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INTRODUCTION

This report has been developed to provide information regarding selected characteristics for offenders under the jurisdiction of the New Jersey Department of Corrections who are on parole. The data compiled in this report are based on information contained in the Department of Corrections computer files as of December 31, 1994. The selected characteristics compiled in this report are Base Offense at Admission, Race/Ethnicity, Age and County of Commitment.

In this edition, note that the District Offices have been divided into four regions, with the Northern Region representing Districts 1, 4 and 12 (Clifton, Jersey City and Paterson), the Metro Region representing Districts 2, 9 and 13 (East Orange and Newark), the Central Region representing Districts 3, 5 and 11 (Red Bank, Elizabeth and New Brunswick) and the Southern Region representing Districts 6, 7, 8 and 10 (Trenton, Camden, Atlantic City and Vineland).

"NOT CODED" refers to records on offenders in the Correctional system for which admission characteristic data have not been entered into the computerized information system as of December 31, 1994.

Total parole population includes Prison, Young Adult and Juvenile parolees. Also included in the total parole population are 1,363 female offenders.

The Bureau of Parole, in addition to supervising parolees released from facilities under jurisdiction of the Department of Corrections, is also responsible for supervision of parolees who have served county sentences, usually of a year or less. These cases are not included in this report.

HIGHLIGHTS

BASE OFFENSE

- Thirty percent (10,593) of the total parole population consisted of persons who had committed crimes of a violent nature. Of these violent offenders, 41% or 4329 were on parole for robbery, 27% or 2826 were on parole for assault, 13% or 1342 were on parole for sexual assault and other sex offenses, 11% or 1154 were on parole for homicide and 9% or 942 were on parole for other persons offenses.
- The single most common offense type was drug offenses. Forty-five percent (16,058) of those under supervision had committed such offenses.

RACE/ETHNICITY

- More than one half of the total parole population (60%) was black.
- The Metro Region (District Offices #2 and #13 in East Orange and District Office #9 in Newark) accounted for 28% of the black parolee population, statewide.
- Whites constituted 21% of the parole caseload and Hispanics, 19%.

AGE

- The median age for those under supervision was 32.
- Ninety-seven percent of the total parolee population was 21 years of age or older.
- Thirty-four percent are aged 21-29 and 39% are 30-39 years of age.
- Only 3% are under age 21.

COUNTY OF COMMITMENT

- Forty-four percent of all offenders on parole were committed from the four (4) major counties of Bergen, Essex, Hudson and Passaic.
- Essex County was the commitment county for 18% (6395) of all parolees under supervision, statewide.
- Fewer parolees were committed from Hunterdon and Sussex than any other county with 231 and 185 respectively.
- NOTE: Data in this report are only for parolees assigned to the thirteen parole district offices. There are approximately 7,000 additional cases assigned to the Central Office Revenue Unit. These cases are not included in the reports presented here.

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OFFENDERS ON PAROLE IN NEW JERSEY ON DECEMBER 31, 1994 BY BASE OFFENSE

In these tabulations, the Base Offense is that which is the most serious offense a. the time of admission. These figures reflect base or controlling offense at admission only, and do not include offenses in addition to the base offense in the case of multiple sentences at admission, nor are additional sentences imposed following initial admission to the State Correctional System included in the data.

- Violent Crimes include homicide, sexual assault, aggravated assault, robbery, other sex offenses and other persons offenses (i.e. simple assault, weapons offenses, coercion, larceny from a person and negligent manslaughter).
- Property Offenses include burglary, arson, breaking and entering, theft, forgery, embezzlement, auto theft and receiving/possessing stolen property.
- Public Policy Offenses include racketeering, gambling, violation of probation, prostitution, corruption, perjury, escape, bail jumping, juvenile or family related offenses and conspiracy. Violation of probation is the commitment offense for the vast majority of those in the Public Policy category.
- Narcotics Violations include distribution, manufacture and possession/use of drugs. Over 90% of these
 are for distribution, manufacture and sale.

OFFENDERS ON PAROLE ON DECEMBER 31, 1994 BY BASE OFFENSE

 Thirty percent (10,593) of the total parole population consisted of offenders who had committed crimes of a violent nature or other persons offenses.

- Of the 10,593 violent offenders 41% or 4,329 were on parole for robbery, 27% or 2,826 were on parole for assault, 13% or 1,342 were on parole for sexual assault and other sex offenses, 11% or 1154 were on parole for homicide and 9% or 942 were on parole for other person offenses.

PAROLE POPULATION BY BASE OFFENSE ON DECEMBER 31, 1994



- Thirty percent of all offenders on parole were convicted of a crime of a violent nature.
- The Metro Region led all others in terms of the portion on parole for violent offenses (39%).
- Of the total New Jersey parole population, the most common commitment offenses were narcotics violations (45%), property offenses (19%) and robbery (12%).

OFFENDERS ON PAROLE ON DECEMBER 31, 1994 BY RACE/ETHNIC IDENTIFICATION

- More than one half (60% or 21,274) of the total parole population was black. Eighty—one percent (6,029) of parolees in the Metro Region were black. These 6,029 black parolees accounted for 28% of the black parolee population, statewide.
- Twenty-one percent (7,274) of the total parole population was white, with the Southem Region accounting for the largest proportion of the white parolee population with 39% (2,851), statewide.
- Nineteen percent (6,862) of the total parole population was Hispanic. The Northern Region supervised 44% (2,992) of the Hispanic parolee population, statewide.

- The largest number of white parolees are from District Office 1 (Clifton) with 1045 and District Office 8 (Atlantic City) with 883.
- District Office 2 (E. Orange) supervised the largest number of black parolees with 2132.
- The largest number of Hispanic parolees (1190) was from District Office 4 (Jersey City).
