The OTHER category includes county diagnostic cases, Youth Authority, federal, prisoners from other states and safekeepers.

Cases with incomplete or missing data are included in the tables, but are excluded from the total in order to compute a more accurate percentage. Due to rounding, percentages may not add to total.
