HIGHLIGHTS

The number of escapes from Institutions and Camps decreased from 72 during 1993 to 56 in 1994.

The Institution and Camp escape rate per 100 ADP decreased from 0.07 in 1993 to 0.05 in 1994.

The number of escapes from Community Correctional Centers decreased from 1,327 in 1993 to 985 in 1994.

> All 56 escapees during Calendar Year 1994 were men.
