# **SUMMARY OF**

# **CHARACTERISTICS OF NEW COMMITMENTS**

1992

This document describes the population of new court commitments to the New York State Correctional Services during calendar year 1992. This report is an abridged version of the 129 page report produced earlier this year. The tables contained the the report present information on legal history characteristics of new commitments (e.g. crime, minimum sentence, prior criminal record) and demographic characteristics (e.g. age, sex, ethnic status, county of commitment). In addition, several tables show trends in new court commitments across the years 1989 and 1992.

## Type of Admission

There were 32,229 total admissions to the New York State Department of Correctional Services in calendar year 1992. Of these 25,155 (78%) were new court commitments, 4,697 (15%) were returned parole violators and 2,377 (7%) were other admissions.




## Commitment Offense

Drug offenders made up 45% of new commitments in 1992. In general, 34% of 1992 new commitments were violent felony offenders, 14% were committed for property crimes, 5% for other coercive crimes, and 2% were Youthful Offenders.





# Second Felony Offender Status

Forty-two percent of 1992 new court commitments were sentenced as first felony offenders, 57% as second felony offenders and 1% as persistent felony offenders.





# Felony Class Category

Approximately 2% of 1992 new court commitments were Class A-I crimes. Class A-II offenses made up 3% of commitments; Class B felonies made up 20% of commitments; and Class C felony offenders made up 22% of commitments. Class D felony category was the largest at 34% of commitments. Class E felony offenders comprise 17%.



## Minimum and Maximum Sentences

The minimum sentence reflects the shortest period of time that a person must serve before being considered for release on parole. The average minimum sentence for 1992 new court commitments was 36.3 months (the median was 24.0 months).

The average maximum sentence for 1992 was 82.6 months. Since the development of programs such as Earned Eligibility, the minimum sentence is a much better estimate of the length of time that will be served in state prison than is the maximum sentence.



## Prior Adult Criminal Record

Examination of the prior adult criminal record of 1992 new court commitments, shows 13% had no prior adult arrest, 9% had a prior adult arrest but no conviction, 22% had a prior conviction but received a sentence other than jail or prison, 31% had served a prior local jail sentence, and 27% had previously served a state or federal term.



## Drug Commitments

The number of drug offenders committed to state prison increased substantially between 1989 (9,742) and 1992 (11,225). People committed for possession of controlled substances made up 27% of total drug commitments in 1989, but they were 31% of drug commitments in 1992. This shift is due to more commitments for lower level class D and E drug possession offenses.





## Gender

Males made up 92% of 1992 new court commitments, females 8%. The proportion of commitments to state prison who were drug offenders grew among females from 66% in 1989 to 72% in 1992. However, the percent of males committed for a drug offense declined from 45% in 1989 to 42% in 1992.

# DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONAL SERVICES NEW COMMITMENTS - 1992 GENDER





## Ethnic Status

White offenders committed to state prison in 1992 are made up of approximately one-third violent felony offenders, one-third property offenders and the remaining one-third other felony offenders. Black offenders are approximately one-third violent felony offenders, one-half drug offenders and the remainder other offenders. Hispanic offenders committed to state prison in 1992 were approximately four-sevenths drug offenders, a third violent offenders and the remainder other offenders.



# DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONAL SERVICES NEW COMMITMENTS - 1992 AGE ON COMMITMENT







## **Educational Level**

The average educational level (based on last grade completed as reported by the inmate) among 1992 new court commitments is 10th grade. Based on tests administered at reception to the Department, the average reading level is 8th grade, the average mathematics level is 7th grade.

## Jail Time

Time spent in a local jail prior to conviction or prior to commitment to state prison is credited toward service of the minimum term. On average, the length of time served in a local jail was approximately the same 1992 (6.1 months) as for new commitments in 1991 (6.4 months).
