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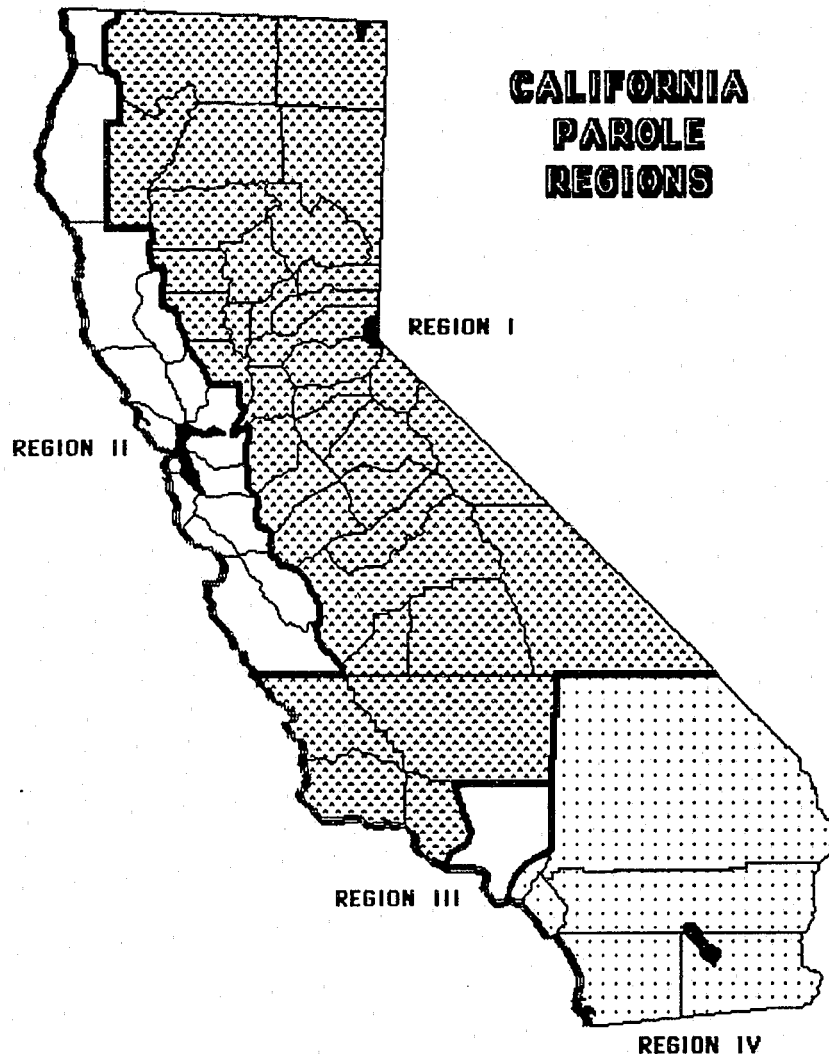
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CHARACTERISTICS OF CALIFORNIA FELON PAROLEES



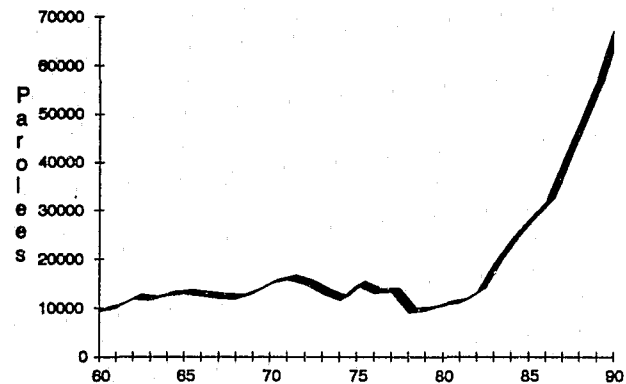
- Region I: Covers all the counties north of Los Angeles and San Bernardino counties, with the exception of those in Region II.
- Region II: Covers the San Francisco Bay Area counties including: Monterey, San Benito, Santa Cruz, Santa Clara, San Mateo, San Francisco, Alameda, Contra Costa, Solano, Napa, Lake, Mendocino, Sonoma, and Marin.
- Region III: Covers Los Angeles county excluding the southeastern area (Long Beach through Pomona).
- Region IV: Covers all of southern California from San Bernardino county and the southeastern area of Los Angeles county to the Mexican border.

