I. FELONY CONVICTIONS — NUMBER AND CATEGORY

Throughout 1990, convictions for crimes against the person were sharply higher than in 1989; the fourth quarter showed a 26 percent increase over the same quarter in 1989, and the full year was 24 percent higher than in 1989. Crimes against property also increased throughout 1990; the fourth quarter of 1990 was 15 percent higher than 1989, and the total for the year was 16 percent over 1989.

Felony drug law convictions, which had been showing an increase, began to decline in the last half of 1990. The fourth quarter was 1 percent lower than the same quarter in 1989, and the full year was only 4 percent more than 1989.

II. FELONY CONVICTIONS — SUMMARY OF DISPOSITIONS

Table A compares the current rate of prison commitments with the commitment rates over the past few years, and at the beginning of determinate sentencing.

The most significant change since 1985 is the increased prison commitment rate for felony drug law violations (from 25 to almost 40 percent for all drug law violations). There has been a noticeable but smaller increase in the commitment rate for assault with a deadly weapon (from 45 to 50 percent); the current

quarter's decrease to 44 percent prison commitments is probably an aberration.

The prison commitment rate does not fully reflect the use of incarceration in California. Almost all defendants granted probation in superior court are required to serve a jail term as a condition of probation. Table B indicates the *total incarceration rate*, considering both prison and jail, but excluding other dispositions such as Youth Authority commitments, holding steady at its high of about 96 percent of all those convicted.

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III. FELONY CONVICTIONS — BY APPELLATE DISTRICT

Table C shows the rates of prison commitments by appellate district, summarizing some of the statistics in Tables 2 through 5.

That comparison indicates that the differences noted in previous *Quarterlies* continue to exist in the prison commitment rates in different areas of the state. For example, superior courts

in the Second Appellate District appear to have a consistently higher prison commitment rate for burglary (2nd) and other property crimes than superior courts in the First Appellate District; superior courts in the First Appellate District send a lower percentage of those guilty of possession of narcotics to prison than superior courts in the balance of the state.

IV. DETERMINATE SENTENCING STATISTICS

SENTENCE LENGTH

Statistics on the length of determinate prison sentences appear in Table 6. These are summarized for selected crimes, over time, in Table D.

Table D indicates that most high volume crimes (e.g., theft, burglary, robbery) showed no significant change in average sentence length from quarter to quarter, over the past several years. An exception is assault with a deadly weapon, which shows an increase in three successive quarters.

In the case of voluntary manslaughter, the average sentence in 1984 shows the impact of the increase, effective January 1 of that year, in authorized sentence (to 3, 6, or 11 years); but by 1986, the quarter-to-quarter variation appears to reflect only the random variation to be expected for a lower volume crime.

Statutes effective in 1979 and 1980 significantly increased the possible sentence for rape. Those changes appear to have had their full effect by 1984, the beginning of the period covered by Table D. There continues to be considerable quarter-to-quarter var-

iation in average sentence, as would be expected for a lower volume crime (500-600 convictions per year) for which an individual sentence may be as low as 3 years, in a case without complications, to somewhere in the vicinity of 100 years, for a case with multiple rapes and other violent sex crimes, and such complicating factors as weapons use and prior convictions.

In the more complete tabulations of sentence length, Table 6, it should be noted that the "minimum" sentence listed under "Range of Sentence Imposed" is one-third of the middle authorized term for several of the crimes listed. This is caused by a reporting error: the courts sometimes report only the time added by a new consecutive sentence, instead of the new "aggregate term" computed per Penal Code section 1170.1(a). This reporting error does not mean that there is an error in the actual sentence imposed. In the maximum sentence column, "99.0" may represent a sentence greater than 99 years, as the computer is programmed to treat 99 years as the maximum allowable determinate term.

V. IMPACT OF DRUG CASES ON TRIAL COURT VOLUME

As noted in section I, the total volume of felony drug law convictions leveled off and began to decline in the last half of 1990, while convictions for crimes against property were increasing, and

crimes of violence against persons were increasing sharply. These data appear in detail in the following special tabulation.

These data depict a California pattern similar to that reported for the full United States in the FBI's Uniform Crime Reports: a decrease in drug law offenses, but a sharp increase in crimes of violence. (*Crime in the United States 1990*, page 183, Table 32, reported arrests of males for violent crimes in 1990 as 11.8 percent higher than in 1989, arrests for property crimes almost unchanged, and arrests of males for drug abuse violations as 14.1 percent lower than in 1989.)

As in prior quarters, a smaller percentage of drug cases actually went to trial than cases involving such crimes as assault with a deadly weapon and burglary (first degree). The trial rate of 2 percent of convictions was most similar to the rate for burglary (second degree). Aside from their sheer volume, therefore, the drug cases do not impose an inordinate workload on the courts.

VI. DATA NOTES

Statistical tables in the *Quarterly* are derived from case reports received from superior courts. Despite the efforts of data processing and editing personnel, a few cases could not be tabulated because they had a code or section number that could not be interpreted as a felony offense or were so inconsistent internally that an error had to be assumed. No other reports are excluded. A very few reports lacked county identifiers or information on whether the conviction was by trial or plea; these cases are included in aggregate totals, but are necessarily excluded from breakdowns by appellate district or by type of conviction. Consequently

Tables 2 through 5 (by appellate district) will not add to Table 1 (state total), and the totals for particular crimes in Tables 7 and 8 (by manner of conviction) may not equal the Table 1 totals for the same crime.

In a few instances seemingly erroneous dispositions were reported. Most of these anomalies were cleared up by consulting the original document; it might, for example, show that the crime was an attempt, or was committed prior to a change in the law. Even when the anomaly cannot be explained, the crime is tabulated as it was reported by the court.
