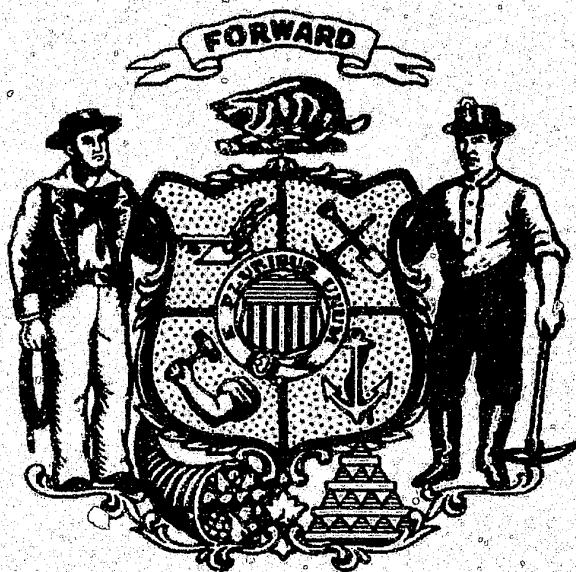

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HIGHLIGHTS

ACQUISITIONS

- * Eight out of 10 men (75.5 percent) and women (91.3 percent) admitted to Wisconsin's correctional institutions for adult offenders during calendar year 1991 were classified as new admissions. This category includes offenders who were not under any type of supervision at the time of sentencing as well as those who were incarcerated with or without new sentences because of violation of probation supervision.
(See Table 1.)
- * Unarmed burglary (17.7 percent), other drug offenses (13.2 percent), unarmed robbery (6.5 percent), and theft (6.4 percent) were the offenses for which men were most frequently sentenced. Women were most often sentenced for other drug offenses (19.9 percent), forgery and theft (13.6 percent each), and fraud (4.8 percent).
(See Table 2.)
- * Men entered the institution with an average sentence of 80.2 months; women with 55.1 months. The average sentence for all offenders received in 1991 was 78.5 months. Two-thirds (66.6 percent) of the admissions entered the institution with sentences of five years or less. Forty-nine men and 3 women with life sentences were excluded from these computations.
(See Table 3.)
- * Two-fifths (39.8 percent) of the men and over one-third (36.0 percent) of the women admitted during 1991 were committed from Milwaukee County. Commitments from Dane, Kenosha, Racine, and Rock Counties accounted for an additional one-fourth (25.5 percent) of the men and over one-third (35.6 percent) of the women received at the institutions.
(See Table 4.)
- * The average lengths of sentence received by men convicted of unarmed burglary, other drug violations, unarmed robbery, and theft were 72.9, 47.7, 96.0, and 54.8 months respectively. Women sentenced for other drug offenses, forgery, theft, and fraud received average sentences of 50.4, 41.3, 38.1, and 36.0 months.
(See Table 5.)
- * Over one-half (56.2 percent) of the men admitted were classified as assaultive offenders, one-fifth (19.5 percent) as drug offenders and over one-tenth (13.8 percent) as sex offenders. These three categories are not mutually exclusive. Men classified solely as property offenders made up three-tenths (29.4 percent) of the admissions.
(See Table 6.)

- * More than one-third (35.7 percent) of the women admitted in 1991 were categorized solely as property offenders. Those classified as assaultive offenders made up over one-third (35.7 percent) of the admissions, almost three-tenths (27.6 percent) were drug offenders, and almost one-tenth (8.4 percent) as sex offenders. The latter three categories are not mutually exclusive.
(See Table 6.)
- * Men, with an average age of 28.2 years, were over two years younger than women who had an average age of 30.3 years.
(See Table 7.)
- * Men from White racial and ethnic backgrounds made up just under one-half (47.3 percent) with Blacks accounting for an additional two-fifths (42.9 percent) of the admissions. In contrast, over one-half (54.4 percent) of women admitted were Black while two-fifths (40.8 percent) were White.

- * Seven out of 10 men (68.1 percent) and 5 out of 10 women (51.1 percent) had never been married.
(See Table 9.)
- * Approximately one-half (48.6 percent) of the men and two-thirds (65.8 percent) of the women had no record of prior felony convictions. About one-fourth (27.4 percent) of the men and over one-tenth (14.0 percent) of the women had a record of two or more prior felony convictions aside from the conviction which resulted in this admission.
(See Table 10.)
- * Over one-half (55.8 percent) of the men and three-fourths (75.4 percent) of the women had no record of prior incarceration in a penal institution. Previous confinement in Wisconsin correctional facilities was noted for over one-third (35.1 percent) of the men and one-fifth (19.1 percent) of the women.
(See Table 11.)
- * One-fourth (23.9 percent) of the men and over one-tenth (12.5 percent) of the women had a record of previous confinement in a correctional facility for juvenile offenders.
(See Table 12.)
- * Four out of 10 men (41.2 percent) and women (39.3 percent) were found to have some high school education but had not earned diplomas. High school diplomas or GED certificates were held by about two-fifths (38.8 percent) of the men and over one-fourth (27.6 percent) of the women.

- * The majority of the men (70.7 percent) and women (73.5 percent) were free from any disability at admission. Over one-tenth of the males (11.4 percent) and females (14.8 percent) were found to have some type of physical disability upon admission.

- * The majority, 84.0 percent of the men and 95.2 percent of the women had no record of service in the military.
(See Table 15.)
- * After completion of assessment and evaluation security assignment procedures over one-fifth (22.4 percent) of the men received an initial security rating of close or maximum, one-third (33.2 percent) were rated as medium or medium out, an additional one-third (34.8 percent) were assigned a minimum classification, and less than one-tenth (8.5 percent) were classified as suitable for special programs. Maximum security ratings were assigned to less than one-fifth (15.4 percent) of the women, one-tenth (11.8 percent) were rated as medium, three-fifths (59.6 percent) as minimum, and over one-tenth (12.5 percent) as suitable for special programs.
(See Table 16.)
- * Two-fifths (41.6 percent) of the men were initially placed in maximum or maximum/medium facilities, one-third (34.6 percent) in medium facilities, and less than one-fourth (22.8 percent) in minimum facilities. Over one-half (56.6 percent) of the women were assigned to a maximum/medium facility while over two-fifths (42.7 percent) were placed in minimum settings.

- * Slightly less than one-half (45.5 percent) of the men and one-third (33.1 percent) of the women were seriously in need of treatment for problems related to alcohol usage.
(See Table 18.)
- * A serious need for involvement in programs designed to treat those with problems related to drugs and drug usage was noted for two-fifths (41.5 percent) of the men and just under one-half (47.8 percent) of the women.
(See Table 19.)
- * Less than one-fifth (18.8 percent) of the men and women (18.0 percent) were not in need of treatment for problems relating to the usage of alcohol and/or other drugs.
(See Table 20.)
- * Five out of 10 men (49.4 percent) and women (48.2 percent) were found to have at least a moderate need for involvement in some type of educational training program.
(See Table 21.)

- * Approximately two-thirds (63.4 percent) of the men and three-fifths (57.7 percent) of the women had at least a moderate need for involvement in some type of vocational training program.
(See Table 22.)
- * Eight out of 10 men (81.4 percent) and women (83.8 percent) did not have a need for any type of mental health services.
(See Table 23.)
- * Participation in drug and/or alcohol treatment programs, vocational training programs, and other therapy programs were the placements recommended most frequently for men and women admitted during calendar year.
(See Table 24.)
