JANUARY - DECEMBER 1993  
(Preliminary Data)

**INMATE POPULATION** The inmate population in DOCS facilities rose by 2,833 inmates (+4.6%) from end of December 1992 to 1993. The number of state ready inmates stood at 1,052 the close of December 1993 compared to 1,340 at the close of December 1992, down 288 (-21.5%). At the close of the thirteenth term of 1993, pending felony cases stood at 22,574. The number of felons convicted but still awaiting sentence stood at 9,455.

**ADMISSIONS** Total admissions for January - December 1993 at 35,830 were 11.2% or 3,600 higher than the 32,230 recorded during this period in 1992. Court commitments decreased by 256 (-1.0%) from 25,153 to 24,897. Returned parole violators increased by 1,587 (+36.4%) while conditional release violators increased by 135 (+45.0%). Other admissions rose from 2,418 to 4,552 (+88.3%) which resulted from an increase in the number of temporary release absconders returned to custody in 1993. The 12 month average increased in all admission categories except for commitments which declined.

Releases There were 32,997 inmates released from DOCS facilities during January - December 1993 which was 4,655 (+ 16.4%) more than the 28,342 released in 1992. Paroles accounted for 22,447 of the 1993 releases compared to 20,302 for January - December 1992, up 2,145 (10.6%). Conditional releases at 3,402 were slightly below (-2.9%) the 3,505 reported in 1992, while releases at expiration of sentence rose by 355. Other releases increased from 3,839 to 6,097 reflecting an increase in absconders from temporary release. The 12-month average showed releases increasing in all categories except conditional releases.




