INTRODUCTION**ACQUISITIONS**

This report summarizes statistical information about the Maricopa County Juvenile Court Center in 1994. This report compares the court activity in 1994 with the activity of the prior four years (1990-1993).

The bulk of this report deals with juvenile delinquency and incorrigibility (status) referrals. Information is obtained from police reports, other referring entities, and from probation officers who interviewed the children and their families. It describes the number and characteristics of delinquency and incorrigible offense cases in 1994 handled by the Maricopa County Juvenile Court.

A child becomes known to the court by a "referral" which alleges that the child has violated the law in some way. It should be noted that many children whose actions or social conditions might warrant action by the Juvenile Court are not referred to the court and are therefore not included in these data. Some children are not referred simply because their illegal actions are not observed or reported, or the child is not apprehended. Furthermore, not all activities of juveniles, once reported to the police, are subsequently referred to the Juvenile Court. Some police agencies within the county use community counseling programs for children apprehended for minor offenses, followed by release to their parents. Consequently, the data presented in this report cannot be taken as a complete measure of the extent of delinquent behavior in Maricopa County.

When it has been decided by a referring agency that a child's action or social condition warrants intervention by the court, that child is referred, and when a child is referred, the intake division of the Juvenile Court begins the process of diagnosis and recommendation. There are numerous ways in which a referral may be dealt with by the court. However, the best interest of the child, balanced with what is in the best interest of the community, must always be considered.

Children also become known to the court when they are being adopted, when one or both parent's rights are being severed (usually prior to adoption), or when the child may have been neglected, abandoned or abused.

How Maricopa County's Juvenile Justice System Works




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

STATE AND COUNTY STATISTICS


Arizona is geographically the sixth largest state in the nation with 113,642 square miles and a population estimate in 1994 of 3,958,875 in 15 counties. Maricopa County is the seventh most populated county in the nation with 9,204 square miles and a population of 2,424,547. (Department of Economic Security Population Estimates for 1994.)

Approximately 57.9% of the state's population resides in Maricopa County. There are 263 residents per square mile. Phoenix is the county seat.





Delinquent & Incurrigible Referrals




In any given year, about 6% of the juvenile population (between the ages of 8 and 17) of Maricopa County are referred at least once to the Court Center. That's about one juvenile in every 15 at risk. In 1994, there were 32,701 referrals generated by 20,855

juveniles, which computes to 1.57 referrals per juvenile on the average. The number of juveniles referred to the court has increased by 12.8% from 1990 to 1994. There was a 12.7% increase in the number of referrals received from 1990 to 1994.





Delinquent & Incurrigible




Referrals are categorized as to their severity according to the offense. This order was established by the Maricopa County Juvenile Court Center and is unique to this Court Center. Property crimes (Felony/ Grand Theft and Misdemeanor/ Theft) account for 33.2% of all referrals.

Incurrigible (status) offenses were 30.1%, Public Order (Peace and Obstructing) 16.9%, Person crimes (Felony/Violent and Misdemeanor/ Fight) 13.3%, Drug law violations (Felony and Misdemeanor) were 6.1%, and Administrative (Hold) were 0.3% of 32,701 total referrals in 1994.



SEVERITY OF REFERRAL 1990-1994


Violent Referrals




Grand Theft Referrals




Obstruction Referrals



Fight Referrals




Drug Referrals




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





Source of Referral



Delinquent and incorrigible (status) cases are referred to the court by law enforcement agencies, social service agencies, schools, parents, and probation officers. Law enforcement agencies are the primary source of referral. Overall, 88% of all cases in 1994 were referred by law enforcement agencies. Other referring sources include Probation Officers, Parents, Schools, Court and DYTR. The law

enforcement agency that contributes the most referrals to the Juvenile Court is the Phoenix Police Department. In 1994, Phoenix sent 14,061 referrals, which accounts for 43% of all referrals received. Phoenix, Mesa, Chandler, Glendale and Tempe Police Departments comprise the top five sources of referrals received, accounting for 73% of all referrals to the Juvenile Court Center in 1994.



