

**CHILDREN'S CASES DISPOSED OF BY THE JUVENILE COURTS
FISCAL YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 1974**

Monthly reports submitted by Virginia courts with juvenile jurisdiction for 1973-74 indicated 78,666 youth cases were disposed of. This was an increase of 10,710 or 15.8% over fiscal year 1973.

DELINQUENCY: The type of juvenile activity pertaining to delinquency includes: (1) violation of criminal statutes for other than motor vehicle operation, (2) behavior beyond parental control, such as habitual disobedience or runaway, or (3) school truancy and related problems. Delinquency cases increased from 31,803 in fiscal year 1972-73 to 35,845 in fiscal year 1973-74 - a 12.7% increase.

TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS: Cases concerning the operation of motor vehicles increased from 19,059 in fiscal year 1972-73 to 25,100 in fiscal year 1973-74 - a 31.7% increase. This is not a fully accurate figure since some counties handle all traffic law violators as adults. In such instances, these cases are not represented in the reported juvenile statistics.

DEPENDENCY AND NEGLECT: The number of cases concerning dependency and neglect increased from 5,311 in fiscal year 1972-73 to 5,370 in fiscal year 1973-74 - a 1.1% increase.

OTHER TYPES OF CASES: The number of "all other" cases increased from 11,781 the prior fiscal year to 12,351 in fiscal year 1973-74 - a 4.8% increase. These cases include children referred to the court for (1) commitment as mentally defective; (2) determination of custody or guardianship; and (3) consent to marry or enlist in the Armed Forces for wards of the State or local governments.

UNOFFICIAL CASES: The 5,362 unofficial cases represent 7.0% of all cases disposed of. The practice of many cities and counties to report only official cases indicated that the prevalence of habitual juvenile misbehavior and delinquent conduct is greater than the base statistics appear to show.

RACE AND SEX: Of the official cases disposed of 60.0% were white males, 18.0% were white females, 16.0% were non white males and 6.0% were non white females.

CITY AND COUNTY: The cities accounted for 37,450 or 48% of the cases and the counties 41,216 or 52%.

The information in the following tables is compiled from monthly reports submitted by the judges of the individual courts in cooperation with the Department of Corrections. Although the data herein is not complete in several respects, it is believed that it substantially represents the volume of children's cases handled by juvenile courts in Virginia. It is felt that the large increase in cases disposed of is due, in part, to the efforts of the courts to submit more accurate data.
