


As of December 31, 1989, there were 56,746 California felons on parole under the California Department of Corrections(CDC) jurisdiction or the supervision of another state (ISPU).

- The parole population increased 17.2% (8,319) from December 31, 1988.
- This is an increase of 136.6% (32,759) from December 31, 1984.
- The felon parole population consisted of 51,960 (91.6%) males and 4,786 (8.4%) females.

Felon Parole Population by Region of Parole December 31, 1989




Felon Parole Population December 31, 1960 - 1989



- Region I accounted for 19.7% (11,193) of the felon parole population.
- Region II accounted for 20.4% (11,558) of the felon parole population.
- Region III accounted for 28.4% (16,127) of the felon parole population.
- Region IV accounted for 29.1% (16,508) of the felon parole population.
- The California felon parolees supervised in other states through (Interstate Parole Unit) accounted for 2.4% (1,360) of the felon parole population.


Offense Categories Felon Parole Population December 31, 1989



- On December 31, 1989:
- Property offenders accounted for 36.0% (20,400) of the felon parole population.
- Violent offenders accounted for 29.7% (16,823) of the felon parole population.
- Drug offenders accounted for 29.4%
 (16,670) of the felon parole population.
- Offenders with other offenses accounted for 4.9% (2,780) of the felon parole population.


- The largest group of felons on parole were originally committed for Controlled Substance Possession and accounted for 12.2% (6,896) of the population.
- The next largest group was committed for Robbery and accounted for 11.6% (6,586) of the population.
- Those committed for Burglary First accounted for 9.8% (5,574) of the population.
- The smallest group of felons on parole were originally committed for Murder Second and accounted for 0.2% (124) of the population.


Felon Parole Population Six Largest and Six Smallest Offense Groups December 31, 1989




Blacks, Whites and Mexican/American each represent approximately the same proportion of the CDC felon parole population. However these proportions differ when looking at individual parole regions.

- Whites comprised the largest racial/ethnic group in Region I, accounting for 45.6% (5,105) of the population.
- Blacks represent the largest racial/ethnic group in Region II and Region III, accounting for 42.7% (4,940) and 49.8% (8,029) of the population, respectively.
- Mexican/Americans represent the largest racial/ethnic group in Region IV, accounting for 37.3% (6,160) of the population.

Over half (52.6%) of the felon parolees fall into the 25-34 year old age groups.

- The largest age group of felons on parole were 25 to 29 years old and accounted for 28.9% (16,416) of the population.
- The next largest age group was 30 to 34 years old, accounting for 23.7% (13,471) of the population.
- The smallest age group was the under 20 group which represented 0.2% (87) of the population.
- The next two smallest age groups were the 60 and over and the 55 to 59, which accounted for 1.0% (562) and 1.0% (613) of the population, respectively.