Sex of Referred





Ethnicity of Referred



Juveniles Brought to Detention Screening and Juveniles Detained





During 1994, there were 9,109 requests (screened) for detention. This resulted in detention 8,090 times, or 88.8% of the requests were detained. A request for detention may occur when a Police or Court Officer believes, for the safety of the community or the juvenile, that physical detention may be required. The juvenile is taken to either of the two Maricopa County Juvenile Detention Centers and interviewed by

a Probation Officer. Based upon Supreme Court Rules and the Court Center's administrative policies, the Probation Officer has the option to release the juvenile to the parents or physically detain the juvenile pending court action. Probation Officers are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. If the juvenile is detained, a petition must be filed and an advisory/detention hearing held within 24 hours.

In 1994, 8,090 juveniles were detained. Of those, 3,679 were detained for delinquent or incorrigible acts, and the remainder of 4,411 juveniles were detained for such reasons as: court holds, warrants, and children from other jurisdictions.

The average daily population in detention (including both facilities) was 311 juveniles in 1994. There has been a 56% increase in the average daily population of juveniles in detention from 1990 to 1994 with the detention capacity increasing only 18%. The average (mean) length of stay was 14 days. Length of stay does not have a normal distribution. Most juveniles stay fewer than 14 days while those who stay longer remain much

longer than the 1994 average might suggest.

Detention has been operating over its capacity for the past two years, with a percent over capacity in in 1993 of 12% and in 1994 of 24%.



During 1994, 2,794 juveniles were placed on probation and 1,587 juveniles were continued on probation by the court. Juveniles placed on probation has increased 29% over the last five years and juveniles continued on probation has increased 148%. The total number of juveniles on probation has increased 56% over the last five years.

The average number of prior referrals a juvenile has when placed on probation has increased slightly from 1993 of 1.7 referrals to 1.9 referrals in 1994.




Probation Fees Assessment and Collection




Probation assessments and collections in 1994 have increased, with \$135,378 in assessments and \$62,542 in collections over 1993. That relates to assessments increasing by 25%, and collections increasing 26% over 1993. The 1994 collection rate is 45%.

Juveniles Committed or Awarded to Arizona Department of Youth Treatment & Rehabilitation (ADYTR)




Commitments to the State Department of Youth Treatment & Rehabilitation (DYTR) in 1994 has shown an increase over 1993 of 55 juveniles committed to DYTR for a total of 616 juveniles in 1994. The Juvenile Court has the exclusive responsibility for making the decision to remand a juvenile for transfer for adult criminal prosecution.

The number of transfers to adult criminal court in 1994 increased by 14% over 1993 for a total of 318 juveniles being transferred. The number of prior complaints or referrals has increased slightly from 6.8 in 1990 to 7.7 in 1994.



1994 Transfer Decision






Intake Caseload Cite-In First Set



The Intake cite-in is the interview of the referred juvenile and parent(s) at the Juvenile Court by a Probation Officer. Generally, these juveniles are first and second referral misdemeanors or status offenders. The Officer has the discretion to handle the referral without initiating a formal court process.


The above graph shows the average number of days to first cite-in, measuring how quickly the Intake Division is able to get to the caseload assigned. In 1994, it took 73 days from date of complaint to date cite-in took place. A second measure is the number of pending (unfinished) cases as shown in the graph to the right. There were 5,810 pending cases in 1994, a 47% increase from 3,956 pending cases in 1993.

New Referrals Received




Referrals (complaints) where no formal petition is filed may be adjusted by the Probation Officer after the initial interview with the juvenile and parent(s). If the juvenile has acknowledged involvement in the alleged offense, the matter will not be adjusted until specific conditions established by the Probation Officer are met. Conditions of adjust may include referral to community agencies for family counseling, individual

counseling, specialized education, and awareness programs such as alcohol and drug abuse, restitution to victims, voluntary work hours in the community, voluntary restitution, fines, and other similar options.

The number of New Referrals Received to the Intake Division has shown an increase from 18,108 in 1993 to 19,909 New Referrals in 1994, or a 10% increase in the last 5 years.

