Data concerning the number and nature of crimes committed in the state of North Dakota is collected through the Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) Program. This is a voluntary program involving county sheriff's offices and many city law enforcement agencies. In 1991, participating agencies submitted data using either summary reporting or incident-based reporting. Summary reporting is a tally system of reporting the number of index offenses and arrests occurring each month. The incident-based system involves use of a standard incident form to collect data on each incident reported to the agency. This method collects more detailed information than is collected by the summary system.

### **ARRESTS**

Table I on page 2 presents the DUI arrest totals for the period 1978-1991. DUI arrests increased 6.6 percent from 4,322 in 1990 to 4,607 in 1991. The arrest totals shown should not be interpreted as the number of individuals arrested for DUI offenses since it is possible that some individuals may have been arrested for DUI on more than one occasion. The peak number of arrests occurred in 1982 with 9,238 arrests for DUI reported. DUI arrest totals for each year are presented graphically in Figure I.

**DUI Arrest Totals, 1978-1991**

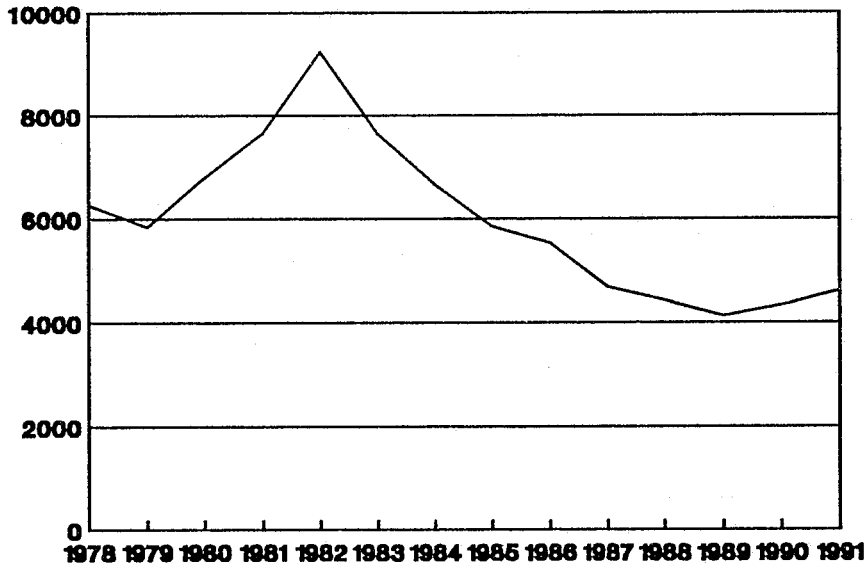


Table II on the following page is a summary of DUI arrests by arresting agency for the fourteen-year period from 1978 through 1991. This table also contains the average number of arrests for each agency during this period. The Highway Patrol has consistently made the largest number of arrests for DUI. In 1991, that agency made 1,562, or approximately 34 percent, of the 4,607 arrests.

## DUI Arrests by Age and Gender

Table V below analyzes the DUI arrest totals by gender of those arrested. An average of 86 percent of the arrests during this period were arrests of males.

Table VI includes information on arrests by age category. Juveniles, persons under the age of eighteen, made up less than 2 percent of the total. No age data was reported for 30 DUI arrests in 1991.

Table VII on page 7 presents a breakdown of arrests for DUI by age group and gender for the period 1983-1991. This table also contains adult and juvenile arrest totals for this offense each year. Table VIII on page 8 contains information on adult and juvenile DUI arrests for each reporting agency.

Supervision of Juveniles for DUI

In 1991 the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation began using a new reporting form for collection of juvenile supervision data. In the past, incarcerations of adults and detentions of juveniles were recorded on the same reporting form. The Juvenile Detention Record was designed to collect more detailed information than is collected by the adult incarceration form, and to allow for the reporting of attendant care and supervision in other non-secure settings.

DUI was the most serious offense reported in 19 supervision incidents in 1991. This represents 1.4 percent of the 1,370 total supervision incidents reported.

## Incarcerations of Adults for DUI

Each local correctional facility in the state of North Dakota records information on the individuals incarcerated in their facility. The adult incarceration data is reported to the North Dakota Jail Information System (NDJIS) which summarizes various characteristics of incarcerated persons, the reasons for incarceration, lengths of incarceration, legal status at the time of intake, and means of release. NDJIS currently does not receive incarceration data from jail facilities on the state's Indian reservations. Data from the NDJIS does not include data from the State Industrial School, the Missouri River Correctional Center, the State Penitentiary, or any other state institution. The incarceration totals should not be interpreted as the number of individuals incarcerated for DUI offenses since it is possible that some individuals may have been incarcerated more than once in the same or in subsequent years for this offense.

The total number of adult incarcerations for DUI offenses for the years 1978-1991 is shown in Table XII. The number of adult incarcerations for DUI increased 18.2 percent from 3,872 in 1990 to 4,578 in 1991. DUI was the reason for incarceration in approximately 23 percent of the 19,822 total adult incarcerations in 1991.
