



#### HIGHLIGHTS

- » **Arrests:** The total number of adult arrests in 1992 was four percent below the level reported in 1991. This marks the third consecutive year of declines since arrests peaked in 1989. Felony arrests dropped almost six percent, while misdemeanors were down by three percent. However, arrest declines were not experienced by all regions of the State. Significant increases in felony drug arrests were reported in regions which encompass the larger upstate metropolitan areas.
- » **Indictments:** The number of felony indictments (including superior court informations - SCIs) dropped three percent between 1991 and 1992. This decline was primarily driven by fewer drug and non-violent felony indictments in New York City. The Western, Central and Southern tiers of the State experienced large increases in both drug and violent felony indictments.

*Note: The arrests and indictment comparisons are based on preliminary data compiled approximately three weeks beyond the close of each year. Percentage increases or decreases may change somewhat as reporting becomes final.*



### NEW YORK STATE TRENDS IN ADULT ARRESTS: 1983 - 1992





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## NEW YORK STATE ARRESTS AND INDICTMENTS : 1992 vs. 1991

Data for this bulletin were derived from the Computerized Criminal History system and the Indictment Statistical System maintained by the Division of Criminal Justice Services.

The regional groupings used are the economic areas defined by the State Department of Economic Development and consist of the following counties:

New York City: Bronx, Kings, New York, Queens and Richmond;

Long Island: Nassau and Suffolk;

Mid Hudson: Dutchess, Orange, Putnam, Rockland, Sullivan, Ulster and Westchester;

Finger Lakes: Genesee, Livingston, Monroe, Ontario, Orleans, Seneca, Wayne, Wyoming and Yates;

Western New York: Allegany, Cattaraugus, Chautauqua, Erie and Niagara;

Central New York: Cayuga, Cortland, Madison, Onondaga and Oswego;

Capital District: Albany, Columbia, Greene, Rensselaer, Saratoga, Schenectady, Warren and Washington;

Southern Tier: Broome, Chemung, Chenango, Delaware, Otsego, Schuyler, Steuben, Tioga and Tompkins;

Mohawk Valley: Fulton, Hamilton, Herkimer, Montgomery, Oneida and Schoharie;

North Country: Clinton, Essex, Franklin, Jefferson, Lewis and St. Lawrence.
