

## **SURVEY OF SELECTED COMMUNITY RESOURCES**

### **SCOPE**

A list of existing community resources across the state was compiled from area directories, lists prepared by the county offices of the Department of Pensions and Securities, information gathered by the Public Information Office of the Department of Pensions and Security, material obtained through the Alabama Development Office, and a number of miscellaneous contacts too numerous to mention individually here. Those agencies which offer direct services deemed relevant to the needs of offenders and their families are listed. The decision to include an agency was also based upon the cost to the individual client.

In an undertaking of this magnitude it is apparent that omissions will occur.

### **FORMAT**

Each agency is listed alphabetically by county. Each listing includes the full title of the agency, its address, and a brief description of the service offered. The description of services is based upon existing directory information and a direct telephone survey. The yes or no in parentheses following the description of services indicates whether the agency takes referrals from police, courts, or corrections.

In cases where the agency was not contacted directly the referral information was left blank.

In the case of state-wide services, such as the Public Health Department, a listing of the address within each county is given with the note: "See Central Listing." A list of these agencies and a brief description of their services has been made in an effort to avoid needless repetition.

## CENTRAL LISTINGS

1. Alcoholics Anonymous

Fellowship of men and women who share their experiences, strength and hope endeavoring to solve common problems and help others recover from alcoholism.

(yes)

2. American National Red Cross

Offers a well rounded program of family service to members of the Armed Forces, veterans and members of their families needing help in dealing with personal and family problems; provides food, clothing and temporary shelter on a mass basis in emergency periods and rehabilitation services to those in need; provides community preparedness planning for disasters; provides planning, teaching and training for safety and accident prevention, first aid and water safety; maintains, collects, processes and distributes whole blood; develops youth leadership in the schools and the community by promoting self development, civic responsibility in the areas of human relations and international understanding; supplies volunteers for many Red Cross services in hospitals, nursing homes and school health

programs; and educates the public in areas of home nursing, physical fitness for the future and new mothers and baby care. Services may vary in different locations. (yes)

3. Boy's Club, Inc.

Gym, athletic field activities, hobby workshops, library facilities, and group clubs for boys 6-18 years. (yes)

4. Department of Pensions and Security

The State Department sets policies for and supervises administration of all forms of Public Assistance and food programs in the state through the 67 county departments. The financial aid program includes old age assistance, aid to the blind, aid to dependent children, aid to the permanently and totally disabled, limited temporary emergency aid, aid to children in foster care, and aid to children in day care.

Food programs include either distribution of commodities or food stamps offices in each county.

Other services include the "seeking out" of minor children in need of care and protection, aiding such

children to have a fair opportunity in life. Serves children and their families in their own homes, places children in adoptive homes, investigates adoption petitions filed in the probate courts, licenses as well as supervises private child care institutions and agencies, private child placement agencies, foster and day care homes for children, cooperates with other agencies and organizations serving people. Services include a variety of other special and cooperative services, such as certifying eligible persons to receive Medicaid for the Public Health Department. All department recipients including recipients who would be eligible for aid in their own homes but requiring nursing home care are certified. Emergency welfare services in times of disaster; cooperates with civil defense and other governmental units to properly care for victims.

5. Housing Authority

Provides low-rent housing and in some cases, social services. (yes)

6. Mental Health Authority and Centers

Diagnostic, evaluative, and treatment services to persons with emotional, mental, or behavioral disorders.

Mental health centers, Help-a-Crisis Service, Youth Hotline, Care House, Youth RAP sessions. Services may differ with each facility. (yes)

7. Planned Parenthood

Physical examinations, tests, and contraceptives. Pregnancy and fertility counseling. Public education programs. (yes)

8. Public Health Department

Prevents and controls the spread of communicable diseases; safeguards the purity of food and water supplies, protects the health of mothers and children; provides specialized programs in tuberculosis and venereal disease control; teaches people the problems of personal and community health and how to solve them; records and preserves records of vital human events and provides through clinics certain services in the field of preventive medicine, nursing, dentistry and mental health.

9. Salvation Army

Food, clothing, medicine, furniture, etc. for emergency relief. Family and juvenile counseling. Emergency

lodging, food and clothing for stranded transients. House and care for neglected children on referral. Services may vary in different areas. (yes)

10. Social Security Administration

Administers a system of contributory social and disability insurance; receives, develops and adjudicates claims for old age and survivors insurance. Receives and develops claims for disability insurance payments and gives detailed information on its programs; administers Medicare program. (yes)

11. State Employment Service

Placement of workers in suitable jobs. Recruitment and referral to Job Corp Training Centers. Placement in training under Manpower Development and Training Act. Development of contracts and referrals to "on the job training" under NAB - Job 70's and Job Option Program. Vocational counseling and aptitude testing. (yes)

12. State Unemployment Compensation Claims Office

Pays unemployment compensation to eligible applicants.

Persons covered by the Division of the State Unemployment Compensation Legislation and those who have lost their employment through no fault of their own, and are able, willing, and available to accept work, are eligible for benefits. Persons employed by the federal government or have served in the armed services are covered. (yes)

13. Veterans Affairs Department

Files claims for any benefit provided by the Veterans Administration for veterans, their widows and dependents. Furnishes information to anyone about VA laws, benefits, etc. Files applications for the Alabama G.I. Bill. (yes)

14. Vocation Rehabilitation Service

Provides services for those persons who have employment handicaps resulting from mental or physical disability. Services are designed to preserve, to restore, and/or develop the ability of disabled men and women for gainful employment. Services include: evaluation, counseling and guidance, physical restoration, training and training supplies, maintenance,

needed tools, and equipment, finding a job, and follow-up on the job. (yes)

15. YMCA

Recreational, educational, and inspirational programs to meet the needs of membership and community. (yes)
