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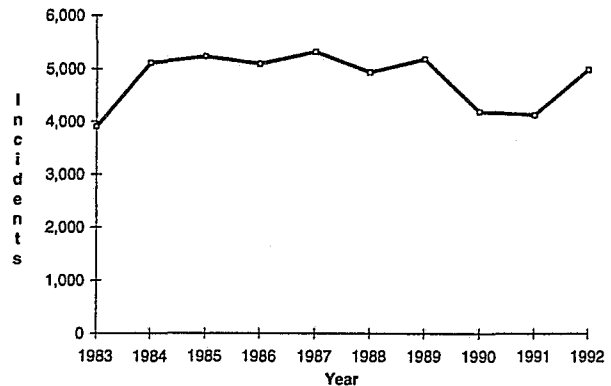
INMATE INCIDENTS

During Calendar Year 1992:

TOTAL NUMBER OF INCIDENTS

There were 4,982 inmate incidents in the California Department of Corrections institutions and camps. The number of incidents increased 862 (20.9%) from the total of 4,120 in 1991.

Calendar Year 1983 through 1992

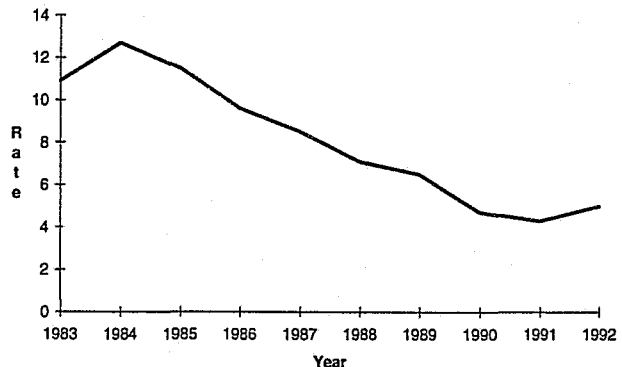


RATE OF INCIDENTS

The rate of incidents increased from 4.3 in 1991 to 5.0 in 1992.

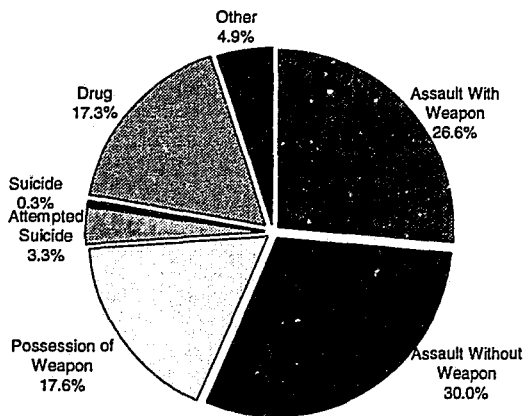
Since 1984, the rate of incidents has steadily decreased dropping from 12.7 in 1984 to 5.0 in 1992.

TYPE OF INCIDENTS

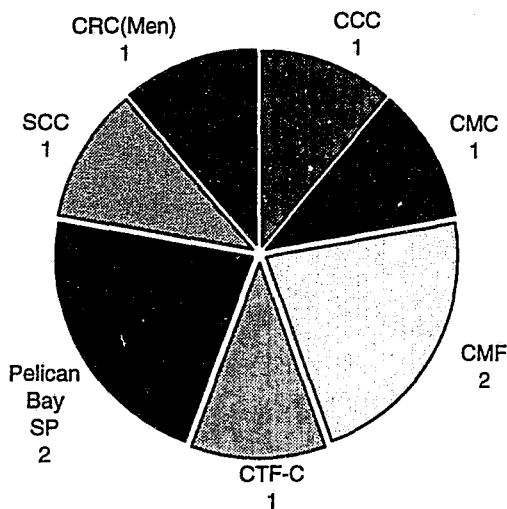
Assaults accounted for 56.6% (2,822) of all incidents.

Assault incidents increased from 2,426 in 1991 to 2,822 in 1992. Assaults with weapons accounted for most of the increase.

Drug incidents accounted for 17.3% (863) of all incidents.

Drug incidents increased from 624 in 1991 to 863 in 1992. Marijuana based drug incidents accounted for over three-fourths of the increase.

FATAL ASSAULTS

Nine male inmates were fatally assaulted in 1992. The number of fatalities increased from 4 in 1991 to 9 in 1992.

After reaching a high of 32 in 1972, the number of inmates stabbed to death decreased to only 3 in 1992.

There have been 15 fatal assaults on staff since 1970. The last one occurred in 1985.

INMATE INCIDENTS

NUMBER OF ASSAULTS ON STAFF

In 1992, there were 1,188 assaults on staff. Of these, 455 (38.3%) involved the use of weapons by inmates.

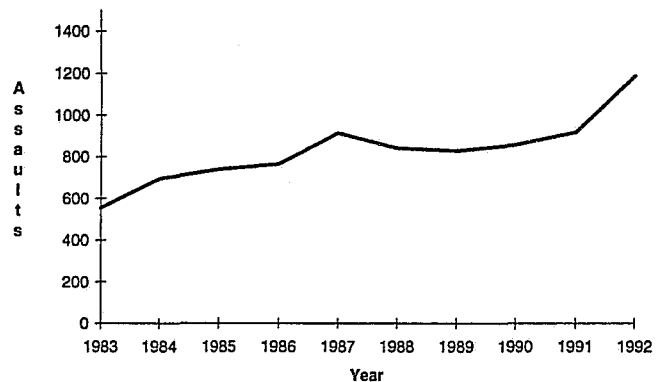
Assaults on staff increased from 919 in 1991 to 1,188 in 1992.

Assaults on staff at CMF-Main increased from 102 in 1991 to 187 in 1992.

Assaults on staff at Folsom decreased from 111 in 1986 to 31 in 1992.

Assaults on staff at CTF-Central decreased from 107 in 1984 to 27 in 1992.

RATE OF ASSAULTS ON STAFF

The rate of inmate assaults on staff has steadily decreased since 1984 when it was 1.7 per 100 average daily institution population.

After reaching a low of 1.0 in 1990 and 1991, the rate of inmate assaults on staff increased to 1.2 in 1992.

Calendar Year 1983 through 1992

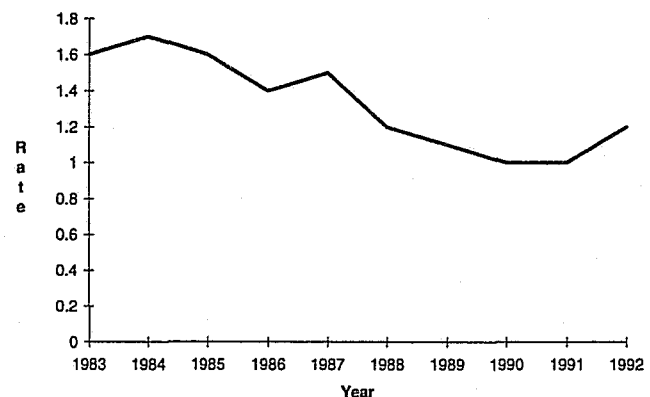
