INTRODUCTION

This report has been developed to provide information regarding selected offender characteristics in each correctional complex, major institutions and satellite housing units under the jurisdiction of the New Jersey Department of Corrections on December 31, 1990. The selected characteristics compiled in this report are Base Offense at Admission, Total Term at Admission, Ethnicity, Age, County of Commitment, and Mandatory Minimum Terms.

The Prison Complex includes the New Jersey State Prison, East Jersey State Prison, Bayside State Prison, Riverfront State Prison, Mid-State, Southern State, Northern State Prison, Edna Mahan Correctional Facility for Women (females and males) and the Adult Diagnostic and Treatment Center (ADTC is a facility for adult male sex offenders).

The Youth Correctional Complex consists of the Garden State Reception and Youth Correctional Facility, the Albert C. Wagner Youth Correctional Facility, and the Mountainview Youth Correctional Facility. The Juvenile Facilities include the New Jersey Training School for Boys, the Lloyd McCorkle Training School for Boys and Girls and the Juvenile Medium Security Facility.

On December 31, 1990 there were approximately 2,741 State-sentenced offenders temporarily housed in County Facilities awaiting transfer into the State Prison System. Characteristics data on these offenders are not included in this report. Similarly, characteristics data for the 2,229 Prison and Youth Reception residents, Juvenile Group Center Residents, Halfway House, County Contract, County Assistance, Central Medical Unit and Electronic Monitoring/Home Confinement residents are not included in these tabulations.

"Not Coded" are records for offenders in the correctional system for whom admission characteristics data have not been entered into the computerized information system as of December 31, 1990.

HIGHLIGHTS

Fifty-two percent (52%) of <u>all</u> New Jersey Department of Corrections residents were committed for crimes against persons which include Homicide, Sexual Assault, Assault, Robbery, Sodomy, Sexual Abuse and Other Person Offenses.

Fifty percent (50%) of all New Jersey Department of Corrections residents were committed with maximum statutory sentences of 10 years or more. Of the total, five percent (5%) are serving Life Sentences and 13 offenders are under Capital Sentences.

Sixty-three percent (63%) of New Jersey's Department of Corrections residents are Black, while 21% are White and 16% are Hispanic.

Fifty percent (50%) of all residents in the New Jersey Department of Corrections are under 29 years of age.

Of the 21 New Jersey counties, seven (Atlantic, Hudson, Essex, Camden, Union, Passaic, and Monmouth) account for seventy-two percent (72%) of Total State Correctional Residents. Essex County is the highest contributor with twenty percent (20%).

Fifty percent (50%) of all adult residents housed in the State System have mandatory minimum sentences.

Thirty percent (30%) of all Department of Corrections residents have been committed for narcotics law violations, including possession, sale and distribution. Over 90% of all narcotics law violations are sale/distribution offenses.

OFFENDERS IN NEW JERSEY CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS ON DECEMBER 31, 1990 BY BASE OFFENSE

In these tabulations, the Base Offense is that which is the most serious offense at the time of admission. These figures reflect base or controlling offense at admission only, and do not include offenses in addition to the base to the base offense in the case of multiple sentences at admission, nor are additional sentences imposed following initial admission to the State Correctional System included in the data.

- Violent Crimes include homicide, sexual assault, aggravated assault, robbery, other sex offenses (i.e. incest, carnal abuse, sodomy and impairing the morals of a minor) and other persons offenses (i.e. simple assault, weapons offenses, coercion, larceny from a person and negligent manslaughter).
- Property Offenses include burglary, arson, breaking and entering, theft, forgery, embezzlement, auto theft and receiving/possessing stolen property.
- Public Policy Offenses include racketeering, gambling, violation of probation, prostitution, corruption, perjury, escape, bail jumping, juvenile or family related offenses and conspiracy. Violation of probation is the commitment offense for the vast majority of those in the Public Policy category.
- Narcotics Violations include distribution, manufacture and possession/use of drugs. Over 90% of these are for distribution, manufacture and sale.

- Fifty-six percent (56%) of the offenders in the Prison Complex have been convicted of a crime of a violent nature. This is the first time in the history of the Department that this figure has dropped below 60% for the Prison Complex.
- Twenty-seven percent (27%) of all offenders in the Prison Complex have been convicted of narcotics violations.



 Only 36% of the female residents have been committed for violent offenses.

- In the chart above, we see that 39% of all Prison Complex males are serving terms of 15 years or more (including those serving life terms).
- Seventy-two percent (72%) of all offenders at New Jersey State Prison-Main are serving terms of 20 years or more, with 500 of those serving life sentences.
- Forty-seven percent (47%) of all offenders at East Jersey State Prison-Main are serving sentences of 15 years or less with 47% serving sentences greater than 20 years.
- Fifty-six percent (56%) of all offenders at Bayside State Prison-Main are serving sentences of 5 years or less.



- Forty-two percent (42%) of the offenders at the Adult Diagnostic and Treatment Center are serving sentences of 15 years or more.



EDNA MAHAN CORRECTIONAL FACILITY FOR WOMEN

- Fifty-seven (57%) of the female offenders at Edna Mahan Correctional Facility for Women are serving sentences of five years or less.
