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### FELON NEW ADMISSIONS

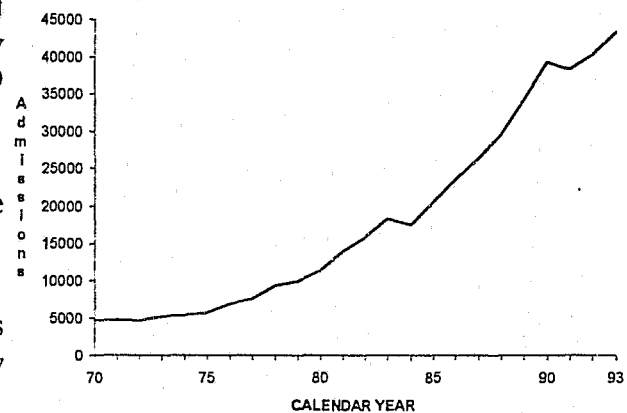
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During Calendar Year 1993, the number of California Department of Corrections felon new admissions increased to 43,149 from 29,579 during 1988.

Felon new admissions increased 134.5% since 1983, 45.9% since 1988 and 7.4% since 1992.

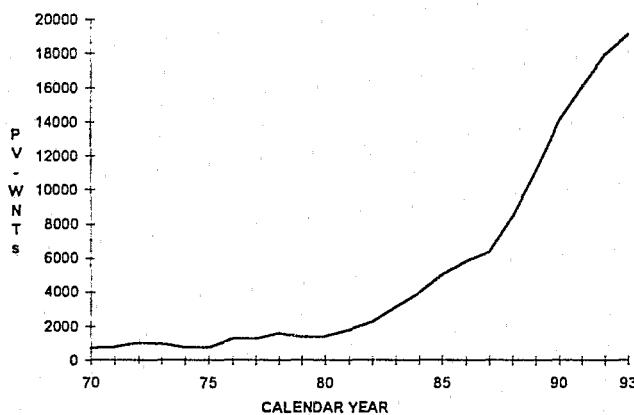
- The number of male felon new admissions was 39,210 and the number of female felon new admissions was 3,939.

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### PAROLE VIOLATORS RETURNED WITH A NEW TERM

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During Calendar Year 1993, Parole Violators Returned With a New Term (PV-WNTs) reached an all time high of 19,150.

- This represents an increase of 506.0% since 1983, 127.7% since 1988 and 6.8% since 1992.
- There were 17,935 male PV-WNTs and 1,215 female PV-WNTs.