CHARACTERISTICS OF CALIFORNIA FELON PAROLEES

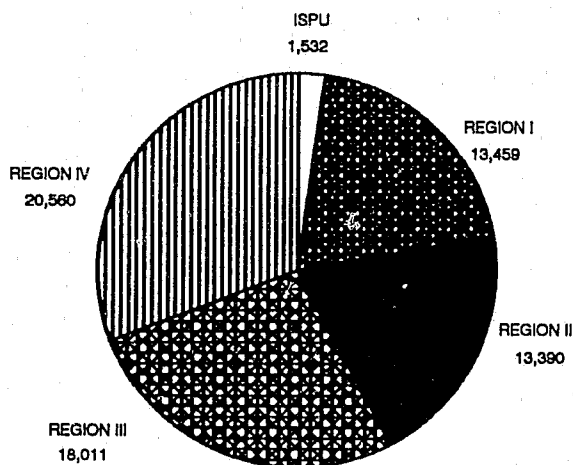
As of December 31, 1990, there were 66,952 California felons on parole under the California Department of Corrections(CDC) jurisdiction or the supervision of another state (ISPU).

- There was an increase of 10,206 parolees since December 31, 1989.
- The felon parole population consisted of 60,937 (91.0%) males and 6,015 (8.9%) females.

December 31, 1960 - 1990



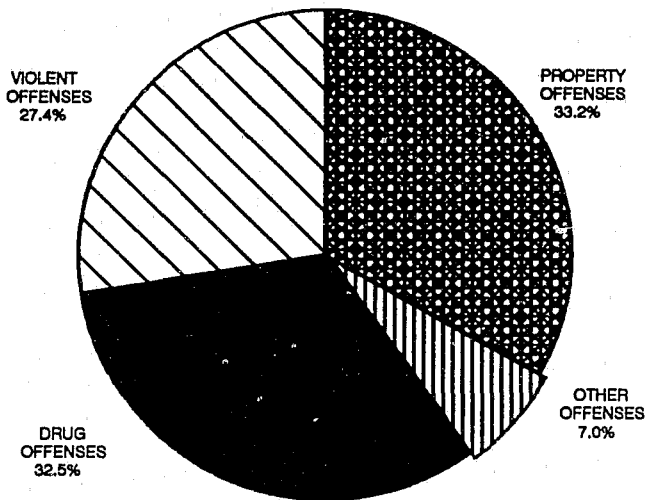
Felon Parole Population

- Region I accounted for 20.1% (13,459) of the felon parole population.
- Region II accounted for 20.0% (13,390) of the felon parole population.
- Region III accounted for 26.9% (18,011) of the felon parole population.
- Region IV accounted for 30.7% (20,560) of the felon parole population.
- The California felon parolees supervised in other states through (Interstate Parole Unit) accounted for 2.3% (1,532) of the felon parole population.

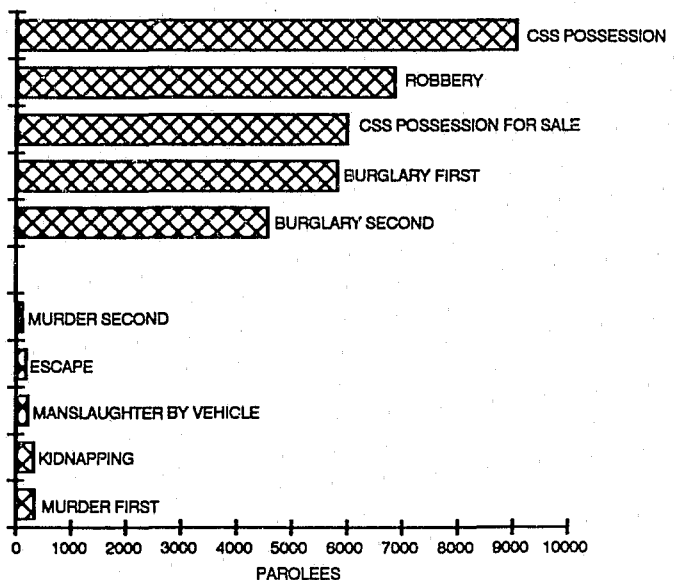


On December 31, 1990:

- Property offenders accounted for 33.2% (22,208) of the felon parole population.
- Drug offenders accounted for 32.5% (21,751) of the felon parole population.
- Violent offenders accounted for 27.4% (18,314) of the felon parole population.
- Offenders with other offenses accounted for 7.0% (4,675) of the felon parole population.

