HIGHLIGHTS

Comparisons of preliminary data for January-March, 1991 and January-March, 1992

New York State

Felony arrests totaled 50,420 for January-March, 1992, 1 percent above the 50,062 felony arrests reported for the same period in 1991 but 6 percent below the 53,889 felony arrests reported for January-March, 1990. Felony drug arrests for the first quarter of 1992 were down 2 percent from 1991 and 10 percent from 1990.

Felony indictments for the first quarter of 1992 totaled 18,613, an increase of 1 percent from the first quarter of 1991. Felony drug indictments for the first quarter of 1992 were 5 percent below the same quarter in 1991 and 12 percent below 1990.

Convictions resulting from felony indictments dropped 2 percent from 1991 to 1992 and convictions from felony drug indictments also fell 2 percent.

Total state prison sentences dropped 6 percent from 1991 to 1992 and drug convictions were down 7 percent.

N.B.: The unit of count for indictments, superior court informations, and dispositions is the defendant-indictment.

Each defendant named in a felony indictment or superior court information is counted separately.

Each indictment or superior court information returned against a defendant is counted separately.

Data are not transactional, i.e., indictments and superior court informations are not necessarily based on arrests within the same year and dispositions may also result from indictments in previous years.

Additional technical information on the collection and processing of this information is available from the Division of Criminal Justice Services, Bureau of Statistical Services.

Data for Greene and Schoharie counties have been incomplete since 1990.
