

#### **Total Number of Incidents**


• There were 4,184 inmate incidents in the California Department of Corrections institutions and camps. The number of incidents decreased 994 (19.2%) from the total of 5,178 for 1989.

#### **Rate of Incidents**

- The rate of incidents dropped to 4.5 per 100 average daily institution population.
- This is the sixth year in a row that the rate of incidents has decreased since reaching an all time high rate of 12.7 in 1984.




Rate of Incidents per 100 Average Daily

#### **Type of Incidents**

• Assaults accounted for 55.0% (2,300) of all incidents.


#### Type of Incidents Calendar Year 1990



- Assault incidents decreased from 2,657 in 1989 to 2,300 in 1990. Assaults without weapons accounted for almost all of the decrease.
- Drug incidents accounted for 21.9% (916) of all incidents.
- Drug incidents dropped from 1,384 in 1989 to 916 in 1990. Marijuana incidents accounted for over one half of the drop.
- CSP- Corcoran's assaults without a weapon decreased from 637 in 1989 to 300 in 1990.

#### Inmate Fatalities by Institution Calendar Year 1990




- Eleven male inmates were fatally assaulted in 1990.
- CIM had the highest number of fatalities, 1 at RCW and 2 at RCC.
- There have been 15 fatal assaults on staff since 1970. The last one occurred in 1985.

#### **Number of Assaults on Staff**

- In 1990, there were 858 assaults on staff. Of these, 201 (23.4%) involved the use of weapons by inmates.
- Assaults on staff dropped from a high of 914 in 1987 to 858 in 1990.
- Assaults on staff at CSP-Sacramento dropped from a high of 81 in 1988 to 31 in 1990.
- Assaults on staff at CMC-EAST increased from 30 in 1988 to 72 in 1990

#### Rate of Assaults on Staff

• The rate of inmate assaults on staff dropped from 1.1 per 100 average daily institution population in 1989 to 1.0 in 1990.

Rate of Inmate Assaults on Staff Calendar Year 1981-1990