- The largest group of felons on parole were originally committed for Controlled Substance Possession and accounted for 13.5% (9,067) of the population.
- The next largest group was committed for Robbery and accounted for 10.3% (6,863) of the population.
- Those committed for Controlled Substance Possession for Sale accounted for 9.0% (6,010) of the population.
- The smallest group of felons on parole were originally committed for Murder Second and accounted for 0.3% (190) of the population.

December 31, 1990

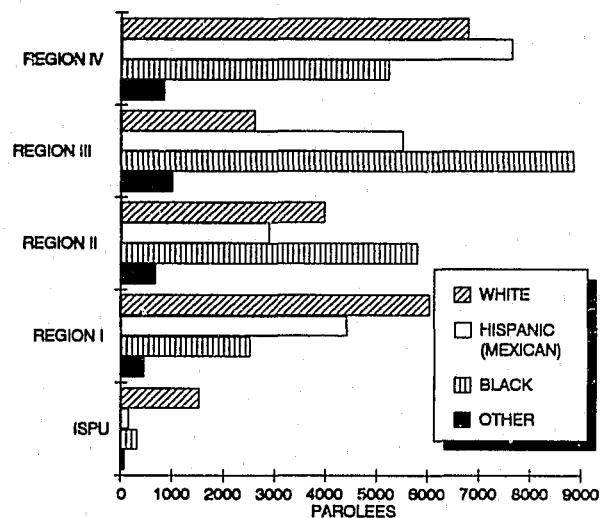


CHARACTERISTICS OF CALIFORNIA FELON PAROLEES

The White and Hispanic (Mexican) racial/ethnic groups each represent approximately the same proportion of the total CDC felon parole population (30.5% White; 30.9% Hispanic (Mexican)). However, these proportions differ when looking at individual parole regions.

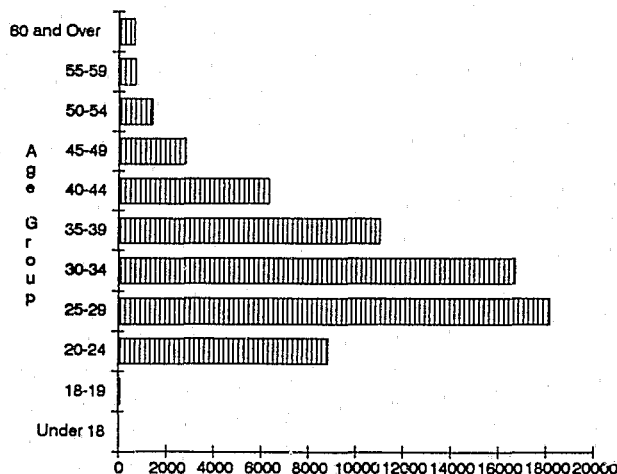
- Whites comprised the largest racial/ethnic group in Region I, accounting for 45.0% (6,053) of the population.
- Blacks represent the largest racial/ethnic group in Region II and Region III, accounting for 43.4% (5,811) and 49.2% (8,855) of the population, respectively.
- Hispanic (Mexican) represent the largest racial/ethnic group in Region IV, accounting for 37.2% (7,658) of the population.

Over half (52.2%) of the felon parolees fall into the 25-34 year old age groups.

- There were no felon parolees in the under 18 age group.
- The largest age group of felons on parole were 25 to 29 years old and accounted for 27.2% (18,202) of the population.
- The next largest age group was 30 to 34 years old, accounting for 25.0% (16,735) of the population.
- The smallest age group was 18 to 19 age group which represented 0.2% (107) of the population.
- The 55 to 59 and the 60 and over age groups represented the next smallest percentage, which accounted for 1.0% (741) and (691) of the population, respectively.