PIC-ACT

Assessment and Collection




The Progressively Increasing Consequences Act (PIC-ACT) became effective through legislative action on July 1, 1984. If after conducting an intake interview with the alleged juvenile offender and parent(s), and the juvenile acknowledges responsibility for the delinquent act or alcohol offense, the Juvenile Probation Officer may adjust the delinquency complaint once the juvenile has complied with specific conditions.

Assessments made for Intake Services in 1994 have decreased 5% over 1993 to \$104,923, and collections have

decreased 12% over 1993 to \$82,909 for 1994. The collection rate is 79%.

This legislation concentrates on first and second time offenders in hopes of eliminating future delinquent behavior patterns before they become firmly established. The development of PIC-ACT centers on the debate of whether holding youthful offenders more accountable for their delinquent behavior will result in a lower incidence of recidivism. Programs sponsored under PIC-ACT are currently in operation in all 15 counties in Arizona.



Home Detention is an alternative between structured institutional detention and unconditional release back into the community. Juveniles originally held in the juvenile detention facility, but being allowed to return home pending Court, may be assigned to Home Detention. In this program, the juvenile's freedom is greatly restricted and the Home Detention staff maintain frequent and close contact with the juvenile on an

unannounced basis to assure compliance with the conditions of release.

As compared to 1993, juveniles placed on Home Detention increased slightly from 1,839 to 1,954 in 1994. Juveniles released, also increased from 1,796 in 1993 to 1,927 in 1994. The average daily population in Home Detention is 248 juveniles with an average length of stay of 47.3 days in 1994.

Placement




The number of juveniles in Placement during 1994 was 303 juveniles in Residential Care and 755 juveniles in Day and Evening Care. Residential placement has decreased by 18% from 1990 to 1994, with a peak of 430

juveniles in 1992. Day and Evening Care has increased 190% in the same five years.

The cost per day for a juvenile in 1994 was \$123.12 for Residential care, and \$56.17 for Day & Evening Care .

Diversion Programs



Diversion programs are established and supervised by various municipalities for the needs of some first time misdemeanant offenders in their communities. These programs are developed by agreement with the Court Center as provided by statute.


Several municipalities within Maricopa County have designed First Offender and Diversion Programs to work with juveniles in the community.

Cities such as Phoenix, Mesa, Tempe, Glendale, Peoria, Scottsdale, Avondale, Chandler, and Gilbert have various types of diversion programs for the first time offender.

In the past five years, the number of juveniles assigned to diversion programs increased significantly by 54%, with 1,030 in 1990 and 1,588 in 1994.

Recidivism

Tracks a Juvenile for One Year After Referral




In this table, recidivism is defined as the probability of a subsequent referral within one year of the initial referral, i.e., the probability of a subsequent arrest (guilt may not have been determined). Administrative offenses (Holds), and technical probation violations (i.e., no law violation charged) are not counted as initial referrals or subsequent referrals. Juveniles 17 years or older at the initial referral, not considered. As soon as a juvenile reaches the age of 18, the Juvenile Court loses all jurisdiction over that person.

Two samples are used above. The sample called "First Timers" utilized only the first referral to Juvenile Court as the initial referral, while "All Juveniles" utilize any referral except an administrative offense or probation violation.

The percent of juveniles recidivating has been gradually increasing over the past five years. In 1994, 32% of all First Time Offenders recidivate, and approximately 42% of All Juveniles recidivate.



A hearing categorized as Held, is one with a recorded start and end time. A Completed hearing is one showing a result of completed,

under advisement, or conditional (applying to dispositions).

In 1994, a total of 50,771 hearings were scheduled, 41,308 hearings were held, and 33,613 hearings were completed. Approximately 67% of these hearings were for delinquency matters.

Total scheduled court hearings have increased 16% since 1990, from 43,846 hearings scheduled to 50,771 hearings scheduled in 1994.

There has been major increase in Dependency hearings, which have increased 53% in the last 5 years.

Hearing types were readjusted in 1993 to reclassify the Miscellaneous category. Hearings for the years 1989 to 1993 were recalculated as a result of this adjustment. Actual Total Hearings Scheduled did not vary significantly from the numbers previously published, but Miscellaneous and Delinquency Hearings were redefined which did affect their total.
