



I N T R O D U C T I O N

The identification of crime, through the collection of meaningful data, provides a base for more effective enforcement. Collection of refined information, the collation and analysis which follow, allows dissemination to contributors in the form of additional intelligence upon which more effective police action can be based. The statistics tabulated in this publication are provided by reports submitted by law enforcement agencies in the state.

Basically these statistics, for the sake of brevity, are confined to the following:

1. Crime Index Comparison showing crime rates in Oregon compared with the latest average U. S. Crime rates.
2. A state summary of crimes reported or cleared.
3. Crimes reported or cleared by all agencies.
4. Crimes reported by all agencies - seven offense group consisting of murder and non-negligent manslaughter, rape and attempted rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, larceny over \$200, and auto theft.
5. Crimes reported by all agencies other than the seven offense group.
6. Arrests reported by age group from fingerprint cards received.
7. Total arrests all crimes reported from fingerprint cards received.

To make these statistics more meaningful, we have calculated a crime rate for the entire state and individual counties to express reported crimes on a standardized basis. The crime rate is based on the total number of offenses per 100,000 population, which is the method normally used in the United States.

During 1973, a total of 56,349 crime reports was received from all agencies in the state compared to 52,098 such reports received for 1972, an increase of 8.2 percent.

Chapter 181, Oregon Revised Statutes, requires all law enforcement agencies of any political subdivision of the state to file with the Bureau of Identification and Investigation, Department of State Police, within 48 hours after such crime is reported, a report on each crime which involved the commission of a felony, any misdemeanor or other offense or violation of a city ordinance, any element of which involves sexual conduct prohibited by law; and any misdemeanor or other offense or violation of a city ordinance, any of which involves the use or sale of narcotic drugs or dangerous drugs. This statute also provides for the submission of fingerprints, taking of photographs of individuals charged with the specific crimes listed herein, and the submission of supplemental reports covering disposition of cases reported. In compiling the statistics included in this publication, we are limiting the offenses to those particular crimes for which reports are required by law. Juvenile statistics are not included unless remanded to adult court.

In publishing this data, we rely on the submitting agencies for the accuracy of the contents. The data is compiled from available information in the hope that it may throw some light on the problems of crime detection and prevention, and the treatment of offenders.

Not all major crimes occur with enough frequency to be meaningful in an index. It is hoped that this publication will furnish an abbreviated and convenient measure of our crime problem in Oregon.

CLARIFICATION OF OFFENSE CLASSIFICATION

The following information is provided as a guide for cooperating agencies to assist in defining the particular offenses:

1. The crime figures presented in this publication are police statistics and are distinguished in this manner so as not to confuse them with judicial or penal statistics.
2. Crimes included are limited to violations of the Oregon Statutes.
3. Offenses are tabulated from crime reports received by the State Police from Oregon law enforcement agencies with the exception of auto theft. This figure is tabulated from information received from the Law Enforcement Data System.
4. Offenses tabulated are basically limited to the seven major offense group. These consist of offenses shown by experience to be those frequently and reliably reported to the police. Other offenses tabulated are sex crimes (including both felonies and misdemeanors), violations of narcotic and dangerous drug laws, and other felonies.
5. Crimes included in the seven offense group may have been reported to the police directly by a citizen's complaint, or by notification from a district attorney, court official, or in some other reliable manner.
6. Reports that are incomplete or duplicated are excluded.
7. Each crime reported is counted as one offense regardless of the number of persons involved.
8. A juvenile taken into custody is counted as a person arrested if he has been remanded to adult court for trial.

DESCRIPTION OF CRIME CLASSIFICATION

SEVEN MAJOR OFFENSE GROUP

1. Murder and non-negligent homicide includes all willful, felonious homicides and manslaughter, but does not include criminal negligent homicide or attempts.
2. Rape includes all degrees of rape or any attempts.

3. Robbery is defined as the theft or attempted theft of property through the use of threat, fear, physical violence, or any attempt to commit such theft.

4. Aggravated assault includes attempted murder and any assault involving serious physical injury or physical injury inflicted by a deadly or dangerous weapon.

5. Burglary includes any unlawful entry into or remaining in a building or dwelling for the purpose of committing a crime therein or any attempts to do so.

6. Larceny - theft, except auto theft, over \$200 in value.

7. Auto theft includes all cases where a motor vehicle is stolen or driven away and abandoned, and so-called joyriding thefts.

SEX OFFENSES OTHER THAN RAPE

Includes all offenses against chastity, common decency, morals, and the like, except those offenses listed under number 2 in the seven major offense group. Also included in this category are sex offenses of a commercialized nature, and attempts.

NARCOTIC AND DANGEROUS DRUG OFFENSES

Includes all offenses of possession, manufacture, unlawful use, sale or distribution of narcotics or dangerous drugs as defined under the Oregon statutes, as well as fraudulently obtaining or attempts to do so and fraudulent sales of imitation narcotics or dangerous drugs.

OTHER OFFENSES

1. Arson includes willful fire setting.

2. Forgery and counterfeiting includes offenses dealing with making, altering, uttering and possessing forged documents.

3. Fraud deals with the making, altering, presenting, advertising, converting and obtaining money or property under false pretenses.

4. Weapons, carrying, possessing by person previously convicted of a felony.

5. Offenses against family and children, including non-support.

6. All other miscellaneous offenses defined as felonies.

Crime Index Comparison. Includes comparative statistics for 1969 through 1972 of U. S. and Oregon, reflecting total major offenses reported, together with individual crimes included in the seven major offense category as well as the crime rate per 100,000 population. Statistics included for the U. S. are derived from Uniform Crime Reports published by the Federal Bureau of Investigation. Figures for Oregon are compiled from reports received from law enforcement agencies within the state. Auto theft statistics are derived from monthly tabulations received from the Law Enforcement Data System.

In comparing Oregon's Crime Index with the statistics published in the Uniform Crime Reports by the Federal Bureau of Investigation, it should be pointed out that in Oregon, larceny over \$75 is tabulated as such for the years 1969 through 1971, and over \$200 for 1972 and 1973, instead of larceny over \$50.

Oregon statistics for 1973 are shown in the table, but comparative figures for the U. S. are not yet available.
