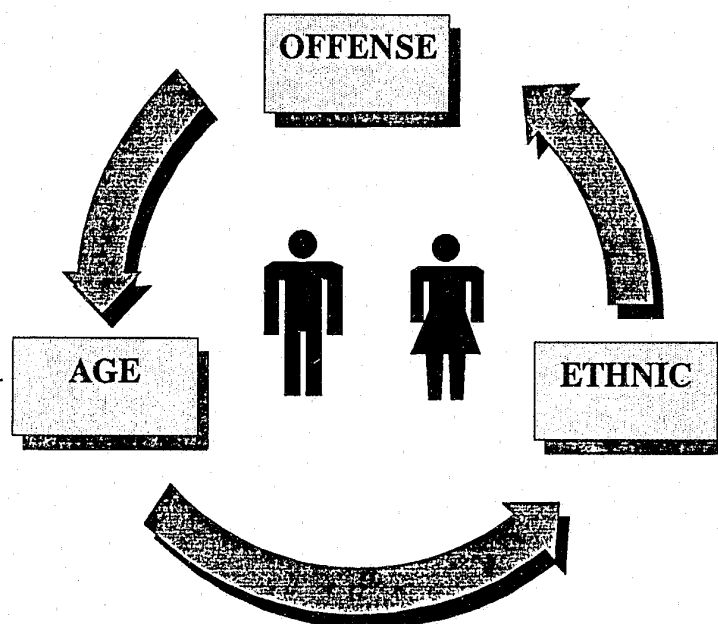

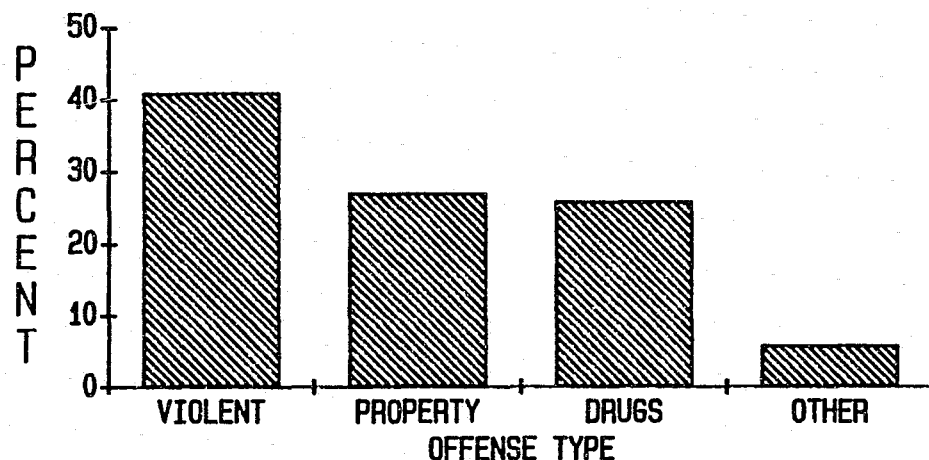

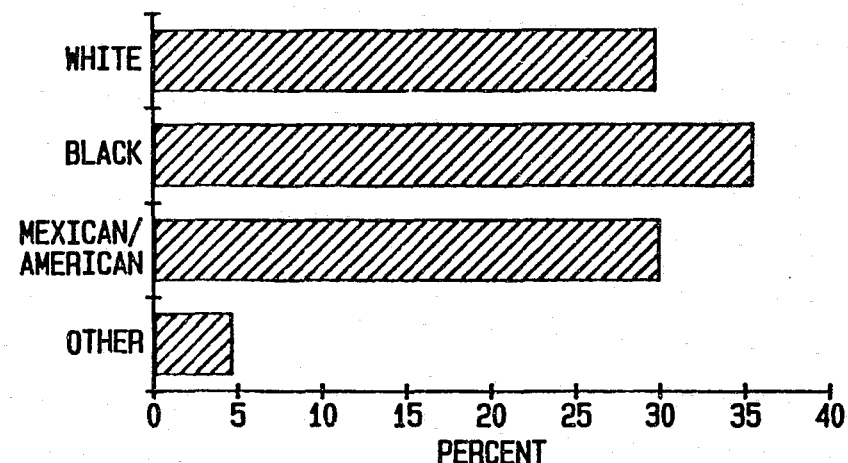

CHARACTERISTICS OF POPULATION IN CALIFORNIA STATE PRISON DECEMBER 31, 1990

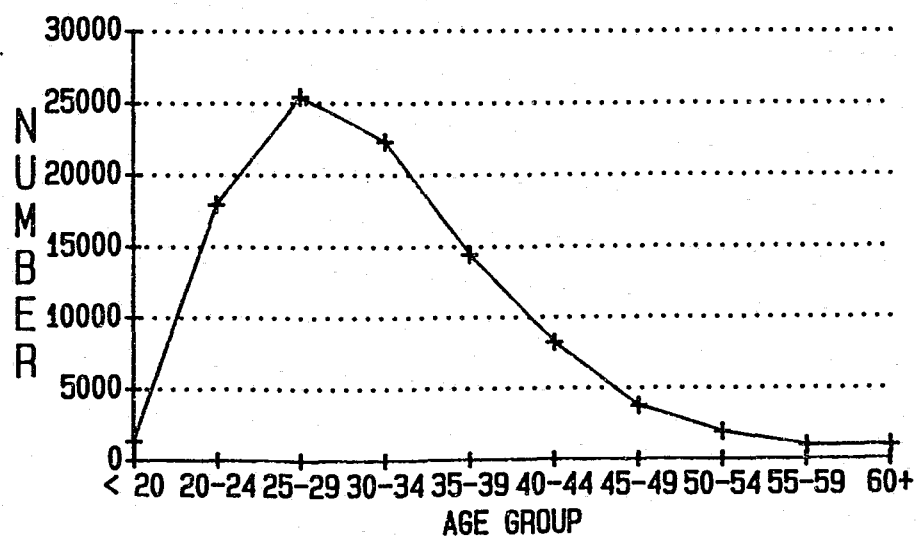
TYPE OF OFFENSE



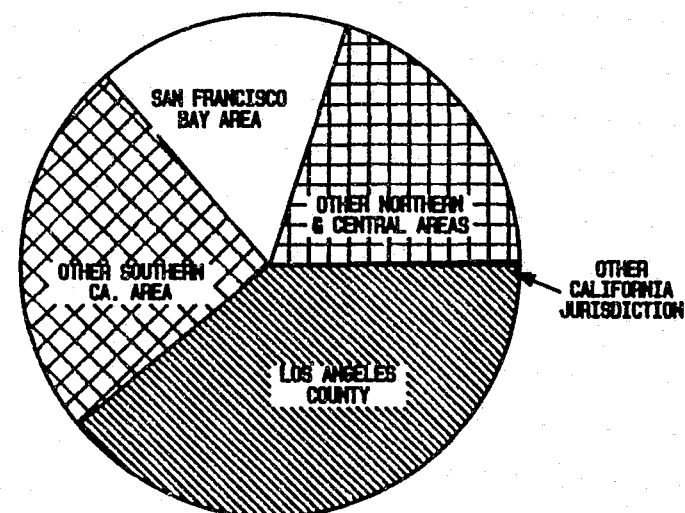
ETHNIC STATUS
