- \* The majority of the men (82.2 percent) and women (88.5 percent) in residence were classified as new sentences. This classification includes offenders admitted with new sentences and those admitted as probation violators with or without new sentences.  
(See Table 1, pps.4-6, pps.40-41)
- \* White men made up more than one-half (53.1 percent) of the population while almost two-fifths (38.9 percent) were Black. One-half (50.0 percent) of the women were White and somewhat less than one-half (45.2 percent) were Black.  
(See Table 2, p.7, p.42)
- \* The major offenses for which men in residence had most often been convicted and sentenced were unarmed burglary (17.2 percent), other drug violations (9.0 percent), armed robbery (8.6 percent), and first degree sexual assault (8.0 percent). Women were most frequently sentenced for forgery (17.6 percent), theft (14.6 percent), other drug violations (12.2 percent), and first degree murder (6.3 percent).

- \* Three-tenths (30.2 percent) of the men were classified solely as property offenders. Almost three-fifths (57.2 percent) of the men were classified as assaultive offenders, one-fifth (20.9 percent) as sex offenders, and over one-tenth (14.4 percent) as drug offenders. These three classifications are not mutually exclusive.

- \* Almost one-half (46.1 percent) of the women were classified only as property offenders. Over one-third (36.0 percent) were classified assaultive offenders, about one-fifth (17.9 percent) as drug offenders, and less than one-tenth (4.5 percent) as sex offenders. The latter three categories are not mutually exclusive.

- \* Men in residence were serving an average (mean) sentence of 11.0 years; women, an average (mean) sentence of 6.3 years. Residents serving life sentences, 419 men and 20 women, were excluded from these computations.

- \* About one-third of the men (36.4 percent) and women (34.2 percent) were committed to the institutions from Milwaukee County. Commitments from Dane, Kenosha, Racine, and Rock counties accounted for an additional one-fourth (26.2 percent) of the men and one-third (33.3 percent) of the women in residence.

- \* Men, with an average (mean) age of 31.0 years, were over one year younger than women who had an average (mean) age of 32.5 years.

- \* Five out of 10 men (54.6 percent) and women (52.5 percent) in residence were born in Wisconsin.

- \* About three-fourths (73.4 percent) of the men and three-fifths (60.4 percent) of the women were found to be free from any physical, developmental, or emotional disabilities.

- \* Less than one-fifth of the men (16.7 percent) and 3 women (1.0 percent) had a record of service in the military.

- \* One-third of the men (35.4 percent) and women (34.8 percent) had some high school education but had not earned diplomas. High school diplomas or GED certificates had been earned by four-tenths (41.8 percent) of the men and three-tenths (29.8 percent) of the women.

- \* A tested grade level of sixth grade or less was reported for one-third (33.0 percent) of the men and one-fourth (26.5 percent) of the women. Three-tenths of the men (27.7 percent) and women (31.6 percent) tested at or above the twelfth grade level.

- \* Men had been confined for an average (mean) of 26.8 months; women, for 18.5 months. About one-fourth of the men (23.2 percent) and one-third of the women (32.4 percent) had been institutionalized for less than six months.

- \* Men classified as close or maximum custody made up over two-fifths (43.6 percent) of the population, while an additional two-fifths (45.3 percent) were classified as medium or medium out, and about one-tenth (11.1 percent) were classified as minimum. Three-tenths (30.1 percent) of the women were classified as maximum, four-tenths (40.5 percent) as medium or medium out, and the remaining three-tenths (29.2 percent) as minimum.

- \* Over one-third (36.6 percent) of the men and one-fourth (23.5 percent) of the women were in serious need for treatment of problems relating to the abuse of alcohol.

- \* Two-thirds (65.2 percent) of the men and three-fifths (59.5 percent) of the women had at least a moderate need for treatment of drug abuse problems.  
(See Table 16, p. 35, p. 66)
- \* Eight out of 10 men (81.9 percent) and 7 out of 10 women (69.1 percent) were found to have some type of problem with the abuse of alcohol and/or other drugs.  
(See Table 17, p. 36, p. 67)
- \* A need for assistance in dealing with some type of mental health problem was noted for one-fifth of the men (18.7 percent) and women (22.7 percent).

- \* Over one-half (53.5 percent) of the men and almost two-thirds (63.1 percent) of the women were found, after testing, to have at least a moderated need for involvement in some type of educational program.  
(See Table 19, p. 38, p. 69)
- \* The results of testing and evaluation indicated that three-fourths (75.2 percent) of the men and over two-thirds (68.8 percent) of the women had at least a moderate need for some type of vocational training.
