

Region I: Covers all the counties north of Los Angeles and San Bernardino counties, with the exception of those in Region II.

Region II: Covers the San Francisco Bay Area including: Alameda, Contra Costa, Del Norte, Humboldt, Lake, Marin, Mendocino, Monterey, Napa, San Benito, San Francisco, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, Solano and Sonoma.

Region III: Covers Los Angeles county excluding the southeastern area (Long Beach through Pomona).


Region IV: Covers all southern California from San Bernardino county and the southeastern area of Los Angeles County to the Mexican Border.


As of December 31, 1991, there were 77,120 California felons receiving parole supervision in California.

Population
December 31, 1970 - 1991

- There was an increase of 11,700 parolees since December 31, 1990.
- The felon parole population consisted of 69,758 (90.5%) males and 7,362 (9.5%) females.




Region of Parole

- Region I accounted for 21.7% (16,711) of the felon parole population.
- Region II accounted for 20.3% (15,690) of the felon parole population.
- Region III accounted for 25.9% (20,002) of the felon parole population.

CALIFORNIA FELON PAROLEES SUPERVISED IN CALIFORNIA


Offense Categories

- Offenders with other offenses accounted for 9.3% (7,134) of the felon parole population.

December 31, 1991




CALIFORNIA FELON PAROLEES SUPERVISED IN CALIFORNIA

The Black racial /ethnic group represents the highest percentage of the California Felon Parolees supervised in California..


- In Region I, the White racial/ethnic group represented the largest percentage of the population, accounting for 44.4% (7,426).
- The Black racial/ethnic group represented the largest percentage of the population in Region II and Region III, accounting for 42.8% (6,710) and 47.1% (9,430), respectively.
- The largest percentage of the parole population for Region IV was represented by the Hispanic (Mexican) racial/ethnic group, accounting for 38.2% (9,437).

Over half (50.8%) of the felon parolees fall into the 25-34 year old age groups.

- There were no felon parolees in the under 18 age group.
- The largest age group of felons on parole was 25 to 29 years old and accounted for 25.7% (19,805) of the population.
- The next largest age group was 30 to 34 years old, accounting for 25.1% (19,348) of the population.
- The smallest age group was 18 to 19 years, which represented 0.2% (142) of the population.
- The 60 and over age group represented the next smallest percentage, which accounted for 0.9% (688) of the population.
