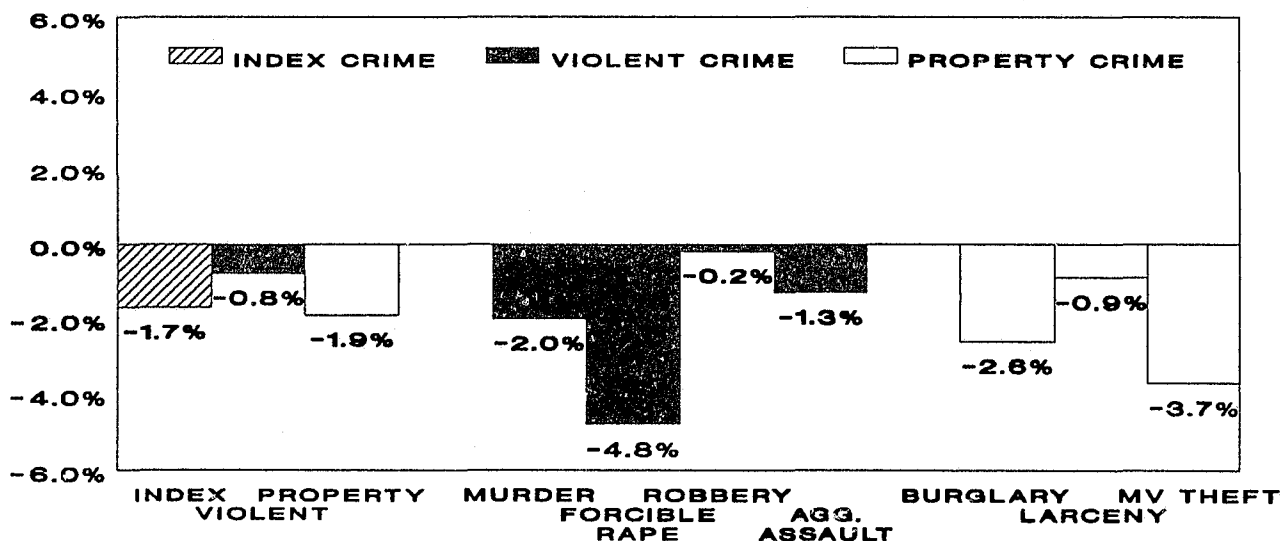

INDEX CRIMES IN NEW YORK STATE (ESTIMATED) DECREASED 1.7% FROM 1990 TO 1991

- New York City reported a 4.4% decrease in index offenses while index crimes in the statewide sample decreased 1.7%.
- The sampled Upstate jurisdictions increased 3.9%.
- Among the Upstate jurisdictions, agencies in the 100,000 to 999,999 population group had a 5.6% increase in index offenses, agencies in the 50,000 to 99,999 group increased 2.7%, while the 25,000 to 49,999 group increased 3.2%.
- Agencies with populations under 25,000 and multijurisdictional agencies increased 3.4%.

The crime data in this bulletin are estimates based on Uniform Crime Reports (UCR) index crimes reported for 1991 and 1990 by law enforcement agencies that had submitted complete monthly reports as of March, 1992. Populations are 1990 estimates based on data from the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

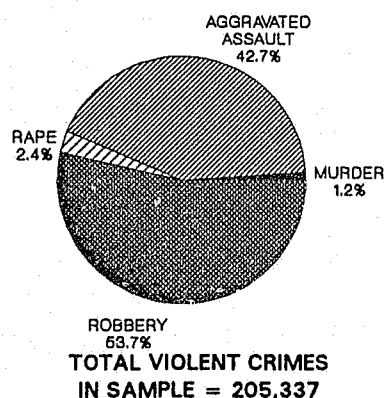

VIOLENT CRIME DECREASED 0.8% STATEWIDE



- Robbery is the most frequently occurring violent crime in the State (54% of all violent crimes).
- New York City reported a decrease of 2.4% in violent crime and accounted for 83% of the violent crimes in the sample.
- The sampled Upstate agencies showed a 7.7% increase in violent crime.
- Agencies in the 25,000 to 49,999 population group showed an increase of 6.8%; agencies in the 50,000 to 99,999 group had an increase of 11.9% and those in the 100,000 to 999,999 group increased 5.5%.
- Agencies under 25,000 population and multijurisdictional agencies had a 9.4% increase in violent crime.

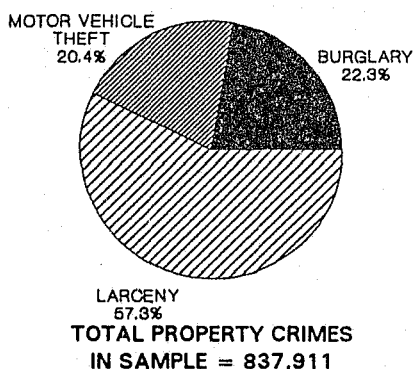

- Larceny is the most frequently occurring property crime, with a frequency more than double that of any other property crime.
- New York City reported a decrease of 5.1% in property crime and accounted for 61% of the property crimes in the sample.
- The sampled Upstate agencies reported a 3.5% increase in property crime.
- Agencies in the population group 25,000 to 49,999 reported a 2.9% increase, agencies in the 50,000 to 99,999 population group had a 2.0% increase and the 100,000 to 999,999 group increased 5.7%.
- Agencies under 25,000 population and multijurisdictional agencies had a 2.9% increase in property crime.

Statewide estimates of crime trends derived from a sample of reporting jurisdictions appear to mirror closely the trends calculated from final data covering all jurisdictions. For example, the 1990 estimates published one year ago compared closely to the final 1990 statewide data reflecting all jurisdictions in the State (See table at left.) In categories where the estimated percent change is very close to zero (e.g. aggravated assault with -0.1%), the final statewide totals may shift sufficiently to produce a small positive percent change.
