

INDEX CRIMES IN NEW YORK STATE (ESTIMATED) DECREASED 9.2% FROM 1993 TO 1994

- New York City reported a 11.7% decrease in index offenses while index crimes in the statewide sample decreased 9.2%.
- The sampled Non-New York City jurisdictions decreased 4.6%.
- Among the Non-New York City jurisdictions, agencies in the 100,000 to 999,999 population group had a 4.9% decrease in index offenses, agencies in the 50,000 to 99,999 group decreased 4.1%, while the 25,000 to 49,999 group decreased 4.9%.
- Agencies with populations under 25,000 and multijurisdictional agencies decreased 4.4%.

The crime data in this bulletin are estimates based on Uniform Crime Reports (UCR) index crimes reported for 1994 and 1993 by law enforcement agencies that had submitted complete monthly reports as of March, 1995. Populations are 1993 estimates based on data from the Federal Bureau of Investigation.




VIOLENT CRIME DECREASED 9.1% STATEWIDE


- Robbery is the most frequently occurring violent crime in the State (50% of all violent crimes).
- New York City reported a decrease of 11.1% in violent crime and accounted for 81% of the violent crimes in the sample.
- The sampled Non-New York City agencies showed a 0.4% increase in violent crime.
- Agencies in the 25,000 to 49,999 population group showed a decrease of 4.0%; agencies in the 50,000 to 99,999 group had a decrease of 7.2% and those in the 100,000 to 999,999 group increased 6.1%.
- Agencies under 25,000 population and multijurisdictional agencies had a 2.9% decrease in violent crime.





PROPERTY CRIME DECREASED 9.3% STATEWIDE

- Larceny is the most frequently occurring property crime, with a frequency more than double that of any other property crime.
- New York City reported a decrease of 11.9% in property crime and accounted for 59% of the property crimes in the sample.
- The sampled Non-New York City agencies reported a 5.1% decrease in property crime.
- Agencies in the population group 25,000 to 49,999 reported a 5.0% decrease, agencies in the 50,000 to 99,999 population group had a 3.9% decrease and the 100,000 to 999,999 group decreased 6.6%.
- Agencies under 25,000 population and multijurisdictional agencies had a 4.6% decrease in property crime.
