
## INMATE INCIDENTS

During Calendar Year 1991:

### Total Number of Incidents

- There were 4,120 inmate incidents in the California Department of Corrections institutions and camps. The number of incidents decreased 64 (1.5%) from the total of 4,184 for 1990.


Total Number of Incidents

### Rate of Incidents

- The rate of incidents dropped to 4.3 per 100 average daily institution population (ADP).
- This is the seventh year in a row that the rate of incidents has decreased since reaching an all time high of 12.7 in 1984.


Rate of Incidents Per 100 ADP

### Type of Incidents


Type of Incidents  
 Calendar Year 1991



- Assaults accounted for 58.8% (2,426) of all incidents.
- Assault incidents increased from 2,300 in 1990 to 2,426 in 1991. Assaults with weapons accounted for most of the increase.
- Drug incidents accounted for 15.2% (624) of all incidents.
- Drug incidents dropped from 916 in 1990 to 624 in 1991. Opiate based drug incidents accounted for over three-fourths of the drop.

 Calendar Year 1991




- Four male inmates were fatally assaulted in 1991. Since 1970, this is the lowest number of fatalities.
- There were 2 fatalities at CCI and 1 each at Folsom and SCC.
- There have been 15 fatal assaults on staff since 1970. The last one occurred in 1985.

## INMATE INCIDENTS

### Number of Assaults on Staff

- In 1991, there were 919 assaults on staff. Of these, 302 (32.9%) involved the use of weapons by inmates.
- Assaults on staff increased from 858 in 1990 to 919 in 1991.
- Assaults on staff at CTF-Central have steadily decreased from 107 in 1984 to 26 in 1991.
- Assaults on staff at Folsom decreased from 170 in 1987 to 63 in 1991.
- Assaults on staff at both Pelican Bay SP and CMF-Main increased by over 30 from 1990 to 1991.

### Rate of Assaults on Staff

- The rate of inmate assaults on staff remained stable at 1.0 per 100 average daily institution population for the second year in a row.

Calendar Year 1982 through 1991


